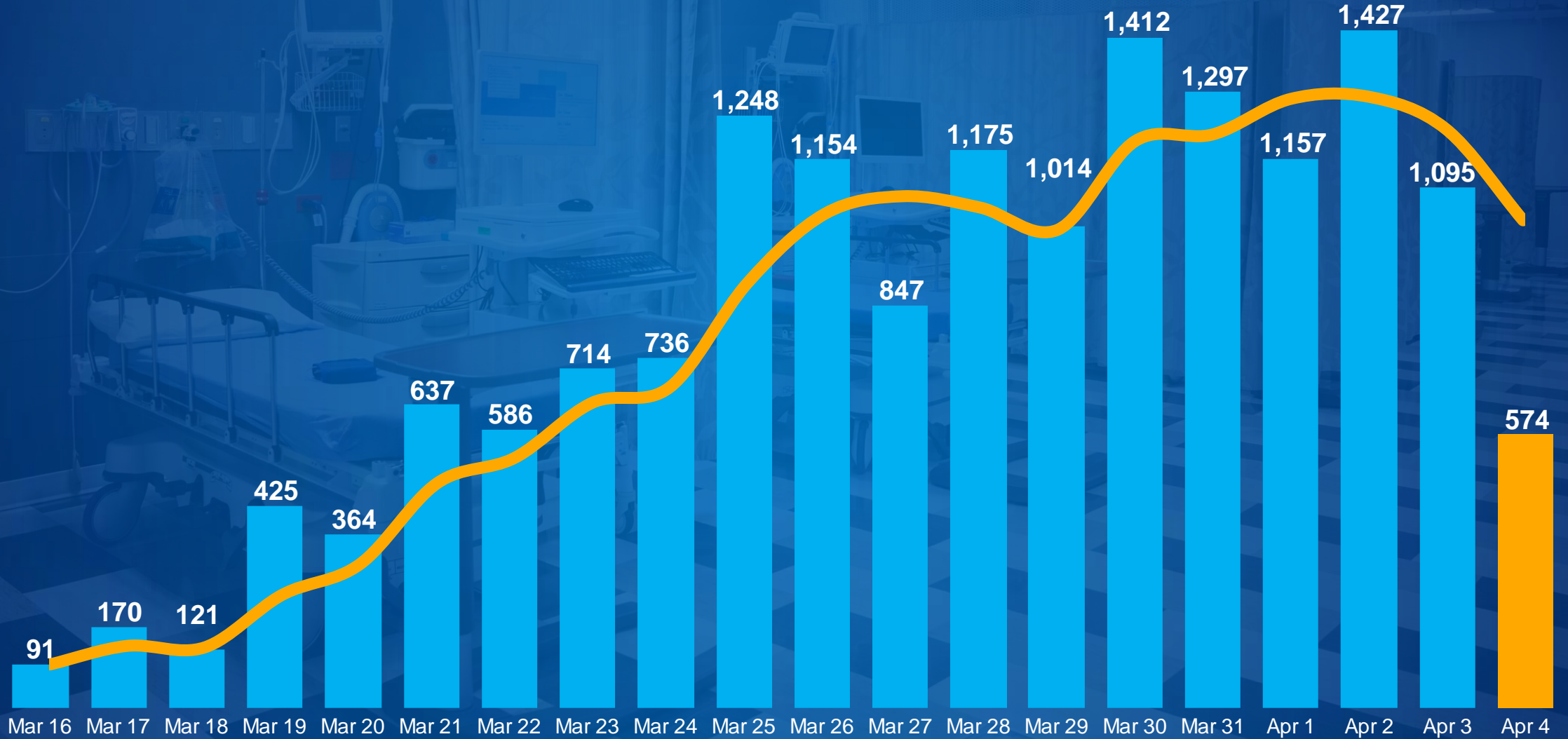

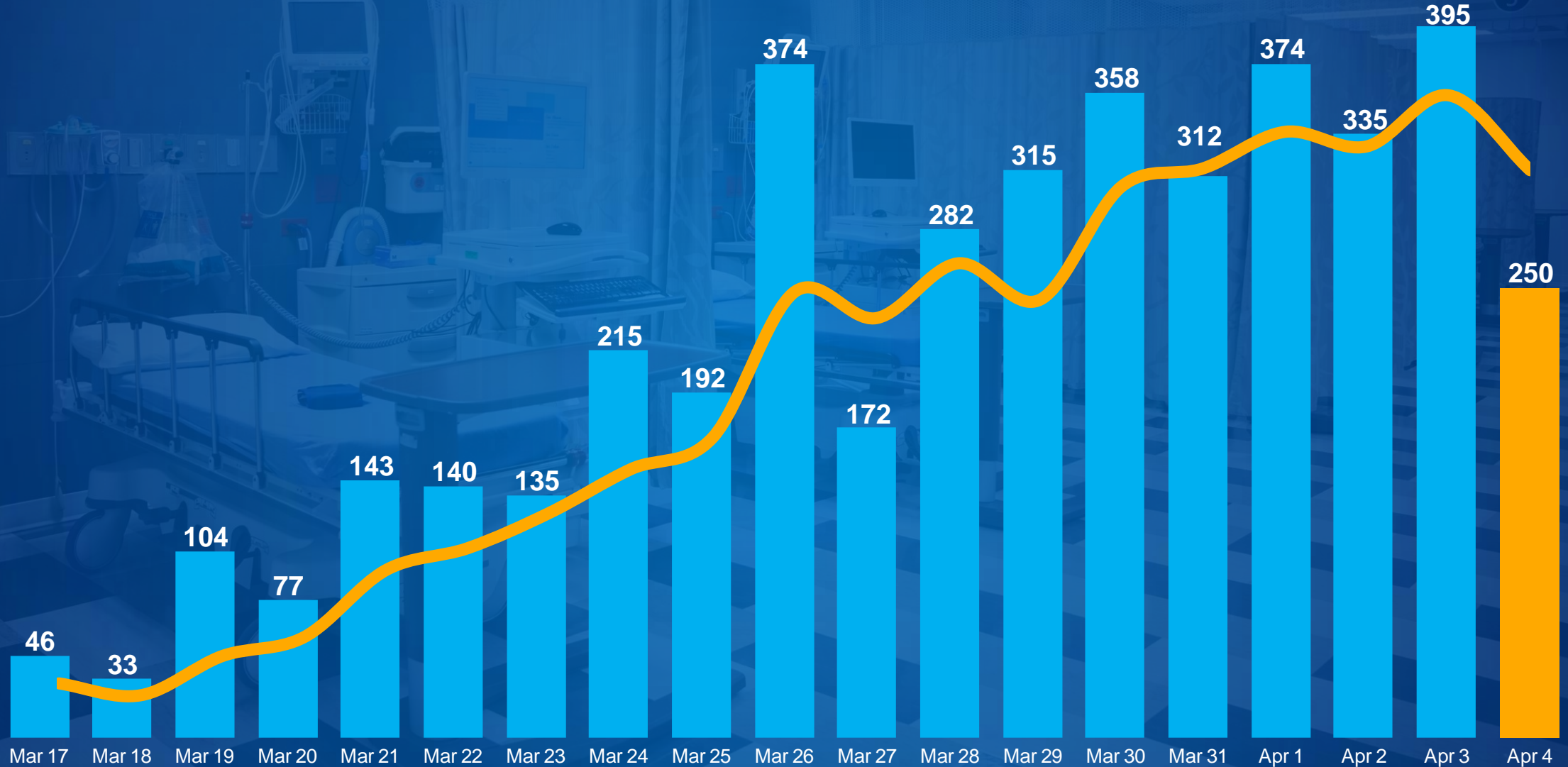

