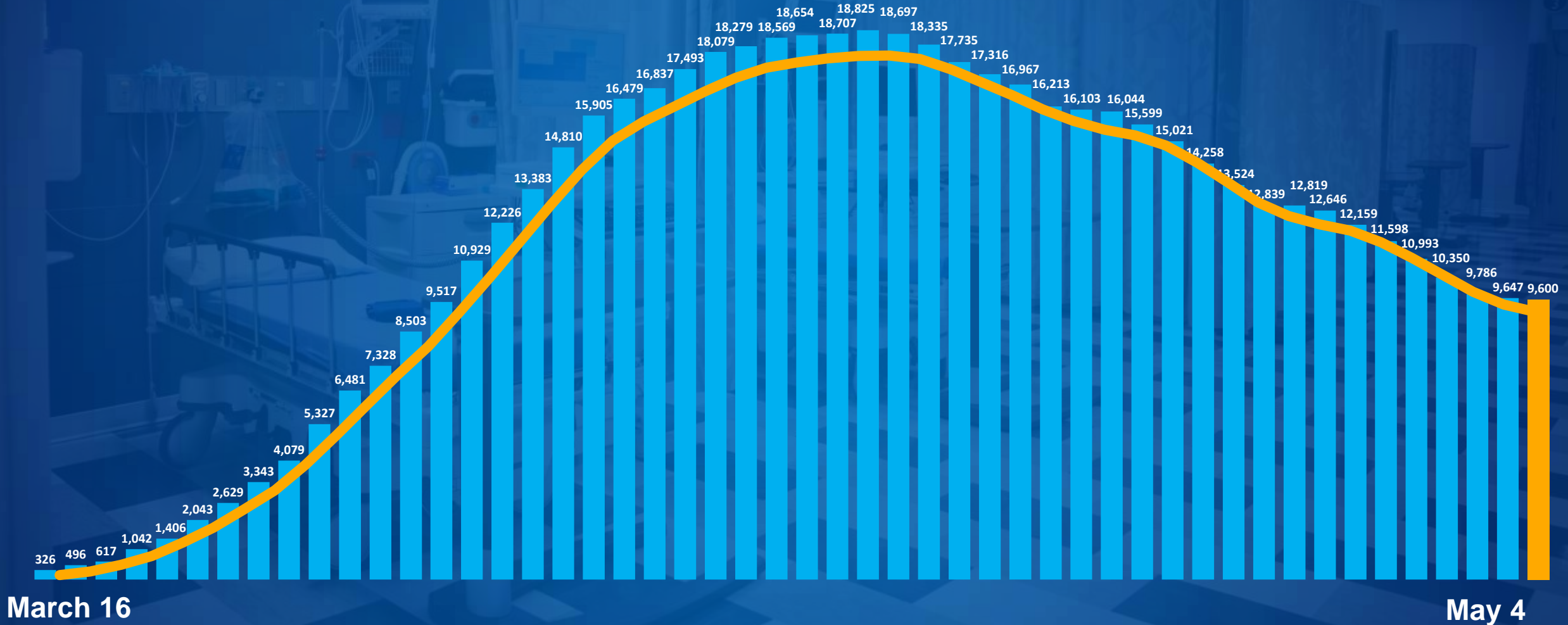

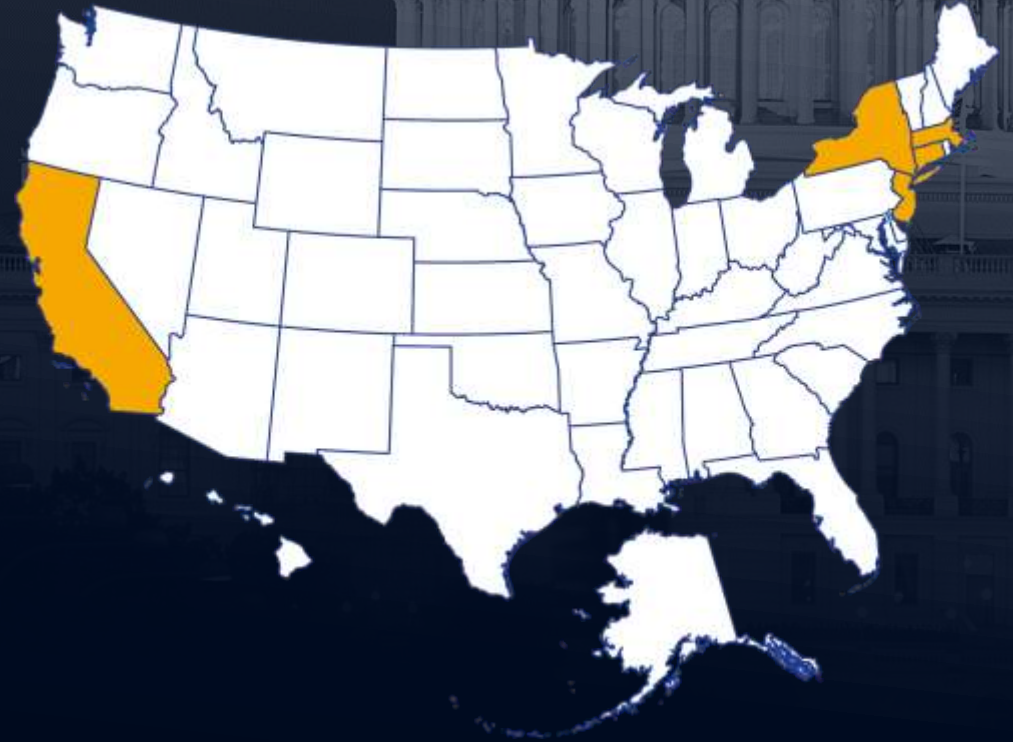
New York State since 2015...

