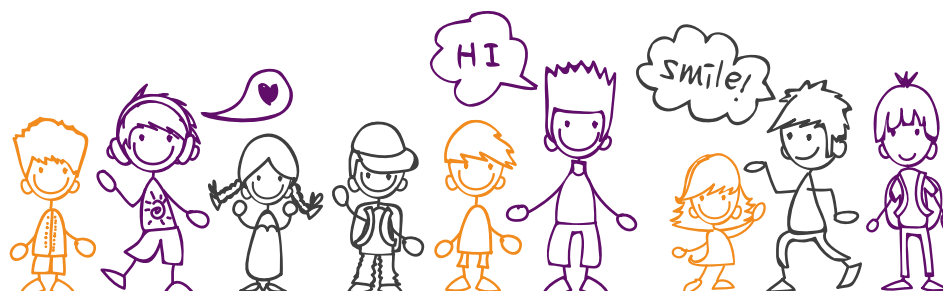

- Break out sessions for kids, teens, and parents

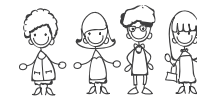