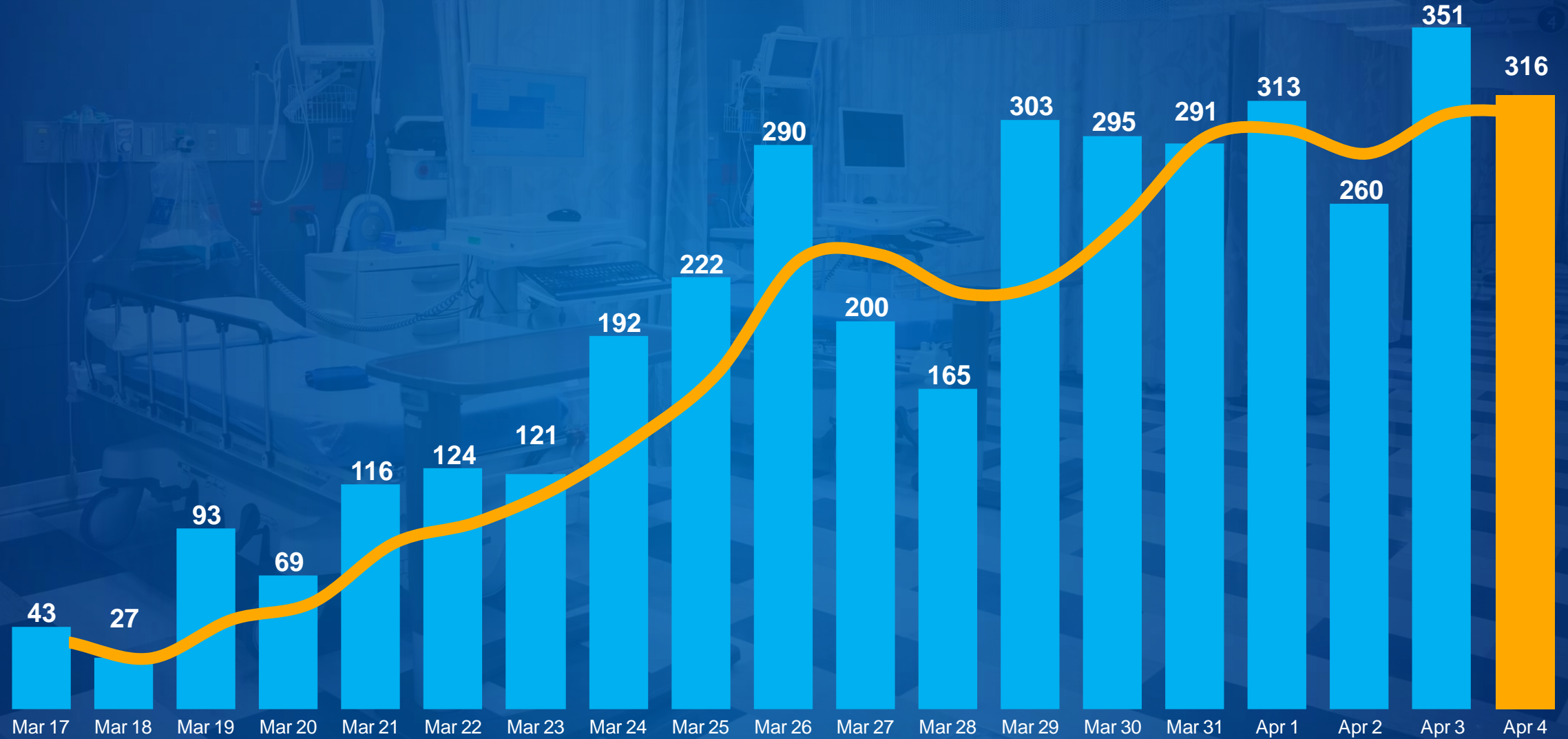
Total New