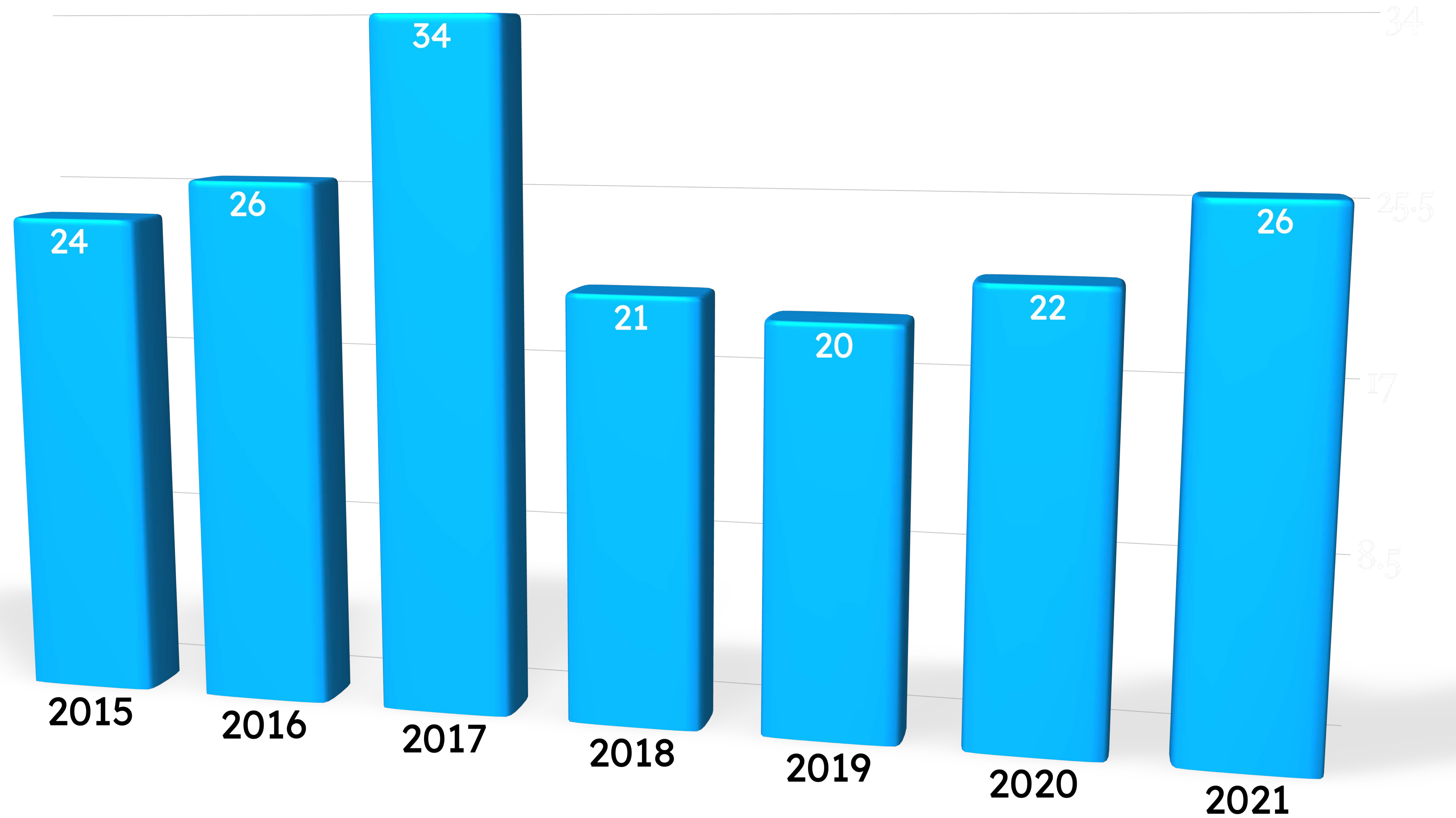

Part 1 Violent Crimes

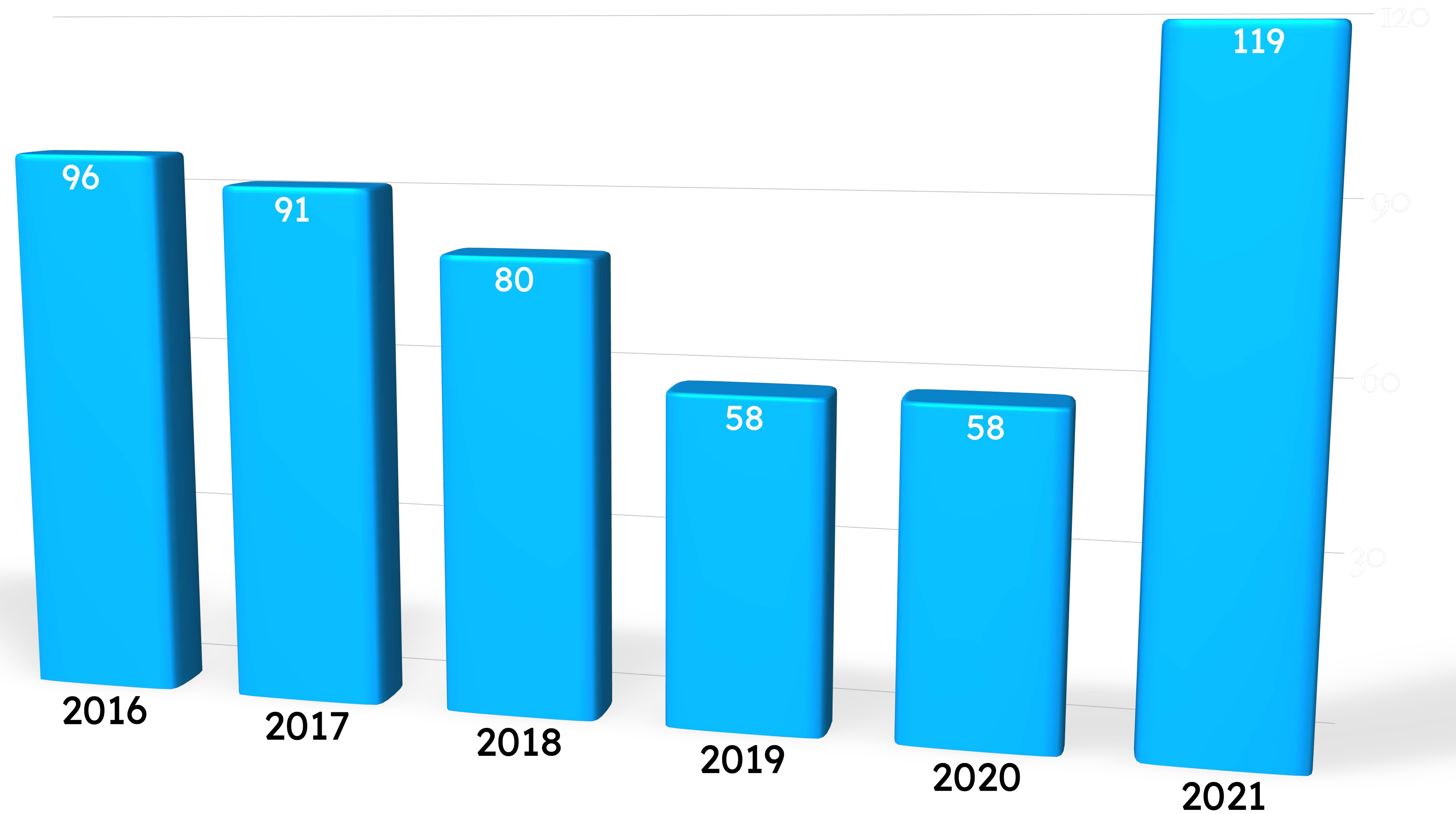
Homicides at Mid-Year

An uptick — although 2019 was a 58-year low-point.



