continue, will significantly disrupt public transportation services and endanger the public's health, safety or welfare, and it appearing to the satisfaction of the Court that this is a proper case for granting an injunction pursuant to Government Code § 3614,

THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS THAT respondents Amalgamated Transit Union Local 1555; Service Employees International Union, Local 1021; American Federation Of State, County And Municipal Employees, Local 3993; San Francisco Bay Area Rapid Transit District; and their officers, agents, servants, employees, representatives, and members and all persons in active concert or participation with them are hereby restrained and enjoined from threatening or engaging in any strike or lockout for a period of 60 days, through and including midnight on October 10, 2013.
