ORDER

Based upon the attached Motion submitted by Assistant Stearns County Attorney Michael

J. Lieberg the court finds that the conditions that necessitated previous orders of this court or other

courts in the State of Minnesota directing search warrants and supporting documents executed

during the investigation into the disappearance of Jacob Erwin Wetterling not be filed pursuant to

Minnesota Rule of Criminal Procedure 33.04 no longer exist. Pursuant to Minnesota Rule of

Criminal Procedure 33.04 such orders were issued because the filing could have caused a search

or future, related searches to be unsuccessful, create a substantial risk of injury to an innocent

person, and/or could create a substantial risk of severely hampering the ongoing investigation into

the disappearance of Jacob Erwin Wetterling. The conditions supporting orders directing that

search warrants and related documents not be filed no longer exist because Danny James Heinrich

admitted to the abduction, sexual assault, and murder of Jacob Erwin Wetterling, pursuant to a

plea agreement, entered into on September 6, 2016 in United States District Court during his

prosecution for Possession of Child Pornography.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that law enforcement is directed to file any previously

unfiled Applications for Search Warrants and supporting Affidavits, the actual Search Warrants,

the Receipt Inventories, and Return Forms that were executed regarding the investigation into the

Disappearance of Jacob Erwin Wetterling that were previously unfiled pursuant to a previous

Order of this court or another court in the State of Minnesota issued pursuant to Minnesota Rules

FILED in Stearns County Court Administration 9/8/16 of Criminal Procedure 33.04 (c)&(d) or other similar or previously existing authority. Law enforcement is also directed to file any previous Motions, supporting affidavits, and Orders of this court or another court in the State of Minnesota pursuant to Minnesota Rules of Criminal Procedure 33.04 (c)&(d) or other similar or previously existing authority directing that Applications for Search Warrant and supporting Affidavits, the actual Search Warrants, the Receipt Inventories, and Return Forms that were executed regarding the investigation into the Disappearance of Jacob Erwin Wetterling not be filed.