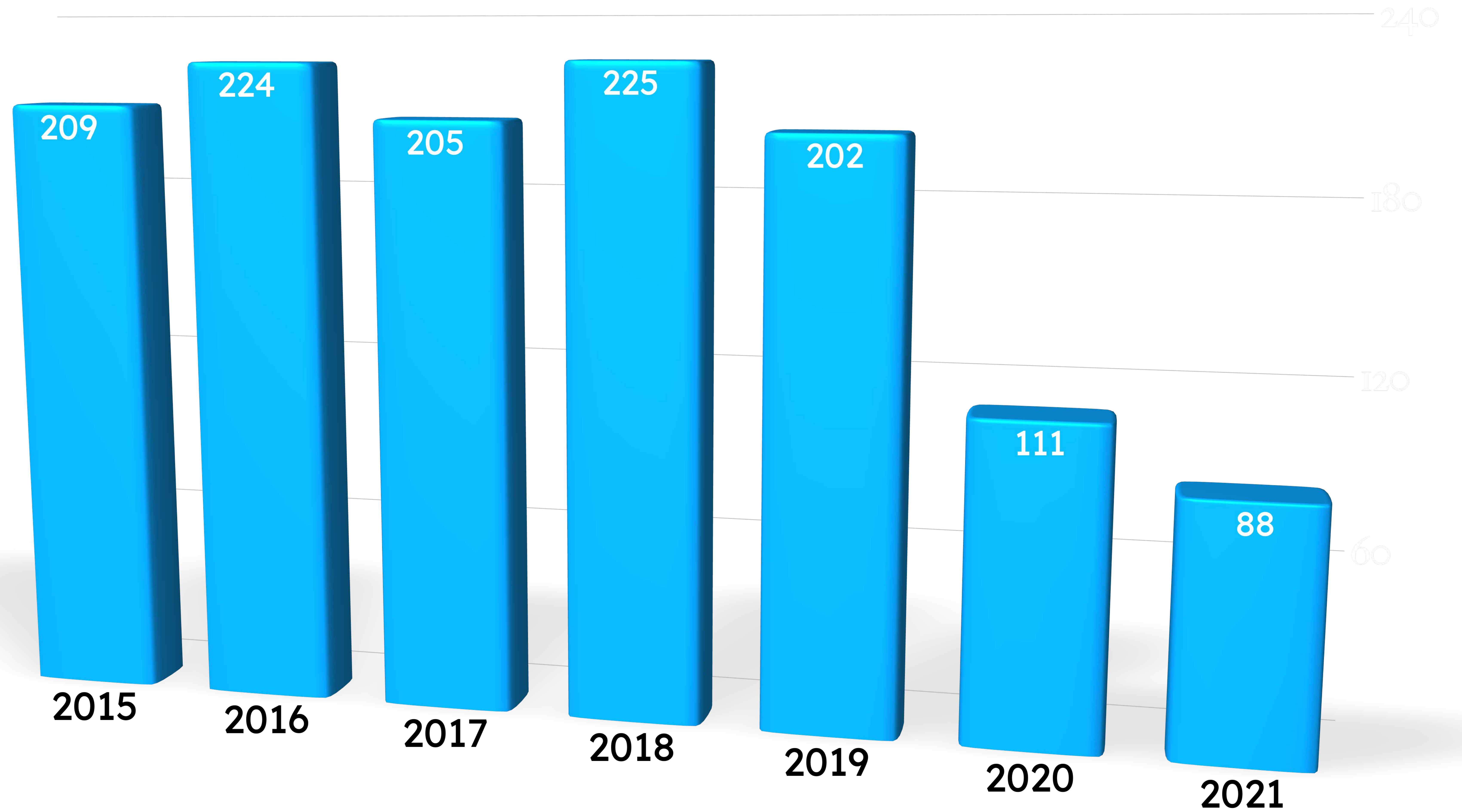
Gun Violence Victims at Mid-Year

Reflecting victims in both fatal and non-fatal shootings.



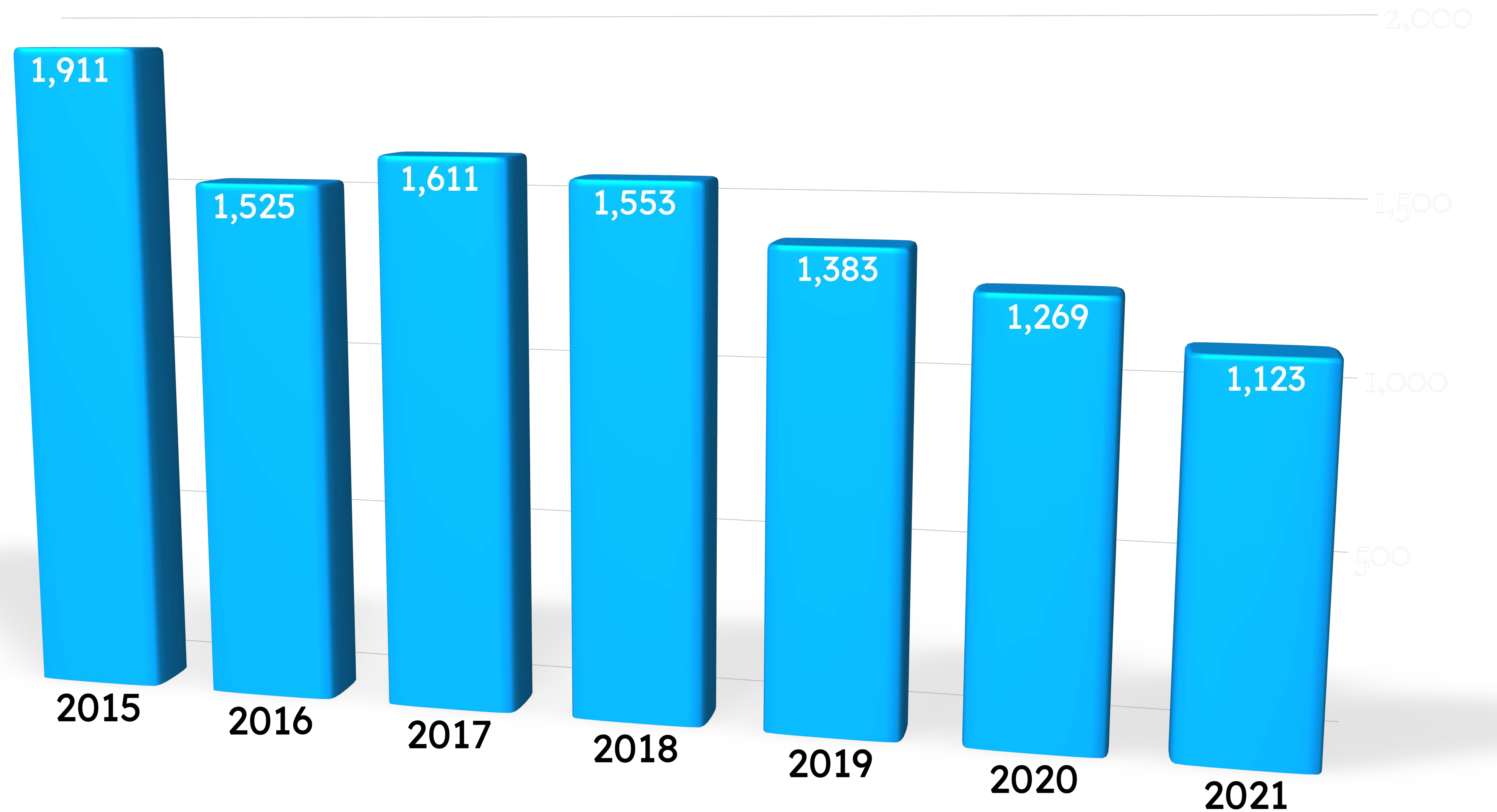
Rape Cases at Mid-Year

change that.



