**SUBJECT: Snow Emergency Declaration**

As of MARCH 4, 2013 <sup>6:30 pm</sup> the City of West St. Paul will be declaring a snow emergency for the next (48) forty-eight hours. We are requesting that vehicles be removed from the public right of way in accordance to subdivisions four and five of West St. Paul's snow emergency ordinance.

Subd. 4. General Rule. No vehicle may be parked or left unattended after 2:00 a.m. on any street designated as a Snow Emergency Route after any snowfall or during an Emergency. Unless further restricted by posted sign, parking may be resumed on streets immediately after they have been fully plowed of snow or the Emergency has been terminated.

Subd. 5. Other Streets and Improved Alleys. No vehicle may be parked or left unattended between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m. on any other street or improved alley after any snowfall or during an Emergency until such street or improved alley has been fully plowed of snow. After plowing, parking may be resumed unless further restricted by posted signs.
