On listed date and time officers were dispatched to Camp Dearborn. Dispatch advised that a hay ride had tipped over and MFD and EMS were enroute for several injuries.



I arrived on scene directly behind Ofc. Gratsch. Sgt. Tisler arrived a short time later. We located the accident scene in area B, west of Hubbard Blvd and just north of General Motors Rd. I observed several people seated on the ground and at picnic tables, many appeared to be injured. Ofc. Gratsch assisted Community EMS by holding C-spine on a female subject laying on the ground.

I located the operator of the hay ride, ID by MI Ops as [REDACTED]. He stated there were 16 passengers in the wooden hayride trailer and he operated the tractor. [REDACTED] stated he was driving S/B in area B immediately west of the Comfort 1 bathroom building. He stated he attempted a right turn into the w/b row of camp sites. There is a slight hill in the area, and [REDACTED] stated that the trailer tipped to the left as he made the turn. [REDACTED] stated there was another hayride in the area and all his passengers had moved to the left side of the trailer. He stated the passengers told him they wanted to throw hay at the other hayride. [REDACTED] stated he had previously told the passengers to stay seated. [REDACTED] stated he had the tractor in low gear and was not going too fast to maneuver the corner. [REDACTED] stated he has driven the hayride several times this fall and last fall, and has been employed by Camp Dearborn for over a year.

I observed the tractor and wooden trailer parked facing W/B in front of campsite B108. I observed scrape marks on the pavement where wood from the trailer had been left on the pavement. The trailer had a wooden rail, and it had fresh scrape marks along the entire length of the rail on the left side of the trailer. Scrapes on the rail of the trailer appeared to indicate that the trailer had tipped completely on its side before returning to its normal position. [REDACTED] and several other witnesses stated that the trailer fell back onto the wheels by itself and was not moved prior to police arriving. I observed that there were three wooden benches that had run the length of the trailer front to back. The two outside benches were intact. The middle bench had been dislodged from the trailer and was laying approximately 15-20' south of the scrape marks where the trailer had tipped. Ofc. Gratsch later photographed the accident scene, tractor, and trailer.

I spoke with Charlotte Bader as she was being cared for by Community EMS. She stated she was seated in the front left area of the trailer with her back toward the tractor. She stated she did not notice anything unusual about the ride before it tipped. Bader stated she felt the ride begin to turn right and the trailer tipped suddenly. She stated there were passengers seated evenly on both sides of the trailer. I asked Bader if she heard anything said about passing the other hayride or throwing hay and she stated no. I asked her if passengers were standing and moving

to the left side just prior to the accident and she said no. Bader complained of pain in her right shoulder and stated her teeth hurt. I observed minor bleeding in her mouth.

I spoke with Laura Lubeck. She stated she was seated in the middle section of the middle bench. She stated she thought the driver was going too fast as he made the turn and the trailer tipped. Mrs. Lubeck stated she was certain that the passengers were seated and they were evenly distributed across the trailer. She stated she did not hear anything about throwing hay at the other hayride. Mrs. Lubeck stated she hit her head on the ground when she fell out of the trailer and she had a bloody nose but it had since stopped. I observed dried blood on her face.

I spoke with Adrienne Yoches. She stated she was seated in the left rear of the trailer with her back to the rail. She stated her two children, 6 year old Samuel Yoches and 4 year old Danielle Yoches, were across from her in the right rear corner. Adrienne stated that the driver was "flying" and took the turn way too fast. She stated she thought the driver was trying to catch up to the other hayride. She stated she never heard anything about throwing hay at the other ride and that all the passengers were seated and evenly spread out when the accident happened. Adrienne had minor abrasions to her hands and stated that both her children were uninjured. She stated that the accident had ripped the diamond out of her wedding ring. I observed her wedding ring on her left hand. The prongs were bent and the stone was missing.

Sgt. Tisler advised me that he had smelled alcohol on [REDACTED] and told me to investigate further.

I spoke with [REDACTED] again. I got closer to [REDACTED] and detected the odor of intoxicants on his breath. I asked if he had been drinking and he stated no. Sgt. Tisler advised [REDACTED] that he could smell intoxicants and [REDACTED] stated he had one beer. [REDACTED] eventually stated that he arrived at work at 0800 hrs and went to lunch at 1130 hrs. He stated he went to Tavern 131 (131 S. Milford Rd) and had a Long Island Iced Tea with his lunch. He stated he came back to work at 1300 hrs and took another break at 1400 hrs and went back to Tavern 131. [REDACTED] stated that the second time at 131, he had a "fireball" shot, 1 rum and coke, and 1 tall beer. He stated he was drinking alcohol because it was his birthday and only drank when he was "off the clock." He stated he finished his last drink at approximately 1600 hrs and was back at work by 1630 to prepare the hayride. He stated the ride began at 1700 hrs.

I requested that [REDACTED] complete sobriety tests and he complied. I asked his highest level of education and he stated he completed the 10th grade then dropped out of high school. I instructed him to recite the english alphabet from A to Z without singing and he stated he



understood. I instructed him to begin. [REDACTED] recited correctly from A to Z.

