## **ENHANCEMENT 1**

PC12022.6(a)(1): Special Allegation-Excessive Loss Over \$50,000 It is further alleged as to Counts I, V, VI and IX, that in the commission of the above offenses the said defendant, ELIZABETH ANNE CHAPINPINOTTI, with the intent to do so, took, damaged, and destroyed property of a value exceeding \$65,000, to wit \$190,000, within the meaning of Penal Code Section 12022.6(a)(1).