Annual amount each state gives to federal government more than they receive back in federal spending.

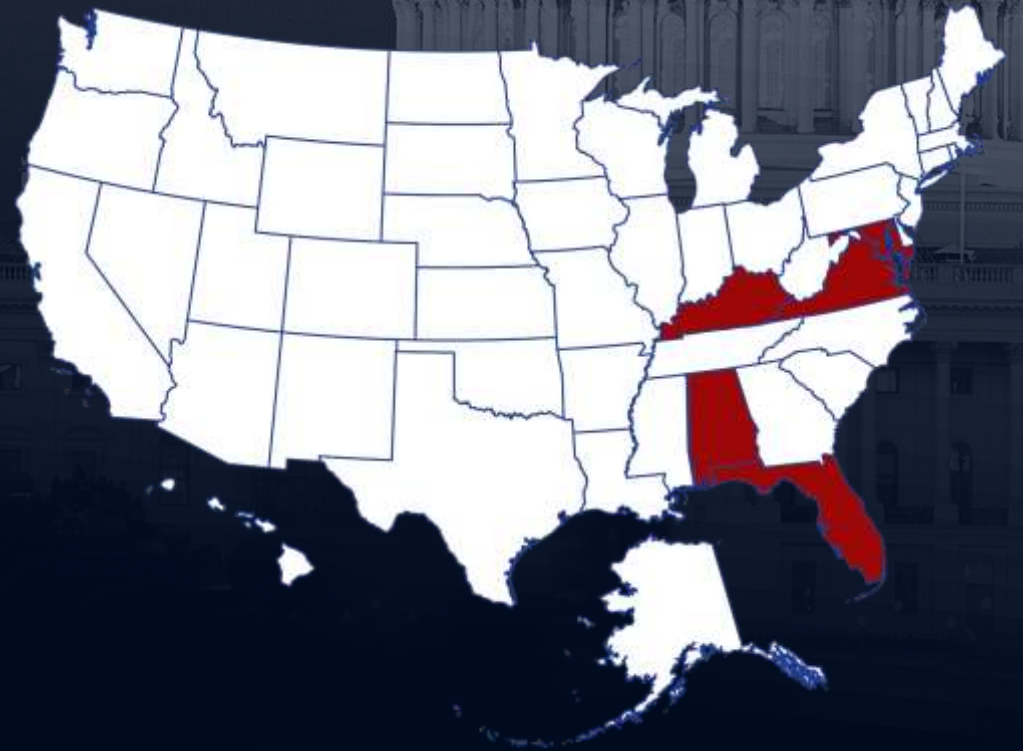


