

KAUFMAN COUNTY SHERIFF'S OFFICE AFFIDAVIT FOR WARRANT OF ARREST

IN THE NAME AND BY THE AUTHORITY OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

I, Sgt. Matt Woodall, being duly sworn, do state upon my oath that I have good reason to believe and do believe, and I charge that heretofore, and before the making and filing of this complaint that Kim Lene Williams, a white female approximately 5'03" tall, 130 pounds in weight, blonde hair, blue eyes with date of birth 09/07/1966, Texas Drivers License and Social Security Number

Did commit an offense against the laws of the State of Texas, to-wit: Capital Murder, in violation of Section 19.03 of the Texas Penal Code, a capital felony, in that he did then and there, in Kaufman County, Texas, murder more than one person during different criminal transactions but pursuant to the same scheme and course of conduct, to-wit: the said **Kim Lene Williams** on or about the 31st day of January, 2013, did then and there intentionally and knowingly cause the death of an individual, Mark Hasse, by shooting him with a firearm; and the said **Kim Lene Williams** on or about the 30th day of March, 2013, did then and there intentionally and knowingly cause the death of an individual, Michael McLelland, by shooting him with a firearm and further did then and there intentionally and knowingly cause the death of an individual, Cynthia McLelland, by shooting her with a firearm.

Affiant Matt Woodall is currently employed by the Kaufman County Sheriff's Office (KSO) assigned to the Criminal Investigations Division. Affiant's belief regarding Williams's commission of this offense is based upon Affiant's personal participation in the investigation of the murders of Mark Hasse, Michael McLelland, and Cynthia McLelland, including his interviews with witnesses, his review of documents, and his discussions with other investigators in the multi-agency investigation of these offenses including the Kaufman County Sheriff's Office, Texas Rangers from Company "B," and Special Agents and Task Force Officers From the Dallas Field Office of the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) among others:

1. Affiant is aware from public records and discussions with other law enforcement officers that in March of 2012, Eric Williams was convicted in a jury trial of the felony offenses of Burglary of a Building and Theft by Public Servant in Kaufman County, Texas. Affiant is aware that murder victims Mark Hasse and Michael McLelland were the prosecuting attorneys in the jury trial of these cases. Affiant learned that Eric Williams, who was a Justice of the Peace in Kaufman County at the time of those offenses, was suspended from his judicial duties after indictment, removed from his elected office in the judgments of conviction, and remains suspended without pay pending his appeal. Affiant has learned from other officers and county employees that Mr. Hasse and Mr. McLelland both believed that Eric Williams blamed them for his removal from office. Affiant has also learned from other officers and county employees that both Mr. Hasse and Mr. McLelland regularly carried handguns after the Eric

Williams jury trial because they believed Eric Williams to be a threat to their personal safety.

- On January 31, 2013, Kaufman County Assistant District Attorney Mark Hasse 2. was shot and killed in an employee parking area approximately one block from the Kaufman County Court House, located in the 100 block of W. Grove Street, Kaufman, Kaufman County, Texas, at approximately 8:38 a.m. and was later pronounced dead. The autopsy revealed that Hasse was shot multiple times.
- On the evening of March 30, 2013, the bodies of Kaufman County District Attorney Michael McLelland and his wife, Cynthia McLelland, were found dead in their home at 9389 Blarney Stone Way, Forney, Kaufman County, Texas. Mr. McLelland and Mrs. McLelland had both been shot multiple times.
- 4. On April 16, 2013 an interview with defendant, Kim Lene Williams was conducted at the Kaufman County Law Enforcement Center. During the interview, Kim Williams confessed to her involvement to the scheme and course of conduct in the shooting deaths of Mark Hasse, Michael McLelland and Cynthia McLelland. Kim Williams described in detail her role along with that of her husband, Eric Williams whom she reported to have shot to death Mark Hasse on January 31, 2013 and Michael and Cynthia McLelland on March 30, 2013. During the interview, the defendant gave details of both offenses which had not been made public.
