SUBJECT: CITIZEN COMPLAINT FROM [REDACTED] REGARDING FORCE AND DEMEANOR AGAINST CAMPUS SECURITY POLICE OFFICER CHARLES BRAZIEL BADGE #9-19 ASSIGNED TO CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL ON DECEMBER 9, 2015

INTRODUCTION

On Monday, December 12, 2015, writer Sergeant Emmitt Smith Badge S-35 assigned to DPS-Police Department Platoon III was assigned to the investigation and report of force and demeanor of Campus Security Police Officer Charles Braziel Badge #9-19. This report was due on Wednesday, January 7, 2016.

On Thursday, January 7, 2016, writer Sergeant Emmitt Smith made a request to Inspector Gary Christian for an extension for the above report due to the fact writer was unable to interview witnesses because of the Christmas school break. This request was granted by Inspector Gary Christian, with a due date of Tuesday, January 19, 2016.

CIRCUMSTANCE

On December 9, 2015, at the request of Detroit Public School Police Chief Stacy Brackens to respond to Cass Tech High School regarding a complaint that Campus Security Police Officer

(CSPO) Charles Braziel had pepper sprayed a student by the name of [REDACTED]. Upon arrival at Cass Tech High School, the writer met with CSPO Braziel and Assistant Principal (AP) Mr. Orlando Bogin regarding the pepper spray incident. Both AP Bogin and CSPO Braziel informed me that a Cass Tech High School Student named [REDACTED], attempted to ride the first-floor elevator without a valid elevator pass when stopped by a teacher, Mrs. Cecelia Williams, who requested her student I.D. and elevator pass. The student produced an expired elevator pass dated October 5-9, 2015. Ms. Williams instructed her to get off of the elevator and take the stairs. As Ms. Williams was approaching the double doors near the elevators, she noticed that the Student [REDACTED] was still attempting to wait for the elevator and at which time Mrs. Williams instructed Student [REDACTED] again not to get on the elevator and to take the stairs. At this time, Student [REDACTED] begins to be belligerent, and Mrs. Williams called for security.

Securitas Security Officer Jayna Payne responded to the location and asked Student [REDACTED] for her I.D. Student [REDACTED] refused to present her I.D. and kept asking "why"? At this time, Officer Payne requested additional assistance from another Securitas Officer. That's when Student [REDACTED] ran up the south stairs and Securitas Security Officer Raghbir Warren proceeded after her on the second floor. After Student [REDACTED] had reached the second floor, she was confronted by AP Bogins and CSPO Braziel. AP Bogins made a request for Student [REDACTED] to calm down and she refused and began to use profanity towards Mr. Bogin and defiantly placed her headphones on her ears to tune AP Bogins out.

Because of Student [REDACTED] disruptive behavior towards AP Bogins, CSPO Braziel grabbed the headphones and cellphone from Student [REDACTED] so she could listen to AP Bogins directions. At this point, Student [REDACTED] became obstreperous and pulled back from CSPO Braziel, falling against the wall. CSPO Charles Braziel informed Student [REDACTED] that she would be arrested if she continues to be disorderly. Student [REDACTED] failed to adhere to CSPO Braziel warning and began to kick and attempted to bite Officer Braziel. Again, Student [REDACTED] was warned that if she continued her aggressive behavior, she would be pepper sprayed. Student [REDACTED] failed to comply with CSPO Braziel lawful command and was sprayed by CSPO Braziel with one (1) burst of pepper spray.

Afterward, Student [REDACTED] was taken to a secured area, and her eyes were washed out with water. Nurse Gandy was on the scene and assisted. Detroit EMS was notified, and Student [REDACTED] was conveyed to Children's Hospital at the request of her mom Mrs. [REDACTED]. The above circumstances led to the assignment of this investigation to Sergeant Smith by Inspector Gary Christian.

INVESTIGATION

Writer, Sergeant Emmitt Smith badge S-35 assigned to Platoon III, about this incident interviewed the below-listed individuals.

SERGEANT DEBORAH CRANE, BADGE S-4 AND SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED STUDENT [REDACTED] OF CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT 8500 CAMERON AT 1:00 P.M. ON DECEMBER 10, 2015

On Friday, December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:15 a.m. the complainant, a student of Cass Technical High School ██████████ stated that she was inside of Cass Technical High School located at 2601 Cass Avenue in the City of Detroit Michigan 48201. Student ██████████ said that she was on the first floor when she got into the elevator when a teacher, Mrs. Cecelia Williams observed her and three other students on the elevator. Mrs. Williams asked three other students and I for their elevator passes. Student ██████████ produces an elevator pass that was expired October 9, 2015. At this time, Mrs. Williams advised all of us to get off the elevator. While Mrs. Williams was walking away, Mrs. Williams turned, and stated: "don't you get back on that elevator." Student ██████████ said that she then turned down her headphones and told Mrs. Williams that she was not getting back on the elevator. That is when Mrs. Williams requested the security officer to check her ID.