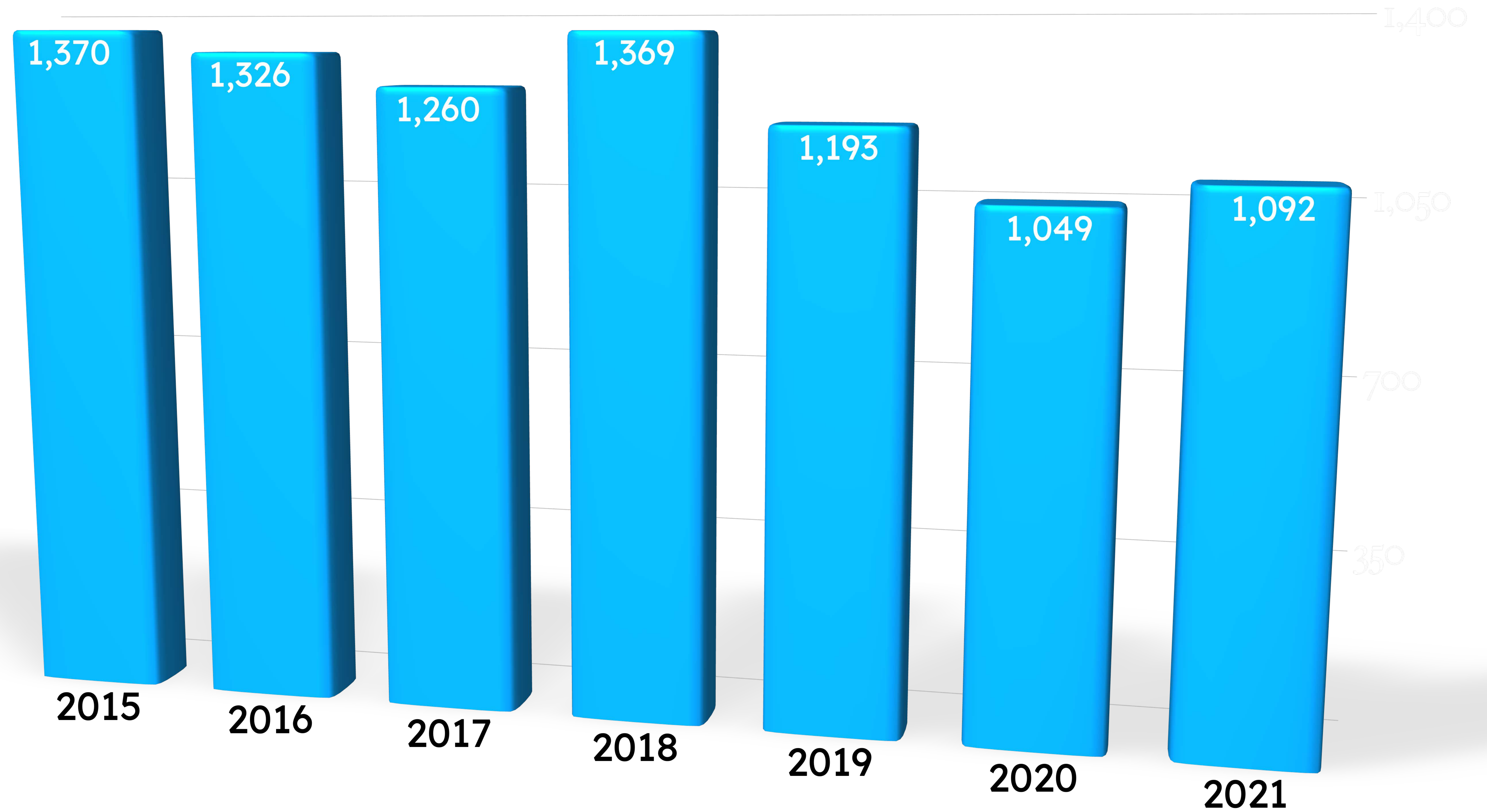
Robberies at Mid-Year

Aggravated Assaults at Mid-Year

