

2012 RCOC Road Improvement Program

This list includes only projects that will be constructed in 2012, not those where design or right of way work is planned for 2012, but where construction will occur in a later year. To avoid confusion over project costs, the costs listed are the total costs for each project, including any preliminary engineering, right of way acquisition and construction costs. For many projects, some of these costs (such as for preliminary engineering or right of way acquisition) were paid for in previous years' budgets, so the total project costs are not necessarily representative of the dollars included in the 2012 budget for each project.

Safety Widenings

- Crooks Road, Starr-Batt Dr. to N. of Hamlin in Rochester Hills (widen 2 lanes to 5) \$3.4 million

Total Safety Widenings: \$3.4 million

Reconstruct/Replace (completely reconstruct or replace an existing road)

- Lahser Road, 11 Mile to 12 Mile in Southfield (includes adding center left-turn lane) \$5.8 million
- Pontiac Trail, Maple to S. Commerce in Walled Lake \$2.7 million

Total Reconstruct/Replace: \$8.5 million

Repair, Rehabilitate and Resurface (repair road base & add 3 or 4 inches of new asphalt to existing lanes)

- Livernois Road, Big Beaver to Wattles in Troy \$1.3 million
- 14 Mile Road, Campbell to Stephenson on the Madison Heights/Troy border \$1.6 million
- Orchard Lake Road, 13 Mile to 14 Mile in Farmington Hills \$1.2 million
- County Center Drive East within county complex in Pontiac \$600,000

Total Repair, Rehabilitate and Resurface: \$4.7 million

Pave Gravel Road (provide paved surface on currently unpaved road)

- Cooley Lake Road, E. of Duck Lake to Mystic Valley on the Milford Twp./Highland Twp. border and the White Lake Twp./Commerce Twp. border \$4.4 million

Total Pave Gravel Road: \$4.4 million.

Bridge Replacement

- Avon Road bridge over the Clinton River in Rochester Hills (just east of Livernois) \$3.4 million
- Nakomis Street bridge over Indianwood Lake Canal in Orion Township \$500,000

Total Bridge Replacement: \$3.9 million

Tri-Party Program Projects (Cost is divided three ways: one third to Oakland County general government, one third to the community and one third to the Road Commission)

- 10 Mile/I-696 Service Drive repaving, Huron St. to eastern city limits in Ferndale \$90,000
- John St. pulverize & resurface, Livingston Rd. to M-59 in Highland Twp. \$190,000
- Pontiac Trail resurfacing, Old Orchard Trail to Orchard Lake Road in Orchard Lake Vill. \$115,000
- Long Lake Rd. concrete slab replacements, Crooks to Northfield Parkway in Troy \$285,000
- Andover Rd. concrete slab replacements, Copperwood to Telegraph, Bloomfield Twp. \$250,000

Total Tri-Party Program Projects: \$930,000

- Grand River Ave. repair, rehabilitate & resurface, Novi to Haggerty in Novi \$4 million
- Commerce Rd repair, rehabilitate & resurface, South Commerce to Union Lake in Commerce Twp. \$2.6 million
- 8 Mile Rd. gravel paving project, Dixboro to Pontiac Tr. on Lyon Twp./Salem Twp. Border \$1.7 million