I instructed [REDACTED] to count backward from 40 to 23. He stated he understood and I told him to begin. He started at 40 and counted slowly and correctly from 40 to 0 and did not stop at 23 as instructed. I asked if he remembered when I told him to stop. He stated he thought I told him to count to zero.

I asked [REDACTED] if he had any physical problems that would affect his balance. He stated he had surgery on his right knee recently and has problems balancing. I omitted walk and turn and one leg stand tests due to [REDACTED] knee problem.

I demonstrated and instructed the finger dexterity test. [REDACTED] completed 3 cycles correctly as instructed.

I asked [REDACTED] if he had any problems with his head and eyes or any history of serious head injury and he stated no. I administered the Horizontal Gaze Nystagmus test. I observed equal tracking and smooth pursuit in both eyes. I observed minor nystagmus at maximum deviation in both eyes. I observed no onset of nystagmus prior to 45 degrees and no vertical nystagmus.

Ofc. Gratsch provided a PBT and I requested that [REDACTED] provide a breath sample. He complied and the result was .060.

I advised [REDACTED] that a report would be filed and would be forwarded to the local prosecutor for review.

Upon arrival Officers McBride and Gratsch were rendering aid.

I s/w injured subject Troy Gibson.

Interview w/Troy Gibson:



Troy stated that he was sitting on the left side of the trailer near the middle. He advised that he felt that the driver of the tractor was going way to fast. He said as they made a turn the trailer tipped to the left and people fell on top of him breaking his arm. I asked if anyone attempted to throw hay at a passing hayride. He stated that everyone was sitting and nobody threw hay.

Interview concluded

Interview w/Ron Lubeck:

Ron advised that he was sitting on the left side of the trailer near the middle. He said he remembered that he felt the driver of the tractor was going to fast around a corner and tipped the trailer. Ron complained of an abrasion to the back of his head but stated he was ok and going to the hospital for precaution.

Interview concluded

Interview w/Al Dyer (Camp Dearborn Supervisor):

Al stated that he was not present when the accident happened. He said that he had let the driver ([REDACTED]) off for a few hrs this afternoon due to his birthday. Al stated that he did not know that [REDACTED] had been consuming alcohol while away.

I was dispatched to Camp Dearborn to assist MFD with a medical. Dispatch advised a wagon being hauled by a tractor had flipped over and there were unknown injuries at that location. Upon arrival I observed a blue tractor with a wagon attached upright in a paved roadway. There were several people sitting and laying on the ground near the wagon. I immediately approached a woman on the ground laying on her back being c-spined by an unidentified man. I advised the man I could take over care of the woman identified as Jodi Jergovich. I swapped out positions with the man and now took over the c-spine of Jodi. Jodi advised she did not remember the



series of events that lead to the wagon being flipped over. MFD arrived on scene with Jodi. FF Jake Moore was able to put on an immobilizing collar on Jodi and care was TOT him along with other Fire and paramedic personnel.

After I left Jodi I spoke with Steven Jergovich. Steven advised he felt the wagon was going too fast and estimated the speed of the tractor to be approximately 30 MPH. He advised he felt the wagon start to sway before it flipped over.

After speaking with the Jergovich's Sgt. Tisler asked me to take photographs of the scene. I took several photographs of the tractor, wagon, debris and skid marks. They were burned onto CD disk. One disk was placed into secured evidence locker 5 and the other disk is attached to this report. After taking the photographs I returned to my patrol car and retrieved a PBT at the request of Sgt. Tisler. After Ofc. McBride put the driver of the tractor, Adam Forehand through FST's, I administered a PBT with a reading of .060.

SOURCE:

On Wednesday October 30, 2013 I received a voice mail message from Cynthia Gayle Cialone. Cialone indicated that she was on the hayride, however did not speak with an officer on the scene.

CONTACT WITH CIALONE:

I contacted Cynthia Cialone and spoke with her about what happened. She was asked to describe the events as she recalled them. Cynthia indicated that she organized the group outing and that they had the chalet rented out with inflatable bounce houses for the day. Cynthia said that the group was supposed to take the hayride, then follow up with a bon fire at the chalet before heading home.

Cynthia said that they got onto the trailer and everything appeared fine at first. Cynthia said that the driver would drive in a zig zag everyonce in a while to hit some of the bumps to make it a bumpy ride. Cynthia said that they would go up and down the different rows (roads) throughout the campground and everyone had to hold on because it was bumpy. Cynthia said that she was sitting in the middle bench almost towards the back of the trailer. Cynthia said that while they were making a sharp right turn, she remembers everyone being thrown from the trailer. Cynthia said that when she looked back towards the trailer it was upright and still attached to the tractor so she does not believe that it actually tipped all the way over. Cynthia believes that the driver was going around 20 MPH because she said it was much faster than someone could walk.



Cynthia said that she received bruising to her ribs, scrapes along her forearms and had a tingly feeling in her neck. Cynthia is being treated by a doctor and will follow up as necessary.

ACTIONS:

Cynthia was added to the person section of the report and provided with the complaint number.