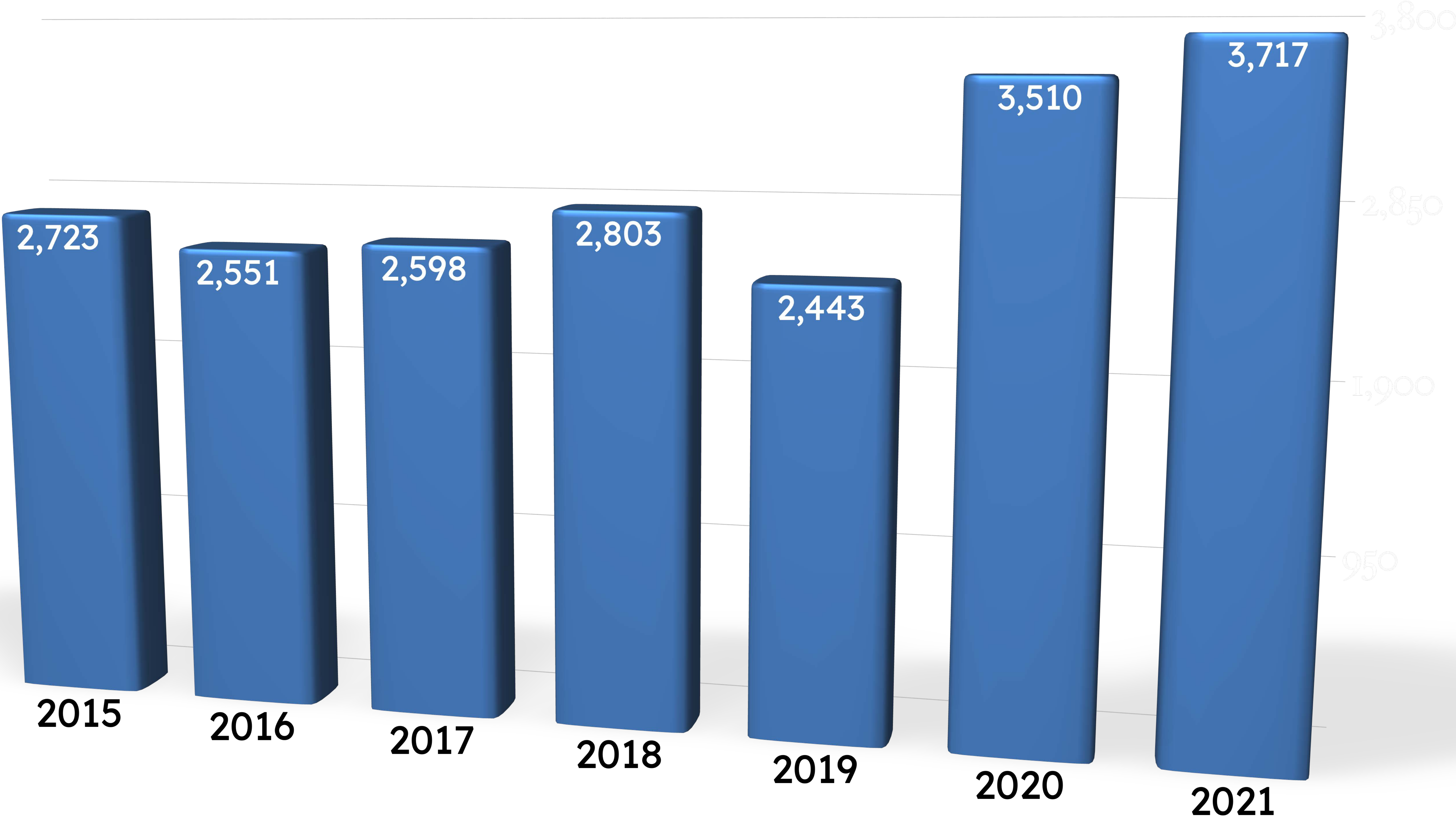
A slight uptick over last year — and a modest long-term decline.



