### **28-Day Closure Scheduled for State Highway 84**

*Emergency Repair Work near West Sacramento*

WEST SACRAMENTO – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is alerting motorists to anticipate lane closures for Highway 84 that would extend travel times in Yolo County south of West Sacramento.

Emergency pavement repair work is needed for this section of highway. Workers are scheduled to begin demolition and pavement repair work on Monday, October 17. The work will require a 28-day closure for north and southbound directions on Highway 84.

#### **SCHEDULE:**

- Beginning **6 a.m. Mon. 10/17 through 6 p.m. Mon. 11/14**, all access on Highway 84 from north of Babel Slough Road to south of Burrows Avenue will be closed.

#### **DETOUR:**

- **NB Traffic** will be detoured to WB Babel Slough Road, to NB South River Road and to NB Gregory Avenue for access to Jefferson Boulevard. (Detour signs will be in place to direct motorists.)
- **SB Traffic** will be detoured to SB Gregory Avenue, to SB South River Road and to WB Babel Slough Road for access back to State Highway 84. (Detour signs will be in place to direct motorists.)

Motorists are urged to use an alternate route to avoid these delays, or plan ahead for the additional travel time using detours.

Weather or unexpected events may delay or prolong the work. 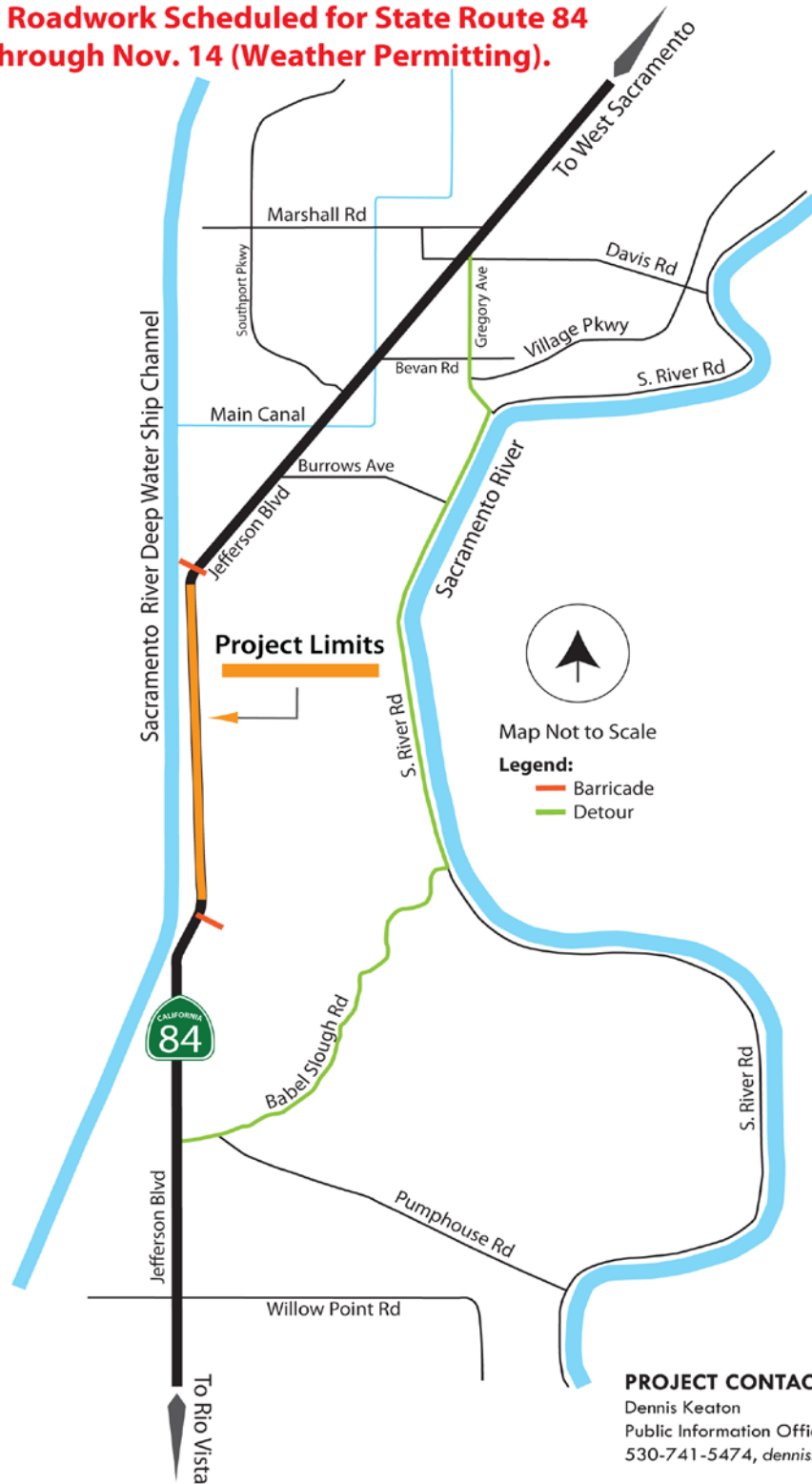
