

NATO Travel Checklist for Passengers

**Temporary conditions to boarding during NATO summit
May 19-21, 2012**

All Metra Riders

- ✓ May be subject to search before boarding or while en route.
- ✓ May carry only one bag not exceeding 15 inches by 15 inches by 4 inches deep (eg. a small purse or briefcase). Boxes, parcels, luggage, backpacks and bicycles will not be allowed on trains. Banned items cannot be stored at Metra stations. They must be removed or they will be disposed of.
- ✓ May not carry any food or liquids on the trains. This includes coffee and other beverages.
- ✓ May not carry any type of tools, pipes, stakes, wood or weapons, including pocket knives and pepper spray, on the trains.
- ✓ Law enforcement personnel must identify themselves and present their credentials and any weapons. Security guards will not be allowed to carry any weapons onboard.
- ✓ Failure to comply with instructions from law enforcement personnel or attempted avoidance of screening will result in ejection from the station or further police action.
- ✓ Passengers may see an increased law enforcement presence and K-9 units.

Metra Electric Line Riders

- ✓ It is recommended that **Electric Line** passengers arrive at their stations at least 15 minutes in advance of their train departure to allow sufficient time for the boarding process. Expect delays en route of up to 15 minutes as trains pass through the Summit site. Trains will depart on a revised schedule available on our website www.metrarail.com.
