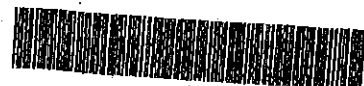

AFFIDAVIT of PROBABLE CAUSE

The following events occurred on or about 02/21/15 before 0833 hours on State Route 40 eastbound approx. 100 yards east of Lick Hollow Road, South Union Twp., Fayette County. The Victim, Mya Ann GRADY, travelling eastbound in her gold Hyundai Accent Coupe bearing PA registration JTX1079, VIN# KMHCG35C92U195567, was on her way to her place of employment, Lady Luck Casino, when she was shot twice in the head through the drivers side window. GRADY was immediately incapacitated, and coasted to a stop, coming to a position of final rest against the south guiderail, engine running, transmission in drive, with the headlights on. GRADY was discovered by a PennDot snowplow driver.

Mya Ann GRADY was pronounced dead on 02/21/15 at 1045 hours by Deputy Coroner John KONDRLA.

Interviews were done with the Victims family and it was discovered that she was romantically involved with the Defendant and had recently attempted to break off the relationship. That the Victim had been driving a silver Chevy Cavalier owned by the Defendant and over time, the Defendant had taken this vehicle off of the Victim as punishment, the last time being Monday, February 16, 2015. Their relationship had been going on for approximately 7 years. Family members of the Victim described their relationship as turbulent and abusive. The Victim had also been romantically involved with [REDACTED] for approximately the last 7 to 8 months. [REDACTED] is estranged from his wife, [REDACTED].

The Defendant was contacted and asked to come to PSP Uniontown to be interviewed. The Defendant was mirandized and admitted in an interview that he had been in contact, by phone and in person with [REDACTED], and that they had spoken about the Victim at length. He stated he had followed the Victim from her residence when she left for work on 02/21/15. The Defendant was driving his wife's white Chrysler Pacifica. The Defendant stated he followed the Victim on SR 40 east until she turned into the parking lot of B & B's market. The Defendant drove slowly through Hopwood, allowing the Victim to catch up to him. The Defendant then positioned his vehicle in the left lane of SR 40 eastbound, allowing the Victim to accelerate in the right lane. The Defendant positioned his vehicle in the left lane right next to the Victim's vehicle when the shots were fired. The Defendant admitted he was present when the two gunshots were fired into the Victim.

Video surveillance was collected from B & B Market, which revealed the Victim pulling into the parking lot in her gold Hyundai at 0822 hours. Travelling directly behind the Victim's vehicle, heading east on SR 40 is a white Chrysler Pacifica.

On 02/24/15 [REDACTED] was interviewed and stated that on Saturday, February 21, 2015 he was on the south berm on SR 40 on the Summit Mountain across from and even with the old watering trough, at a gas well entrance. He stated he observed a white SUV travelling at a fast rate "up" the mountain. It was odd because it was cold and snowing and the passenger window was down. He observed a driver with a dark skin color and did not observe a passenger. He observed this at approximately 0830 hours.

██████████ was contacted and interviewed at PSP Uniontown. She stated that in a phone conversation she had with the Defendant on Friday, February 20, 2015 the Defendant stated he was going to kill the Victim. The Defendant eluded to the fact that this would occur on Saturday.

On 02/22/15 at 1100hours an autopsy was performed on Mya Ann GRADY by Dr. Cyril WECHT. Cause of death was determined to be gunshot wound, and manner of death as homicide.