The Securitas Security Officer (1) is a black female with dreadlocks 5'3" tall, stocky build. Both Mrs. Williams and the Security Officer simultaneously asked for my ID, and I gave it to the Securitas Officer. After the security officer had reviewed my I.D., the security officer gave it back, and I proceeded to walk up the stairs from the lower lobby. That is when another security officer (2) approached me. That security officer (2) was a black male, brown complexion, 6'3", with a short afro. Student ██████████ further stated, I was explaining to security officer (2) what had occurred at the lower level when AP Bogins walked up and asked what happen and what was her name? Student ██████████ gave AP Bogins her name and continued to give an account of the incident when AP Bogins interjected and stated why was I upset. Student ██████████ then interjected and advised AP Bogins that I was just on the elevator going to class. Student ██████████ reports that AP Bogins started "yelling" at her and I asked him if we could speak in his office. Student ██████████ says AP Bogins continued yelling at me, and I then placed my headphone back on to tune him out.

Student ██████████ states that a Campus Security Police Officer Charles Brazier (CSPO) described as being a dark complexion male, 6'4", and wearing a (DPS) uniform arrived on location due to the fact of the elevation of AP Bogins voice. Student ██████████ then stated that the CSPO indicated to me he was going to take my phone, and I responded no, I'm calling my mom.

The CSPO grabbed my phone I pulled back my phone, and the CSPO grabbed my arm and said you're coming with me. AP Bogins advised the CSPO that she did not feel safe with him, and the CSPO then pushed her to the stairs, taking her to the ground. Student ██████████ reports that the CSPO then advised me to get up, and I requested and ambulance. The CSPO said get up or I will drag you. I said, he grabbed my arm and pulled me from the stairs by the central office to the second floor to the bookstore in the dark corner, slamming me into the wall, causing me to hit her my head. The CSPO instructed me to get up again, and I again requested and ambulance.

Student ██████████ goes on to report that during the confrontation another Securitas Security Officer (SO) Crasenthea Harris described as being a black female, brown complexion, 5'6" tall, waves & curly shoulder length hair came over after seeing the commotion and asked me if I wanted to go with her. Student ██████████ stated that she agreed to go with SO-Harris, and the CSPO stated no she is going with me. The CSPO then said if you don't get up off the floor and go with me I will pepper spray you. The SO-Harris advised him not to do that, and the CSPO sprayed her several times. Several individuals tried to get me some water on the second floor. Two Securitas officers

carried me to the water. EMS #1 arrived on location with my mother and took me to Children's Hospital for treatment.

Also, Student [REDACTED] states that someone carried me to the north side room, she says that she doesn't remember who poured water in her eyes. Student [REDACTED] says that she was only able to see a blur. I felt a burning sensation that was overwhelming and more than I could stand. I heard Principal Mrs. Phillips instruct security to call 911 for an EMS. My mom arrived, and approximately five (5) minutes later the ambulance arrived. My mom road with me to Children's Hospital.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED MRS. CICELY WILLIAMS AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH LOCATED AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE AT 10:00 A.M. DECEMBER 9, 2015

The writer interviewed Mrs. Cicely Williams (TEACHER) at the above location, and she stated the following. On December 9, 2015, student Destiny [REDACTED] got on the elevator at approximately 8:25 a.m. Mrs. Williams asked Student [REDACTED] for her elevator pass, and Student [REDACTED] produced a pass dated, October 5, through October 9, 2015. Mrs. Williams informed Student [REDACTED] that her pass was invalid, and [REDACTED] Heard kept the pass. After informing Student [REDACTED] that she would have to get off the elevator, Student [REDACTED] stepped off the elevator and stood there as if she was waiting for the next elevator. Mrs. Williams instructed Student [REDACTED] to take the stairs, but Student [REDACTED] continued standing at the door. Mrs. Williams asked Student [REDACTED] for her I.D. numerous times, and she refused to produce one.

Mrs. Williams says she called for assistance and Securitas Officer Jayna Payne came and requested I.D. from Student [REDACTED], and she kept asking why. Student [REDACTED] continued being insubordinate and finally pulled her I.D. half way out. Mrs. Williams made an attempt to retrieve Student [REDACTED]'s ID, and she pulled it back. At this point, Student [REDACTED] proceeded to run up the stairs and was called back several times, but ignored the orders of Mrs. Williams and Securitas Officer Payne. Attached is the written and signed statement of Mrs. Williams.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED SECURITAS SECURITY OFFICER JAYNA PAYNE AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL LOCATED AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE AT 10:30 A.M. DECEMBER 9, 2015

The writer interviewed Securitas Security Officer Jayna Payne, and she stated the following. On December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:33 a.m. while sitting at the security desk in the south lobby she was summoned by Mrs. William's (teacher) to assist with a student [REDACTED], who refused to give her I.D. after she had produced an elevator pass that was expired. Securitas Officer Payne requested Student [REDACTED] I.D. several times, and she refused and kept asking why they needed her ID? Student [REDACTED] then ran up the south stairs, and Securitas Officer Raghbir Warren proceeded after her on the second floor. Securitas officer Payne also gave this writer a written statement.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED SECURITAS OFFICER RAGHIB WARREN AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE ON DECEMBER 9, 2015 AT 11:00 A.M.

