Re: Governor's Reward in the matter of the homicide of Matt Garcia

To Whom It May Concern:

On September 1, 2008, Fairfield City Councilman Matt Garcia was murdered in the city of Fairfield. On September 2, 2008, Governor Arnold Schwarzenegger issued a State reward in the amount of \$50,000 "for new information, voluntarily given hereafter, leading to the arrest and conviction in a California court of any person who has committed, or is charged with the commission, of the shooting of Matt Garcia."

Five individuals were determined to be helpful in the arrest, prosecution, and conviction of Henry Williams and Gene Combs for the murder of Matt Garcia. Pursuant to Penal Code 1547(d), I recommend the following individuals be awarded funds from the Governor's Reward: Harold Gaymon forty percent (40%), Terri Bush twenty-five percent (25%), Joyce Williams twenty-five percent (25%), Jesus Lopez five percent (5%), and Joseph Morin five percent (5%). Information provided by these individuals was given voluntarily and not part of any plea bargain.
