The undersigned, being sworn says, on information and belief, that JASON FLETCHER did, in the County of Alameda, on or about **April 18, 2020**, commit a FELONY, to wit: VOLUNTARY MANSLAUGHTER, a violation of section 192(a) of the PENAL CODE of California, in that said defendant(s) did unlawfully and without malice kill STEVEN DEMARCO TAYLOR, a human being, in that said defendant acted upon a sudden quarrel and heat of passion and in the mistaken and unreasonable belief that he and another person was in imminent danger of death and great bodily injury and in the mistaken and unreasonable belief that the immediate use of deadly force was necessary to defend against the danger.