Part 1 Property Crimes

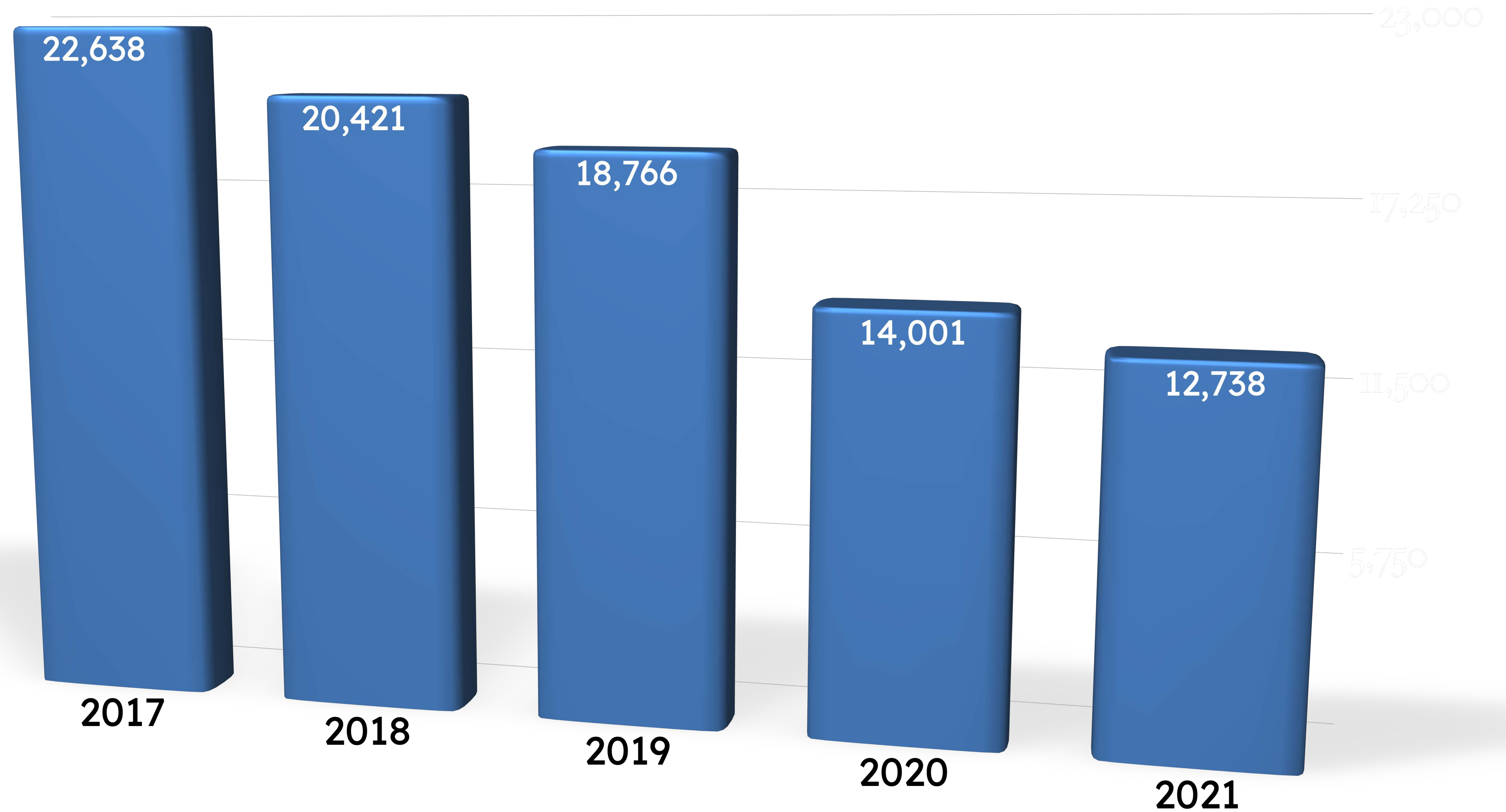
Burglaries at Mid-Year

Larceny/Theft at Mid-Year

