### **I-376 Parkway West Long-term Shoulder Closures begin Next Week in Allegheny County Pittsburgh, PA**

PennDOT is announcing long-term shoulder closures on I-376 (Parkway West) in Allegheny County will begin Tuesday night, Sept. 2 weather permitting.

Beginning at 10 p.m. on Tuesday night, barrier will be placed along the shoulder on I-376 in both directions between the Rosslyn Farms (Exit 64-B) interchange and approximately 1,500 feet past the Carnegie (Exit 65) interchange. Barrier placement will occur Tuesday through Thursday nights from 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. Single lane closures will occur each night in both directions.

Motorists are advised to use caution and allow extra time when traveling through the area. Lanes are narrowed to 10½ feet.

The work is part of a \$72.83 million improvement project on the Parkway West. The overall project includes milling and resurfacing I-376 between I-79 and the Fort Pitt Tunnel. Additionally, bridge preservation and rehabilitation work, drainage improvements, guiderail upgrades, signing and pavement marking, concrete median barrier replacement and sign structure rehabilitation will be conducted.