Hospitalized



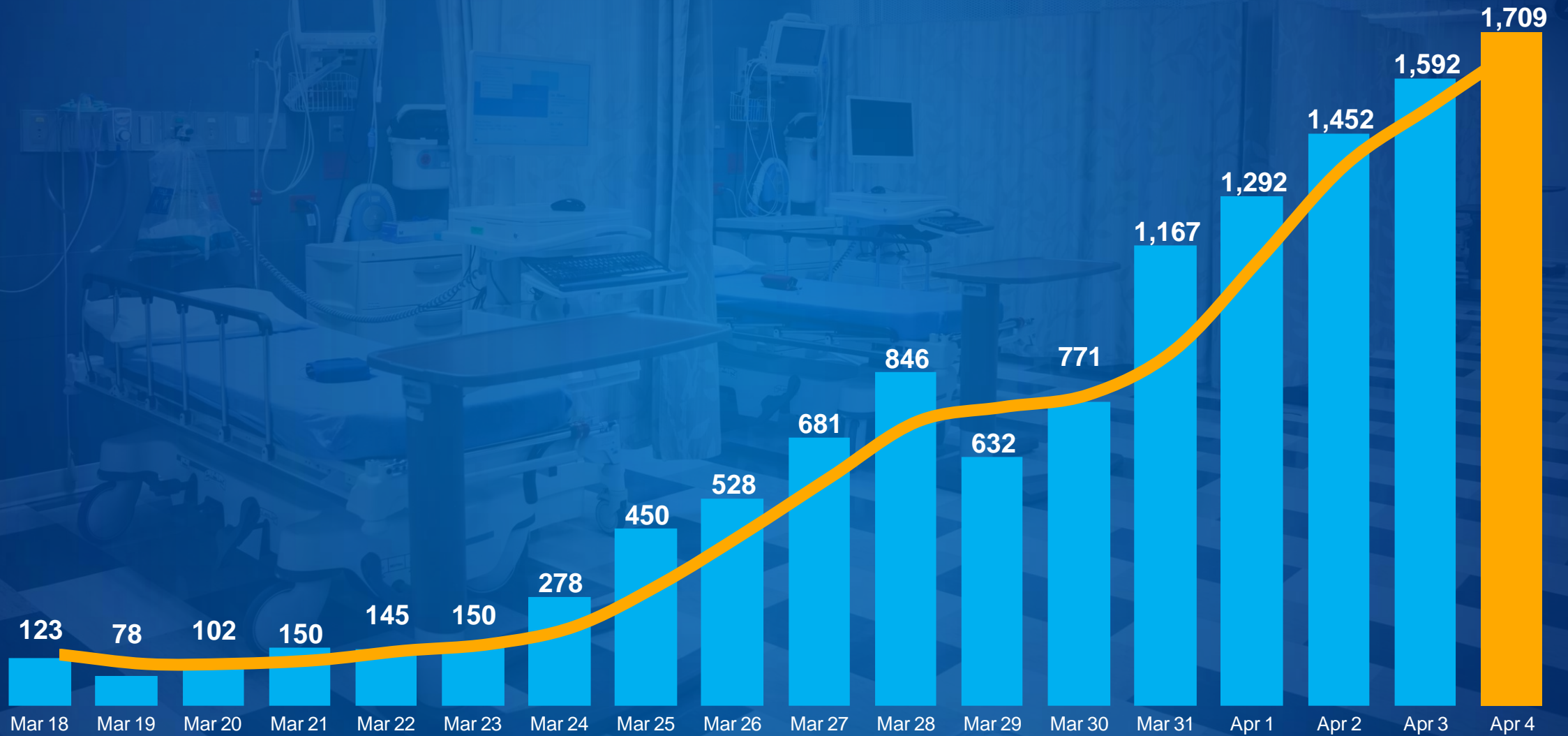
Change in