

THIS MATTER having come before the court by way of plaintiff's application for a declaratory judgment declaring that defendant William Stepien's invocation of the privilege against self-incrimination in response to a subpoena *duces tecum* issued by the New Jersey

Legislative Select Committee on Investigation was unjustified, and for injunctive relief ordering defendant to comply with the subpoena; and defendant having opposed the application; and the court having carefully considered the arguments of the parties set forth in the briefs and supplemental briefs, and as presented to the court during oral argument; and for the reasons set forth in the written opinion accompanying this order; and for good cause shown:

IT IS on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2014, ORDERED that:

1. Plaintiff's application for a judgment declaring that defendant William Stepien has failed, without justification, to produce documents in accordance with the subpoena is DENIED.
2. Plaintiff's request for injunctive relief ordering defendant to comply with the subpoena is DENIED.
3. The complaint filed by plaintiff is hereby dismissed.
