On 1/30/14 at approximately 1932 hrs., I (Ptl. Bruton) was stationary in the left turn lane of Rt. 130 South. While observing traffic, I observed a dark colored four door vehicle travelling South with the driver's side headlight out.

At that time, I safely made the U-turn onto Rt. 130 South and began to follow the suspect vehicle. While following the suspect vehicle, I could see it moving from left to right travelling with the passenger side tires crossing over the center white dotted line. While navigating through traffic I observed the suspect vehicle accelerate at a high rate of speed. As I continued to monitor the vehicle, I could observe the suspect vehicle continue to fail to maintain the left lane of travel. As I closed the distance between my patrol vehicle and the suspect vehicle I was able to pace the suspect vehicle at over 70 miles per hour. As both the suspect vehicle and I came into the area of Work Out World, I activated my emergency overhead warning lights and conducted a motor vehicle stop in the area of Rt. 130 South and Daphne's diner.

Once stopped, I approached the passenger's side of the vehicle to make contact with the driver who was the only occupant of the vehicle. While attempting to gain the driver's attention, The driver began to exit his vehicle through the driver's side door. I advised the driver to remain in his vehicle and requested his credentials. The driver then sat in the driver's seat and attempted to lower the passenger's side window. Due to the window being inoperable, I opened the passenger's door. Upon opening the door, I was able to detect an overwhelming odor of an alcoholic beverage emanating from within the vehicle. I again requested the driver's credentials and at that time he reached into his pocket and removed a yellow colored badge and stated he worked for Jersey City Police. Concerned as to why his badge was just sitting in his pocket, I requested the driver to provide his Jersey City Police Dept. Identification Card. The driver then began fumbling through documents located in a brown leather wallet. Once he provided a Jersey City Police Identification Card, I could see that it was severely worn on the front to the point that it was unidentifiable except for the writing of his name (Vincent Corso), his rank of Sergeant and "Jersey City Police Department" written over a blue background with a severely faded New Jersey State Seal in the center. I then turned the Identification card over and could see that the card was expired 3/13/12. I then requested Mr. Corso's driver's license to confirm the identification did in fact belong to him. I then returned to my vehicle and requested dispatch to make contact with Jersey City Police to further confirm Mr. Corso's employment.

While in my patrol vehicle, Mr. Corso exited his vehicle and staggered towards my patrol car. I advised Mr. Corso to return to his vehicle and that I would be with him in a moment. Mr. Corso then asked for the reason I stopped him. I advised Mr. Corso of the driver side headlight being out. Mr. Corso then staggered back to his vehicle and confirmed same then sat back down in the driver's seat. during that time, Dispatch was able to confirm that he was in fact an employee with the Jersey City Police Department. While determining a course of action, Ptl. Borges arrived on location. Upon Ptl. Borges arrival, Mr. Corso again exited his vehicle and inquired as to what was going on. Ptl. Borges then advised Mr. Corso that he was no longer allowed to operate his vehicle. See Ptl. Borges Supplemental Investigation report I-2014-002450. While speaking with Mr. Corso and confirming he was in fact a police officer, Mr. Corso was asked if he had a weapon in his possession. Mr. Corso initially advised that he did not, then recanted his statement stating of course he did because he is a police officer. At that time, Ptl. Borges and I advised Mr. Corso that we were going to take control of his weapon for the time being. Mr. Corso initially resisted by stating "No don't do this to me". Mr. Corso was then turned by Ptl. Borges and I to face Ptl. Borges' vehicle and I began to lift Mr. Corso's arms away from his body. Mr. Corso again began to turn to the right to face Ptl. Borges and I continuing to state "Don't, don't, don't". Mr. Corso was stopped and advised not to fight us in any way. At that time I had firm grasp of Mr. Corso's outer jacket approximately mid forearm. Mr. Corso was then turned back towards Ptl. Borges' vehicle and advised that we were only taking the weapon for safe keeping. Mr. Corso then began to turn his body the opposite way to face Ptl. Borges and I and attempted to take a step towards his personal vehicle. Mr. Corso was again stopped and advised not to fight with us. Mr. Corso then attempted to rip his arm from my grasp. Concerned for Ptl. Borges and my safety as well as Mr. Corso's, I placed Mr. Corso into a compliance hold with his right arm behind his back and his chest resting on the hood of patrol car #18. Mr. Corso's firearm (Glock 19 Serial # XK303) was then removed from his waist band. Once removed, Mr. Corso was checked further for any more weapons and then placed into the rear of patrol car #15. The weapon was then unloaded and found to have 14 hollow point rounds in the magazine and nothing in the chamber. Both the weapon and the loaded magazine were secured in the trunk of patrol car #18. While securing the weapon, Sgt. Bakay and Sgt. Swanhart arrived on location. At that time, a tow truck was

requested for the vehicle and I transported Mr. Corso back to police headquarters.

