TRAVEL ADVISORY UPDATE

The New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (State Parks) is advising the following:

Robert Moses remains closed. Captree State Park is open. Traffic along the Robert Moses Causeway and Ocean Parkway is light to moderate.

Jones Beach Field 2 and Field 6 remain closed. Traffic is moderate but flowing, parking is still available at: Fields 1,3,4, and Field 5 as well as the Field 10 fishing piers.

Park visitors may want to consider [Heckscher State Park](#) in East Islip as an alternative.

The New York State Parks website www.parks.ny.gov and the New York State Parks Explorer App will be updated with any park alerts and capacity closures.