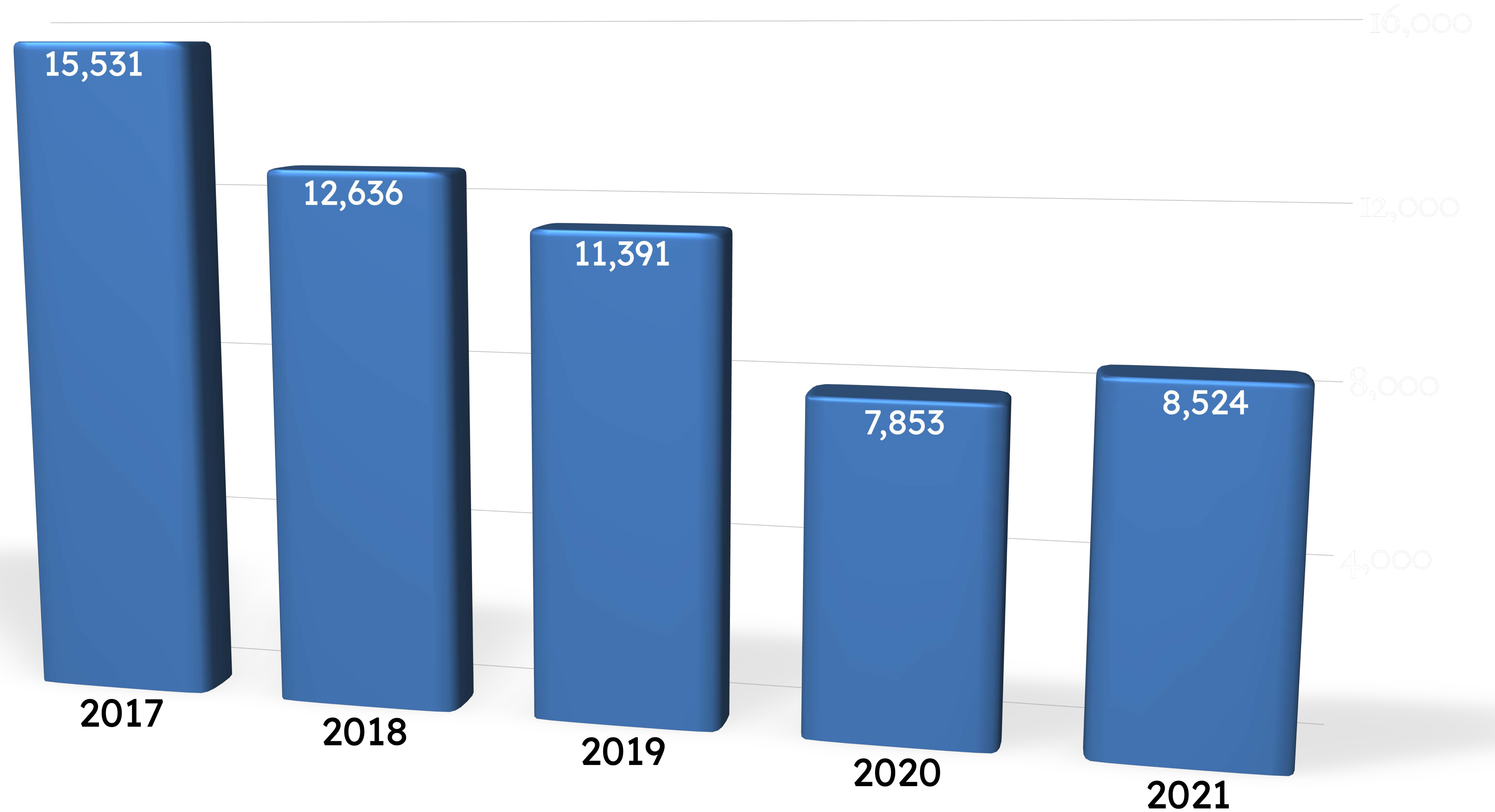
Steady decline

Larceny/Theft category includes thefts from vehicles.

