FELONY COMPLAINT

The undersigned is informed and believes that:

COUNT 1

On or about November 4, 2025, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of SECOND DEGREE ROBBERY, in violation of PENAL CODE section 211, a Felony, was committed by JEANINE JOHN TAELE, who did unlawfully, and by means of force and fear take personal property from the person, possession, and immediate presence of PAVISH PATEL.

"NOTICE: The above offense is a serious felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1192.7(c) and a violent felony within the meaning of Penal Code Section 667.5(c)."

NOTICE: Upon a felony conviction for the above offense, prison custody time is to be served in state prison based upon the above felony offense being a serious felony defined in Penal Code section 1192.7 and/or violent felony defined in Penal Code section 667.5(c), or a felony offense requiring registration as sex offender pursuant to Penal Code section 290(c), within the meaning of Penal Code section 1170(h)(3).

COUNT 2

On or about August 2, 2026, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of MANUFACTURING, IMPORTING, KEEPING FOR SALE, GIVING OR RECEIVING A LARGE-CAPACITY MAGAZINE, in violation of PENAL CODE section 32310(a), a Felony, was committed by JEANINE JOHN TAELE, who received a large-capacity magazine.

COUNT 3

On or about August 2, 2026, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of CARRYING A CONCEALED FIREARM IN A VEHICLE, in violation of PENAL CODE section 25400(a)(1), a Misdemeanor, was committed by JEANINE JOHN TAELE, who did unlawfully carry concealed within a vehicle that was under his control and direction, a pistol, revolver and other firearm capable of being concealed upon the person, to wit: 9mm pistol,

COUNT 4

On or about August 2, 2026, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of POSSESSION OF A SHORT-BARRELED RIFLE OR SHOTGUN, in violation of PENAL CODE section 33215, a Felony, was committed by JEANINE JOHN TAELE, who did unlawfully manufacture, cause to be manufactured, import into the State of California, keep for sale, offer and expose for sale, and give, lend, and possess an instrument and weapon of the kind commonly known as short barreled rifle and a short-barreled shotgun.

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense will require the defendant to provide DNA samples and print impressions pursuant to Penal Code sections 296 and 296.1. Willful refusal to provide the samples and impressions is a crime.

NOTICE: The People of the State of California intend to present evidence and seek jury findings regarding all applicable circumstances in aggravation, pursuant to Penal Code section 1170(b) and *Cunningham v. California* (2007) 549 U.S. 270.

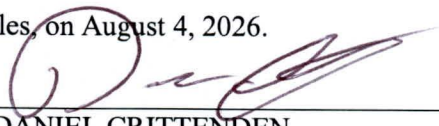

NOTICE: Conviction of this offense prohibits you from owning, purchasing, receiving, possessing, or having under your custody and control any firearms, and effective January 1, 2018, will require you to complete a Prohibited Persons Relinquishment Form ("PPR") pursuant to Penal Code § 29810.
