Robert Moses State Park

The New York State Office of Parks, Recreation and Historic Preservation (State Parks) is advising Robert Moses State Park has now filled to capacity. Park visitors are being advised to detour to Heckscher State Park where attendance is light.

Jones Beach traffic conditions are moderate with available parking at Fields 1, 3, 4, and 5 as well as the Field 10 Fishing Piers. Field 6 and Field 2 are filled. It is expected that Jones Beach will fill to capacity by noon today.

Park visitors may want to consider [Heckscher State Park](#) in East Islip as an alternative.
