COUNT II: On or about January 11, 2018, defendant did commit a felony, THREATENING TO COMMIT A CRIME, violation of Section 422(a) of the California Penal Code, in that the defendant did willfully, unlawfully, and feloniously threaten to commit a crime which would result in the death of or great bodily injury to LOREN NICHOLSON, thereby causing him to reasonably be in sustained fear for his safety.

ENHANCEMENT: During the commission of the above said offense, defendant personally used a firearm, in violation of Section 12022.5(a) of the California Penal Code.
