Count Enhancement la : It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(15) of the California Penal Code in that defendant intentionally killed the victim by means of lying in

wait.

Count Enhancement 1b: It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE FOR TORTURE within the meaning of Section 190.2 (a) (18), in that the defendant inflicted torture in the commission of murder.

Count 2: On or about November 2, 1995 through May 2, 1996, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 187(a) of the California Penal Code, MURDER, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did willfully and unlawfully kill a human being, to wit, M.P. (DOB: November 2, 1995), with malice aforethought.

Count Enhancement 2a: It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(15) of the California Penal Code in that defendant intentionally killed the victim by means of lying in wait.

Count Enhancement 2b: It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE FOR TORTURE within the meaning of Section 190.2 (a) (18), in that the defendant inflicted torture in the commission of murder.

Count 3: On or about November 8, 1996 through May 8, 1997, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 187(a) of the California Penal Code, MURDER, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did willfully and unlawfully kill a human being, to wit, N.P. (DOB: November 8, 1996), with malice

aforethought.

Count Enhancement 3a: It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(15) of the California Penal Code in that defendant intentionally killed the victim by means of lying in wait.

Count Enhancement 3b: It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE FOR TORTURE within the meaning of Section 190.2 (a) (18), in that the defendant inflicted torture in the commission of murder.

Count 4: On or about October 29, 1997 through April 29, 1998, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 187(a) of the California Penal Code, MURDER, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did willfully and unlawfully kill a human being, to wit, N.P. (DOB: October 29, 1997), with malice aforethought.

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Count Enhancement 4a : It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(15) of the California Penal Code in that defendant intentionally killed the victim by means of lying in wait.

Count Enhancement 4b : It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE FOR TORTURE within the meaning of Section 190.2 (a) (18), in that the defendant inflicted torture in the commission of murder.

Count 5: On or about April 16, 2001 through October 16, 2001, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 187(a) of the California Penal Code, MURDER, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did willfully and unlawfully kill a human being, to wit, K.P. (DOB: April 16, 2001), with malice aforethought.

Count Enhancement 5a : It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(15) of the California Penal Code in that defendant intentionally killed the victim by means of lying in wait.

Count Enhancement 5b : It is also alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is subject to a SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCE FOR TORTURE within the meaning of Section 190.2 (a) (18), in that the defendant inflicted torture in the commission of murder.

Count 6: On or about November 2, 1995 through May 2, 1996, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 273ab of the California Penal Code, ASSAULT ON CHILD UNDER EIGHT WITH FORCE LIKELY TO PRODUCE GREAT BODILY INJURY RESULTING IN DEATH, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ while having the care and custody of a child who was under eight years of age did willfully and unlawfully assault said child by means of force that to a reasonable person would be likely to produce great bodily injury and such assault did result in said child's death. To wit, M.P. (DOB: November 2, 1995).

Count 7: On or about November 8, 1996 through May 8, 1997, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 273ab of the California Penal Code, ASSAULT ON CHILD UNDER EIGHT WITH FORCE LIKELY TO PRODUCE GREAT BODILY INJURY RESULTING IN DEATH, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ while having the care and custody of a child who was under eight years of age did willfully and unlawfully assault said child by means of force that to a reasonable person would be likely to produce great bodily injury and such assault did result in said child's death. To wit, N.P. (DOB: November 8, 1996).

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Count 8: On or about October 29, 1997 through April 29, 1998, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 273ab of the California Penal Code, ASSAULT ON CHILD UNDER EIGHT WITH FORCE LIKELY TO PRODUCE GREAT BODILY INJURY RESULTING IN DEATH, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ while having the care and custody of a child who was under eight years of age did willfully and unlawfully assault said child by means of force that to a reasonable person would be likely to produce great bodily injury and such assault did result in said child's death. To wit, N.P. (DOB: October 29, 1997).

Count 9: On or about April 16, 2001 through October 16, 2001, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit a FELONY, namely, a violation of Section 273ab of the California Penal Code, ASSAULT ON CHILD UNDER EIGHT WITH FORCE LIKELY TO PRODUCE GREAT BODILY INJURY RESULTING IN DEATH, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ while having the care and custody of a child who was under eight years of age did willfully and unlawfully assault said child by means of force that to a reasonable person would be likely to produce great bodily injury and such assault did result in said child's death. To wit, K.P. (DOB: April 16, 2001).

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Case Enhancement a (Counts 1 through 5): It is also alleged that during the commission of the murder as charged in Counts 1 through 5 above, PAUL ALLEN PEREZ did commit multiple murders of another, to wit, K.P. (DOB: 8/16/92); M.P. (DOB: 11/2/95); N.P. (DOB: 11/8/96); N.P. (DOB: 10/29/97); and K.P. (DOB: 4/16/01), within the meaning of Section 190.2(a)(3) of the California Penal Code, SPECIAL CIRCUMSTANCES FOR MULTIPLE MURDERS.

Case Enhancement b (Counts 2 through 9): It is further alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ was previously convicted of a serious felony within the meaning of Section 667(c) and 667(e) (1) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR ONE PRIOR FELONY CONVICTION THAT PROHIBITS PROBATION, LIMITS CREDITS, REQUIRES CONSECUTIVE SENTENCING, AND MANDATES PRISON COMMITMENT, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ was convicted of a prior felony as defined in Section 667(d) of the California Penal Code, and listed in Sections 667.5(c) and 1192.7(a) of the Penal Code, and Section 707(b) of the Welfare and Institutions Code, to wit, a conviction on February 14, 1990 for a violation of Section 220 of the California Penal Code, in the County of Merced.

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Case Enhancement c (Counts 2 through 9): It is further alleged that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ was previously convicted of a serious felony within the meaning of Section 667(a)(1) of the California Penal Code, ENHANCEMENT FOR HABITUAL CRIMINALS, in that PAUL ALLEN PEREZ was convicted of a serious felony listed in Section 1192.7 of the Penal Code, to wit, Section 220 of the California Penal Code, on February 14, 1990 in the County of Merced.

Notice: PAUL ALLEN PEREZ is being charged in Yolo County in Counts 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, 8 and 9, Pursuant to Penal Code Section 790(b) and Penal Code Section 190.2(a)(3) which allows for jurisdiction within Yolo County.
