





In conclusion, may I offer my own personal best wishes to you and to the Benedictine Community.



I received your proposal for the payment of counseling of the frequency, the nature, and the extent of the counseling cannot really be pre-ordained under the circumstances. Therefore, we cannot agree to any set amount at this time because that should be something determined by the treating therapist and the patient. Second, it is unrealistic to have the treatment notes forwarded with the bills contemporaneously. We are willing and able to assemble, at various periods, the treatment records and forward them to you.

Finally, we would agree that the payment of any counseling expenses would not be used offensively or defensively by any party in connection with litigation. If there is any ultimate settlement, that amount would be reduced by the amount of therapy expense paid to that date.