Daily ICU Admissions



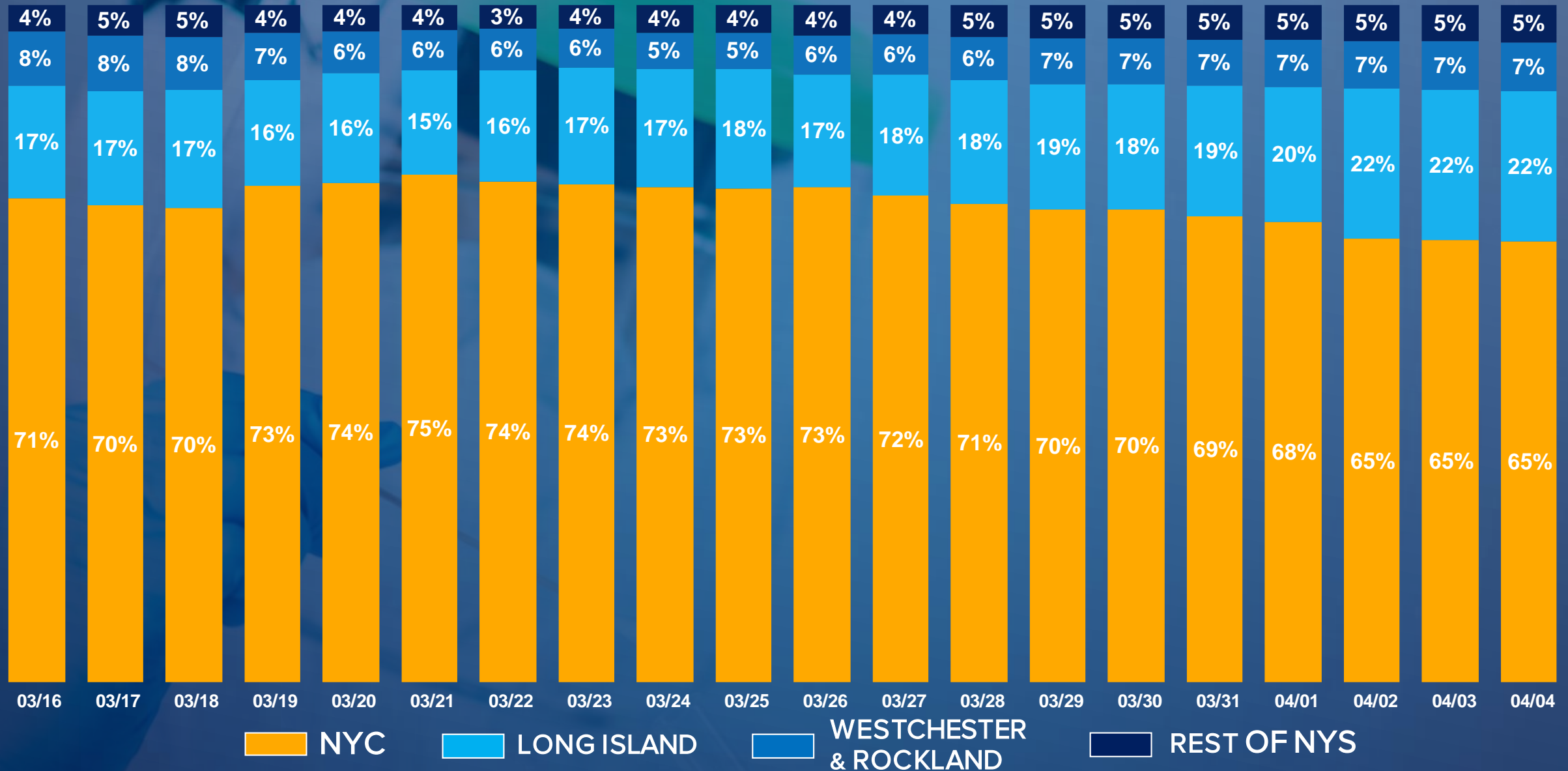
Change in Daily Intubations



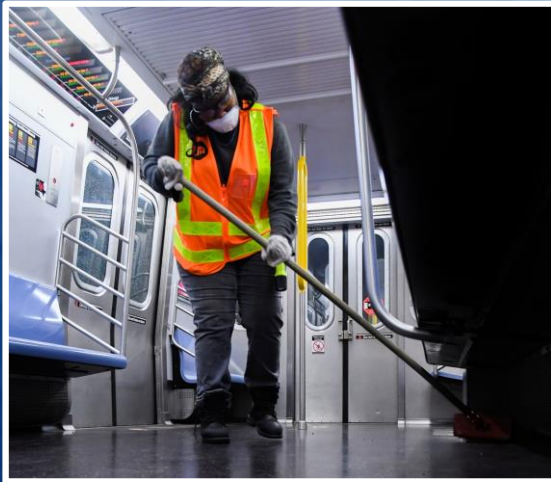
