As a result of the **DETROIT ONE** Initiative, the department embarked on a proactive saturation policing strategy in identified hot spots, focusing on crimes narcotics-related crimes. The strategy has included narcotic raids, increased traffic enforcement, and increased officer presence. During the first six days of this strategy (Mar. 7-9 and Mar. 14-16), no violent crimes were committed in the targeted areas. **Statistical breakdown of the results so far:**

245 Arrests: 93 Felonies/ 152 Misdemeanors

41 Firearms confiscated

105 Narcotic Raids conducted

\$2,764,131 in Narcotics confiscated (street value)

\$54,086 cash confiscated (in conjunction with raids)

4,586 Traffic Violations issued

498 Vehicles Towed (due to no driver's license, in most cases)