Back at police headquarters, Mr. Corso was placed in the interview room. Mr. Corso was advised to wait until his ride arrived. Sgt. Bakay then notified Jersey City Police in reference to to situation and requested someone to come and pick him up. See Sgt. Bakay's Supplemental Investigation report I-2014-002450.

Upon arrival of Jersey City Police Lt. James Carroll and Sgt. Robert Kearns, the keys to Mr. Corso's vehicle and his duty weapon were turned over. Lt. Carroll and Sgt. Kearns then secured Mr. Corso's weapon and removed all uniforms and duty gear from Mr. Corso's personal vehicle. The vehicle was then secured in the parking lot of RTPD Headquarters. Mr. Corso was turned over to both Lt. Carroll and Sgt. Kearns. I then cleared without further incident.

On this date I (Ptl Borges) was monitoring the police radio when I heard Ptl Bruton initiate a motor vehicle stop. At the time of his stop I was dispatched to a parking complaint at the Loft's. As I was clearing the complaint I heard RO O'Connor ask Ptl Bruton what rank the individual was. At that time I began to proceed over to assist Ptl Bruton at his stop location.  I arrived at Ptl Bruton's stop location (Rt 130 SB IFO Daphne's Diner). Upon my arrival Ptl Bruton exited his marked patrol vehicle #15 and approached this Officer. Ptl Bruton informed me that the driver was a Sergeant from Jersey City. He then showed me an ID card from Jersey City PD. Ptl Bruton then advised that the subject appeared to be intoxicated. As Ptl Bruton and I were speaking the driver exited his vehicle. Ptl Bruton stated to him to get back in the vehicle. The individual continued walking towards Officers stating something to the effect of comon brother. I quickly noted a strong...

odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his breath. I then asked him if he had consumed any alcoholic beverages and he stated no and that he was good. I asked him again and he continued to say no. At this time I asked him if he was going to work and he stated no I just got off. I then asked him again if he was going to work since information that was obtained advised that the individual was suppose to be relieving another Sgt. from Jersey City. The individual asked if there was a problem, I advised him that there was and that it was he was highly intoxicated. He then stated I'll just park the car over there. He was told that if he entered that vehicle I would arrest him for DWI. He then stated that he understood. He then told us that we could park the car.

During the stop and interview the subject continued calling everyone "Brother" even after being told several times that this Officer was not a brother. He stated we're all brothers.

At some point during the interview the subject began to walk away. He stated that he was good. I then asked him if there was someone that could come to pick him up because he was not going to drive the vehicle any further. He then stated that he could call his wife. When asked where would she be coming from he stated Lincroft NJ.

I then asked the subject if he had a weapon on him, he innately stated no, then said yes I do I'm a cop. With that I advised Ptl Bruton that we needed to secure his weapon due to the level of intoxication. Upon hearing this the subject immediately began saying no don't do that. He repeated this phrase a few times. Ptl Bruton at that time took hold of the subjects jacket from behind and was reaching for the weapon when the subject began pulling away from him. He continued to mumble that he would just park the car and then would walk home. He was advised that if he entered the vehicle he would be arrested for DWI.

As Officers were attempting to remove the weapon the subject attempted to pull away again. He was then placed face down onto the hood of car #18 so that we could continue to remove the weapon. It was at that time during the encounter I requested a supervisor to our location to assist with the subject. Sgt Bakay and Sgt Swanhart arrived on location a few minutes after the request.

The weapon was removed from the subject and placed on the hood of marked patrol vehicle #18. Ptl Bruton made the weapon safe by removing the fully loaded magazine. Ptl Bruton also advised me that there was not a chambered round. We were able to identify the weapon as a 9mm Glock, with a magazine of hollow point ammunition. I was also advised that the weapon was not secured in a holster instead it was stuck inside the individuals waist line of his sweat pants. He was then placed in the rear seat of marked patrol vehicle #15. While attempting to place him in the vehicle he continued stating please don't do this I'm a cop.

Upon arrival of Sgt Bakay and Sgt Swanhart they were advised of the situation and further that the subject was in possession of a weapon. The Sgt's were advised that the weapon was now secured in the trunk of marked patrol vehicle #18. Further they were advised that the subject appeared to be under the influence of alcohol and could not safely operate a motor vehicle.

I then requested a tow truck so that the vehicle maybe towed back to headquarters for safe keeping. Officers observed a Jersey City uniform and gun belt in the front passengers compartment. RO O'Connor advised that Mackey's would be the tow.

