**NARRATIVES**

EVENT# 13478, BWC WAS RECORDING, HOWEVER VICTIM/CALLER REQUESTED BWC'S TO STOP RECORDING UPON ARRIVAL. HOLDS PLACED ON BWC OF BEAT 920 AND BEAT 924. BEAT 5200 AND 900 WERE ON SCENE. IN SUMMARY, R/O'S ARRIVED ON SCENE AT 12 W 33RD PLACE REGARDING A CHECK THE WELL BEING CALL AND THE OFFENDER HAD LEFT. R/O'S SPOKE WITH [REDACTED] (VICTIM [REDACTED]) WHO STATED THAT SHE WANTED TO SHOW R/O'S SOMETHING UPSTAIRS THAT SHE FELT NEEDED TO BE REPORTED. R/O'S OBSERVED NO VISIBLE INJURIES ON VICTIM, NOR DID VICTIM LOOK DISTRESSED OR RELATE THAT ANY BATTERY HAD OCCURRED. R/O'S PASSED AN INDIVIDUAL WHO WAS SITTING IN ANOTHER ROOM AND VICTIM ACTED NONCHALANTLY AS IF HE WAS NOT AN OFFENDER AND VICTIM DID NOT POINT OUT THE INDIVIDUAL WAS THE OFFENDER. R/O AIMERS STOOD BY ON THE FIRST FLOOR IN CASE SGT. HUBBARD #2050 AND PPO APOSTOLOV'S #19615 INVESTIGATION ON THE SECOND FLOOR DISCOVERED THAT AN OFFENDER WAS STILL PRESENT AND NEARBY. WHEN SGT. HUBBARD AND PPO APOSTOLOV ENTERED VICTIM'S 2ND FLOOR BEDROOM, VICTIM SHOWED OFFICERS BURNT CLOTHING ON A BURNT COMFORTER. VICTIM THEN RELATED, NON-VERBATIM, THAT EARLIER AROUND 1900HRS, A HEATED ALTERCATION DEVELOPED DURING A CONVERSATION WITH [REDACTED] (OFFENDER [REDACTED]) IN THEIR BEDROOM OVER THEIR RELATIONSHIP. OFFENDER TOOK A LYSOL CAN AND A LIGHTER WITH THE INTENTION TO LIGHT VICTIM'S LISTED CLOTHES ON FIRE, WHICH RESULTED IN SMALL FLAMES ON THE CLOTHES LYING ON THE BED AND COMFORTER. THE VICTIM ATTEMPTED TO STOP THE OFFENDER FROM DOING FURTHER DAMAGE AT WHICH POINT THE OFFENDER GRABBED THE VICTIM BY BOTH ARMS AND MOVED HER ASIDE AND ON BWC VICTIM RELATED SHE THEN PUSHED OFFENDER OFF HER. VICTIM WAS ABLE TO PAT OUT THE SMALL FLAMES AND OFFENDER LEFT THE BEDROOM. BY THE TIME THE OFFENDER INFORMATION WAS GATHERED, SGT HUBBARD STATED SHE RELOCATED IMMEDIATELY TO THE FIRST FLOOR AND DISCOVERED THE OFFENDER LEFT THE PROPERTY IN AN UNKNOWN DIRECTION. R/O AIMERS



NARRATIVES

OBSERVED THE OFFENDER LEAVE THE RESIDENCE WITH NO SUSPICION THAT HE WAS THE OFFENDER. WHEN VICTIM CAME DOWN AND SPOKE TO R/O AIMERS, SHE REPEATED THE DETAILS OF THE INCIDENT AND IDENTIFIED THE INDIVIDUAL ON THE FIRST FLOOR AS THE OFFENDER [REDACTED] WHO HAD ALREADY LEFT THE SCENE. R/O AIMERS ASKED VICTIM WHY SHE DID NOT PROVIDE THIS INFORMATION WHILE OFFENDER WAS ON SCENE, THE VICTIM STATED, NON-VERBATIM, THAT SHE DID NOT WANT HIM ARRESTED BECAUSE SHE FELT HE WAS ACTING OUT DUE TO EXTRA STRESS IN HIS LIFE AND ONLY WANTED A REPORT. VICTIM STATED THAT SHE IS DECLINING EMS AND R/O'S AGAIN DID NOT SEE ANY VISIBLE INJURIES. VICTIM ALSO DECLINED TO BE RELOCATED. BEAT 900 ENROUTE TO THE LOCATION AT APPROX. 2210HRS. UPON ARRIVAL COMMANDER JEROME #57 ENSURED SGT. HUBBARD'S BWC WAS ACTIVATED. BEAT 900 OFFERED MEDICAL ATTENTION TO VICTIM WHICH SHE DECLINED. BEAT 900 INQUIRED IF VICTIM FELT SAFE AND OFFERED ASSISTANCE TO BE RELOCATED. VICTIM RELATED SHE DID NOT EXPECT THE OFFENDER TO RETURN. VICTIM RELATED THE OFFENDER BATTERED HER 3 TIMES IN THE PAST BUT SHE DID NOT REPORT THE INCIDENTS. BEAT 900 AND BEAT 920 ENSURED THE VICTIM DID NOT NEED FURTHER ASSISTANCE AND DEACTIVATED BWC. VICTIM DID REQUEST PHOTOS TO BE TAKEN OF HER BURNED GARMENTS AND BEDDING. EVIDENCE TECHNICIAN WAS REQUESTED AT 2011 HRS AND ET CARTER #16084 ARRIVED ON SCENE AT 2258HRS. COMMANDER HOWARD STAR# 501 BEAT# 5200 WAS ON SCENE. R/O'S PROVIDED VICTIM WITH A VIN AND DIN. R/O'S EXPLAINED ORDER OF PROTECTION AND WARRANT PROCEDURE AND ADVISED CONTACTING THE 24HR DOMESTIC VIOLENCE HOTLINE #877-863-6338 WAS PROVIDED. SGT HUBBARD ADVISED [REDACTED] THAT EAP SERVICES ARE AVAILABLE THROUGH THE DEPARTMENT. BEAT 900X AND BEAT 999 WERE NOTIFIED. ET REQUESTED. AREA CENTRAL DETECTIVE MYLES #21442, BEAT 5125 WAS NOTIFIED. CPIC MOOREHEAD #6612 WAS NOTIFIED. NEWS AFFAIRS JARA # 17406 WAS NOTIFIED.
