AFFIDAVIT FOR ARREST WARRANT

COUNTY OF DALLAS

BEFORE ME, the undersigned authority, on this day personally appeared the undersigned affiant who, after being duly sworn by me, on oath stated: My name is M. Yeric #7178 and I am a peace officer of the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas. I, the

affiant, have good reason and do believe that on or about the 6th day of May, 2012, one (name of suspect) JOSE ALFARO did then and

there in the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas commit the offense of Capital Murder a violation of Section 19.03 of the TEXAS

PENAL CODE, a Capital Felony.

Affidavit's belief is based upon the following facts and information which Affiant received from:

- ☐ Affiant's personal investigation of this alleged offense.
- ☒ Michael Yeric #7178, a fellow peace officer of the City of Dallas, Dallas County, Texas, who personally participated in the investigation of this alleged offense, providing this information to Affiant, and whose information Affiant believes to be credible.

On Sunday, May 6, 2012, at approximately 12:10 AM, [REDACTED] committed the offense of Capital Murder, a Capital Felony, by participating in a robbery during which Lorenzo Moreno (L/M 3/7/1946) was shot and killed. This offense occurred at 718 Ezekial Avenue, Dallas, Dallas County, Texas.

The facts of the case are as follows:

On Sunday May 6, 2012, [REDACTED] along with at least 3 other unknown individuals, knocked on the front door of 718 Ezekial Avenue. Ricky Moreno answered the door and was immediately assaulted and dragged out onto the front porch where he continued to be beaten by multiple Suspects. [REDACTED] and two of the unknown Suspects went to the rear bedroom where [REDACTED] was in bed and attacked [REDACTED]. Two of the Suspects were wearing masks, but during the assault [REDACTED] was able to remove the mask of one of her attackers, recognizing that attacker as [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] stated that she has known [REDACTED] for approximately one year and that they had been close friends in the past with [REDACTED] even spending the night at her house in the past. [REDACTED] stated that [REDACTED] struck her repeatedly about the head and chest then produced a knife and stabbed her several times.

While [REDACTED] was being attacked in the rear bedroom, Lorenzo Moreno and Adela Moreno, who were asleep in their room, were awakened by the disturbance. Lorenzo Moreno went to the front porch in an apparent attempt to aid Ricky Moreno while Adela Moreno went to the rear bedroom to aid [REDACTED]. When Lorenzo Moreno arrived at the front door, one of the unknown Suspects produced a shotgun and fired one time, striking Lorenzo Moreno in the chest. Moreno died at the scene as a result of his wound.

MAGISTRATE'S DETERMINATION OF PROBABLE CAUSE

have examined the foregoing affidavit and have determined that probable cause exists for the issuance of an arrest warrant for the individual accused therein.

Adela Moreno attempted to intervene in the attack on [REDACTED]. At least one of the Suspects turned and attacked Adela Moreno forcing her out into the hallway where she was repeatedly struck by fists and an unknown object.

The Suspects fled the scene in at least two vehicles.

Ricky Moreno and [REDACTED] were transported to Parkland Hospital where they were treated for their injuries.

Later the same day, Detectives M. Yeric #7178 and T. Raley #6794 showed [REDACTED] a single photo of [REDACTED] whom [REDACTED] positively identified as her attacker.

Detectives M. Yeric #7178 and T. Raley #6794 showed Adela Moreno a single photo of [REDACTED] whom Adela Moreno immediately positively identified as [REDACTED] attacker. Adela Moreno stated that she known [REDACTED] by face and name and has had [REDACTED] in her home on multiple occasions.

During this offense one television was removed from the house.

On May 7, 2012, at approximately 3:00 PM, Teresa Gonzalez came to the CAPERS office at Dallas Police Department headquarters. Gonzalez stated that she and [REDACTED] had been close friends until very recently and that on Sunday May 6, 2012 [REDACTED] called Gonzalez and told her that she and her boyfriend Jose had "hit a lick at [REDACTED]'s house." (Common terminology for committing a robbery) Gonzalez knows Jose by name and face and identified him as Jose Alfaro and positively identified him by a single photograph. Gonzalez stated that she has been to Alfaro's house and could direct Detectives there. Gonzalez also told Detectives that Alfaro drives a red SUV. Gonzalez directed officers to 13266 Emily #114 which is also the address listed for Alfaro on recent arrest records. Also at the location was a red Isuzu Rodeo belonging to Alfaro's mother, which matched the general description of a vehicle seen leaving the offense location.

Immediately after Gonzalez showed officers where Alfaro lived, uniformed officers attempted to make contact with the occupants of unit #114. Undercover officers observed a L/M in a black shirt and a L/F in a black shirt standing directly outside of unit #114. When uniformed officers arrived, the L/M and L/F were gone. Officers covering the rear of unit #114 observed a L/M and L/F attempt to flee through a rear window of #114. When the L/M and L/F saw the officers, they retreated into the apartment and shut the window. After approximately two hours of continual efforts to convince the occupants to come out, Jose Alfaro and [REDACTED] surrendered.

[REDACTED] was arrested for outstanding warrants for Capital Murder and Aggravated Assault related to this offense.

Jose Alfaro was transported to the CAPERS office where he denied any involvement in or knowledge of the offense.