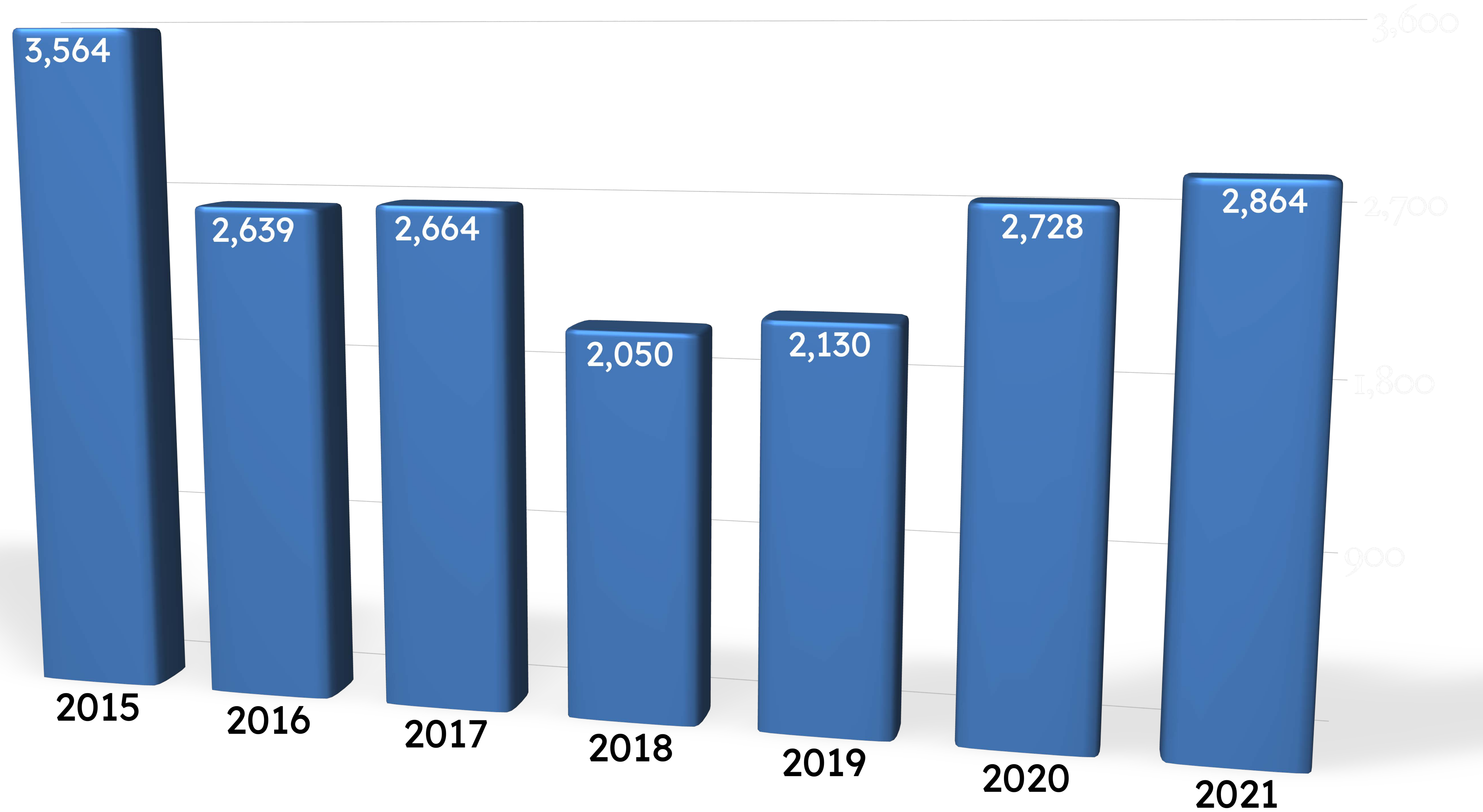
Car Break-Ins at Mid-Year

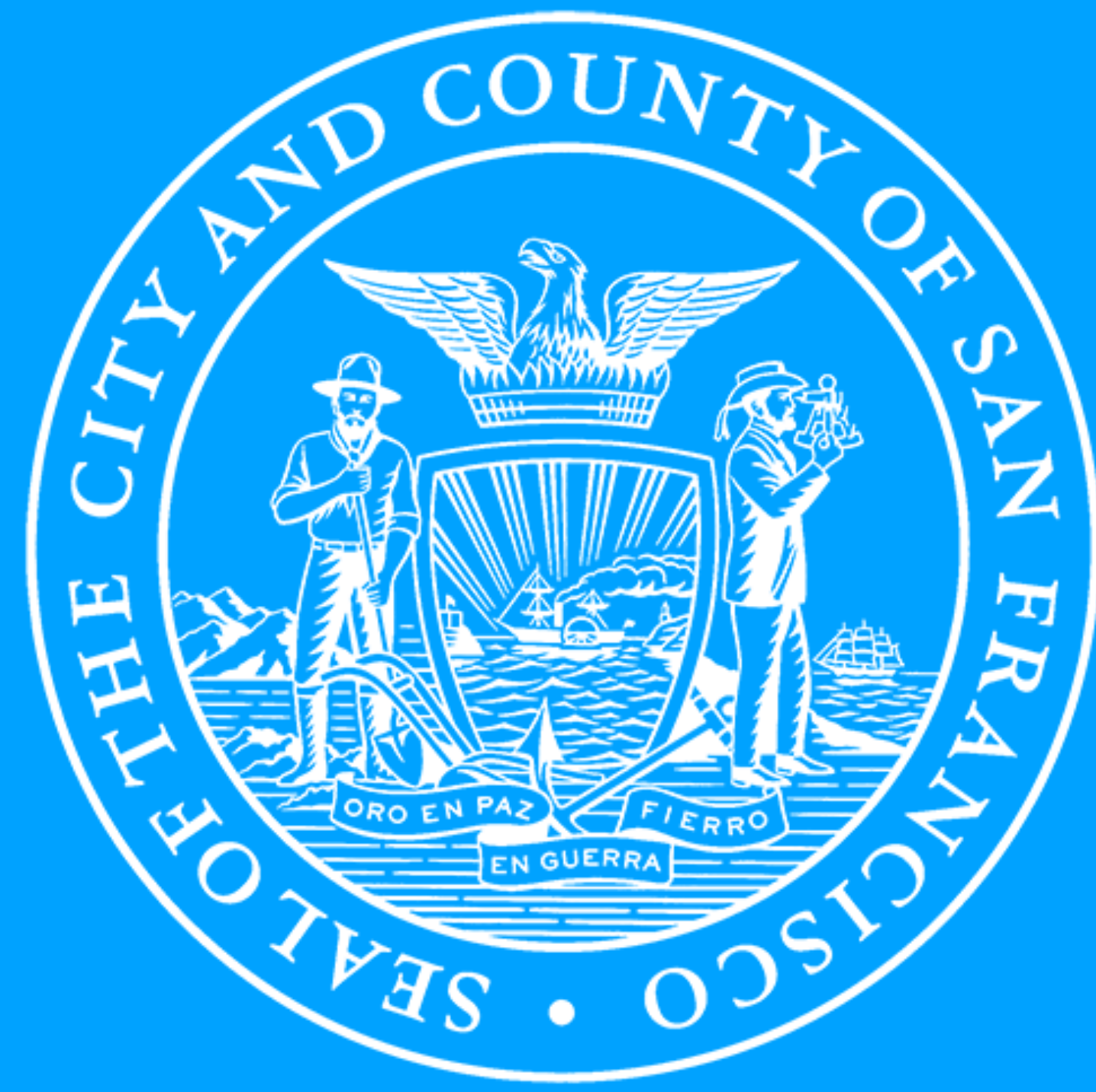
Modest uptick from 2020, but still in decline from 2017.



