

BLOOD DRIVE, GREYHOUND ADOPTION EVENT SUNDAY

IN MEMORY OF NAPERVILLE WOMAN & HER LOYAL COMPANION

WHAT: A year ago this November, Emily Driscoll, 22, and her rescue greyhound, Quincy, were killed when they were hit by a car while crossing the street in Naperville.

In her and Quincy's memory, the Driscoll family, LifeSource, and the animal rescue group Greyhounds Only will join together and host a memorial blood drive and Greyhound adoption event.

Nearby Culver's of Aurora will be on site to dish out free scoops of custard, while Culver's owners Jim and Judy DiVerde will donate 10% of that day's Culver's lunchtime sales to Greyhounds Only, the group which brought Emily and Quincy together before their tragic deaths.
