

My name is Adrienne Spohr, I am the younger daughter of Wendy Wood and Gary Spohr.

On Saturday June 5, a man entered my parents' home, murdered my father and attempted to murder my mother. My mother is in the ICU and is unresponsive. We have no idea who did this and why. My parents actively supported the community and loved being in Tahoe.

Although the Sheriff's press release did not include information on my mother's devastating injuries, my family is equally devastated by our inability to talk to my unresponsive mother, who was shot in the brain.

We are horrified. We could have never imagined something like this could happen to our parents. We are desperate to find justice for them.

Tahoe is supposed to be a safe community. We love this community, and we need help from it. We are desperately asking everyone to provide any photos or videos of the suspect as he traveled:

Southbound on West lake Blvd from Tahoe City to Homewood between 3:30-5:30 pm;

Northbound in the opposite direction between 8:30-10:30pm;

It appears that suspect may have walked along the bike lane on the lake side of the road on the way to and from our home.

Images/video of the suspect and his attire are on the Placer County Sheriff Facebook Page. The person who shot my parents was heavily clothed with a black sweatshirt, light colored sweatpants, mask and gloves.

We are looking for any video (GoPro, dash cam, Ring camera, still photos with West Lake Blvd in back) that might have captured the suspect as he traveled on foot down the road.