Auto Thefts at Mid-Year

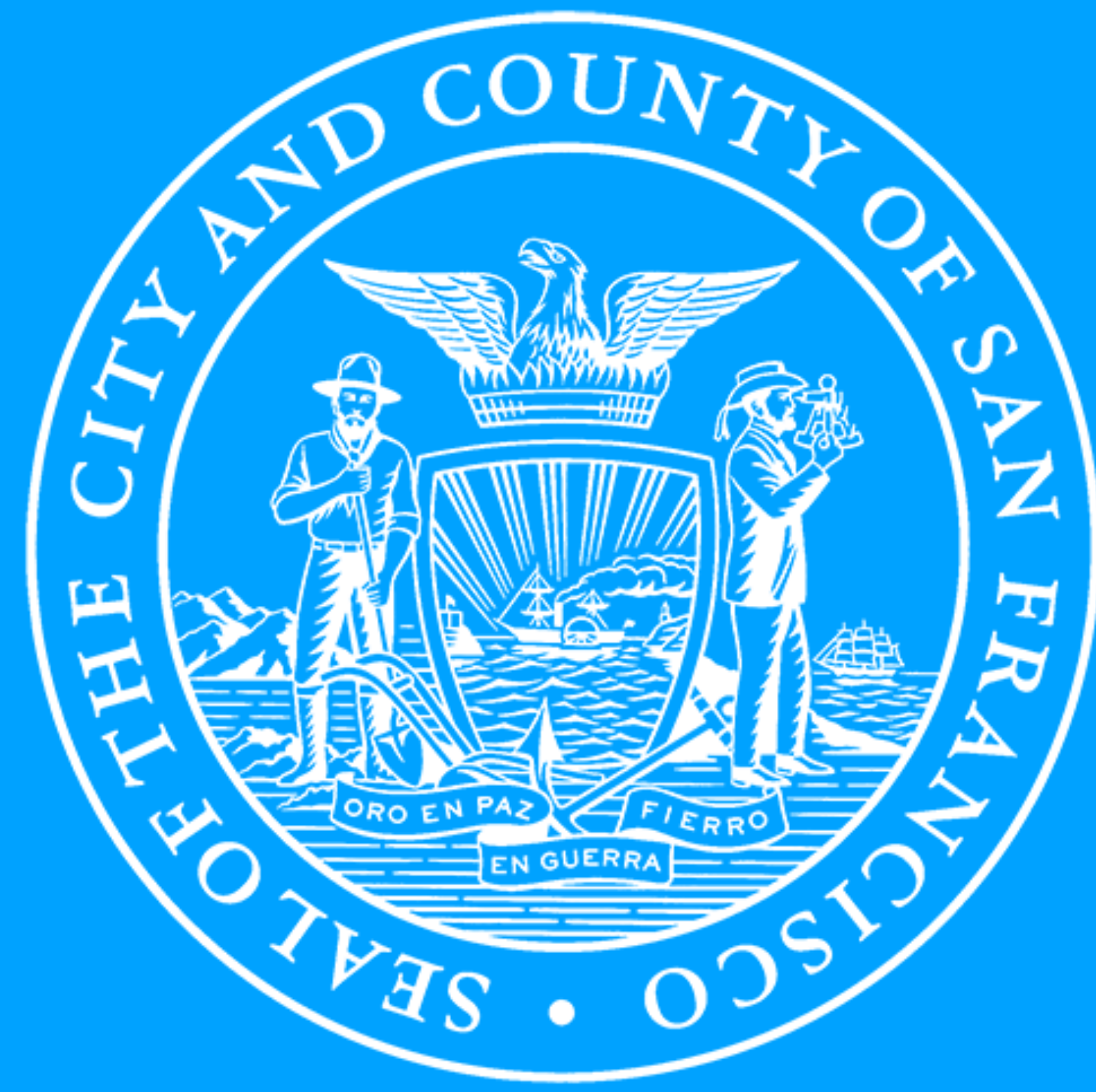
Not the trend