Upon arrival of Mackey's towing same was brought back to headquarters.

At the station Sgt Bakay advised that he was in contact with Superior Officers from Jersey City and that they would be making arrangements to pick up the subject.

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On the above date and time I (SGT. BAKAY) was at RTPD Headquarters assisting PTL. EMMONS with a domestic violence arrest when PTL. BORGES requested a supervisor to respond to her location.																	
**NOTE: PTL. BORGES was assisting PTL. BRUTON on a motor vehicle stop on RT. 130 SOUTH / DAPHNE'S DINER.**																	
Upon hearing the urgency in PTL. BORGES radio transmission, I immediately left RTPD Headquarters and responded to this location (with activated emergency lights and sirens). As I arrived to assist PTL. BORGES and PTL. BRUTON, I was advised by both officers that the subject initially stopped was highly intoxicated and that he was an "off duty" Sergeant with the Jersey City Police Dept. (identified as: VINCENT C. COROSO). I was further advised that MR. COROSO was armed with a handgun (which had been...

secured) and that MR. COROSO was now seated in the rear of RTPD Patrol Car# 15. PTL. BRUTON and PTL. BORGES stated to me that while attempting to secure MR. COROSO'S Glock 19 (9mm) handgun that he put up a struggle and failed to comply with their requests to cooperate. PTL. BORGES advised me that a brief struggle ensued with MR. COROSO and compliance holds needed to be utilized in order to secure his weapon for "safe keeping". Upon gathering this information, I opened the front passenger door to RTPD Patrol Car# 15 and identified myself as a Sergeant for the Robbinsville Twp. Police Department. I advised MR. COROSO that I was not pleased that he failed to cooperate with PTL. BORGES and PTL. BRUTON and tried explaining to him the seriousness of the events that transpired. During this course of conversation, MR. COROSO advised me that he too was a Sergeant with the Jersey City Police Dept. and I could detect a strong odor of an alcoholic beverage emitting from his person.

SGT. SWANHART also arrived at this location to assist with PTL. BORGES' request for a supervisor and was advised of the situation.

After being briefed in greater detail by PTL. BRUTON of the events leading up to the motor vehicle stop and thereafter, I determined that the best course of action at the time was to summon a tow truck to bring MR. COROSO'S vehicle (NJREG: FP8277) to the parking lot area of RTPD Headquarters. I advised PTL. BRUTON to transport MR. COROSO to RTPD Headquarters and that I would attempt to contact a supervisor of the Jersey City Police Department to advise him of the situation (in hopes that a fellow officer would be detailed to respond to RTPD Headquarters to take custody of MR. COROSO'S handgun, uniforms and to ensure that MR. COROSO was taken home safely without further incident). I then returned to RTPD Patrol Car#15 and advised MR. COROSO of the same intended course of action should both he and his department cooperate.

PTL. BORGES was detailed to await the tow truck while PTL. BRUTON transported MR. COROSO to RTPD Headquarters. I also returned to RTPD Headquarters and MR. COROSO was placed in the Detective interview room. Once MR. COROSO was placed in the interview room, I contacted LT. POLASKI of the situation. After speaking to LT. POLASKI, I contacted CAPTAIN HUSSEY of the Jersey City Police Dept. (201)-889-6445 and advised him of the situation and requested that a Jersey City Police Officer respond to RTPD Headquarters so that MR. COROSO'S duty gun could be released and documented accordingly on a property report with this department. I also advised CAPTAIN HUSSEY that MR. COROSO was not under arrest and that we were attempting to extend a "professional courtesy" in hopes that the Jersey City Police Dept. would comply with our request for an officer of that department to take custody of MR. COROSO, his weapon, and his uniforms. CAPTAIN HUSSEY assured me that he would be detailing an officer to respond to RTPD to assist with our requests and soon thereafter advised me that a Sergeant from that agency would be responding.

Within a reasonable period of time, LT. JAMES CARROLL and SGT. ROBERT KEARNS (from the Jersey City Police Dept.) arrived at RTPD Headquarters. Both officers were advised of the totality of the situation and agreed with our request to take custody of MR. COROSO, his weapon, and his uniforms. LT. CARROLL and SGT. KEARNS were also advised that MR. COROSO'S vehicle was also in our parking lot and arrangements needed to be made regarding the removal, safe keeping, and eventual return to MR. COROSO. LT. CARROLL and SGT. KEARNS advised me that they would take care of it but requested that it be kept here until those arrangements could be made. After agreeing to the arrangements, requests, and signing the property report, MR. COROSO was released from our temporary custody without further incident.

\*\*NOTE: During my entire involvement with MR. COROSO, he remained cooperative and complied to our requests.\*\*
