## THE DEFENDANT COMMITTED THE OFFENSES OF:

- 1 (M) P.L. 140.10(a) Criminal Trespass 3<sup>rd</sup> DQO
- 2 (V) P.L. 140.05 Trespass

IN THAT THE DEFENDANT DID: knowingly enter or remain unlawfully in a building or upon real property which was fenced or otherwise enclosed in a manner designed to exclude intruders and knowingly enter or remain unlawfully in or upon premises.

## THE GROUNDS FOR THE DEPONENT'S BELIEF ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Deponent is informed by Sofia Bonilla, that at the above time and place, the Bronx Zoo, she was seated on the monorail and as the monorail approached the tiger's den, she observed defendant stand up on the monorail railing in front of her and jump into the tiger's den.

Deponent states that he observed defendant laying on the ground inside tiger's den which was enclosed by a fence. Deponent further states that he asked defendant why he jumped into the den, defendant stated in sum and substance: EVERYONE MAKES CHOICES AND WE HAVE OUR REASONS IN LIFE WHY WE DO THINGS.

Deponent is informed by Det. Matthew McCrosson sh#005474 of the 52nd precinct that he asked defendant why he jumped into the tiger's den, defendant stated in sum and substance: I WAS TESTING MY NATURAL FEAR, YOU WOULD NOT UNDERSTAND IT IS A SPIRITUAL THING, I WANTED TO BE AT ONE WITH THE TIGER.

Deponent further states that aforementioned enclosed tiger's den is owned and maintained by the City of New York.