The writer interviewed Securitas Security Officer Raghیب Warren who stated the following: On December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:30 a.m. he observed student ██████████ standing in front of the elevator and was being told by teacher Mrs. Williams to take the stairwell because Student ██████████ did not have a valid elevator pass. Securitas Officer Warren stated that Student ██████████ continued standing at the elevator, refusing to take the stairwell after being directed several times by Mrs. Williams. Securitas Officer Warren said that he then witnessed Securitas Officer Jayna Payne telling Student ██████████ to take the stairs as well, but he stated that she still refused, and Securitas Officer Payne got on the radio and called for the assistance of Campus Security Police Officer Charles Braziel.

Securitas Officer Warren reported that Student ██████████ then proceeded to run up the stairs and stopped when confronted by AP Bogins, who was trying to figure out what was going on. However, Student ██████████ ignored AP Bogins and continued walking away from him after being asked several times to stop. Securitas Officer Warren said that Campus Security Police Officer Charles Braziel made it to the second level and attempted to talk with Student ██████████, who became very hostile by yelling and cursing at the officer. Securitas Officer Warren further stated that Student ██████████ was escorted to the north security office, and her parents were contacted. Securitas Officer Raghیب Warren also gave this writer a written statement.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED SECURITAS OFFICER CRASENTHEA HARRIS AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE ON DECEMBER 9, 2015 AT 11:30 A.M.

The writer interviewed Securitas Officer (SO) Crasenthea Harris. SO-Harris stated the following: On December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:25 a.m. she was called on the radio by AP Bogins to make the second floor of the school for student ██████████, who was in front of the bookstore being insubordinate and had assaulted Campus Security Police Officer Charles Braziel.

Securitas Officer Harris stated that when she made it to the second floor, Student ██████████ was sitting on the ground near the bookstore yelling, "I am not going with him, fuck him, he slammed me on the floor," referring to Campus Security Police Officer Braziel. Securitas Officer Harris stated that she asked Student ██████████, "What's wrong," and she said that Student ██████████ just kept repeating, "I'm not going with him."

Securitas Officer Harris reported that Student ██████████'s mother was calling her cell phone, and she (S/O Harris) answered the phone and advised Ms. ██████████ to come up to the school to retrieve her daughter because she was insubordinate and that she had assaulted Campus Security Police Officer Braziel. Securitas Officer Harris stated that she then passed the cellphone to Campus Security Police Officer Braziel, who was able to advise Ms. Venus in more detail as to her daughter's (██████████) behavior. According to Securitas Officer Harris, once Campus Security Police Officer Braziel got off the phone with Student ██████████'s mother, he asked Student ██████████ repeatedly to get up off the floor and go to the student affairs office, but again she refused.

Securitas Officer Harris stated that she then told Student [REDACTED] that she needed to calm down and follow instructions. Securitas Officer Harris reported that Campus Security Police Officer Braziel attempted to help student Destiny [REDACTED] up from the floor, but she began kicking and tried to bite him. Securitas Officer Harris stated that Campus Security Police Officer Braziel advised that if Student [REDACTED] continued kicking and attempting to bite him, that he was going to have to spray her if her behavior continues. Securitas Officer Harris stated that Campus Security Police Officer Braziel tried to help Student [REDACTED] up once again, and she began kicking him and at this time, she was given one burst of pepper spray to the face by Campus Officer Charles Braziel.

Then Securitas Officer Harris stated that with the assistance of Securitas Officer Warren they were able to help Student [REDACTED] up from the floor and walk her over to the water fountain and cleansed her face and eyes. Securitas Officer Harris stated that she and Securitas Officer Warren then escorted Student [REDACTED] to the security office in the north lobby area at the direction of Campus Security Police Officer Braziel. Securitas Officer Harris stated that once they were inside the security office, Campus Security Police Officer Braziel continued giving Student [REDACTED] water on her face and that she (S/O Harris) also escorted Student [REDACTED] outside so that she could get some fresh air.

Securitas Officer Harris stated that immediately after her arrival, [REDACTED] was lead to her detained daughter, Student [REDACTED] in the security office. Mrs. [REDACTED], asked her daughter, Student [REDACTED], "What Happened?" Securitas Officer Harris stated that Student [REDACTED] became irate again but at that time EMS (Medic #1) had arrived on location and transported the student to the hospital without incident. Securitas Officer Harris also gave this writer a written statement.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL ORLANDO T. BOGINS AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE ON DECEMBER 9, 2015 AT 12:00 P.M.

The writer interviewed Assistant Principal Orlando T. Bogins who stated the following: On December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:30 a.m. AP Bogins reported that he overheard Securitas Officer Payne call for Campus Security Police Officer Braziel to make the south lobby immediately. AP Bogins states that when he made it to the south lobby Securitas Officer Rahib Warren, and DPS Officer Braziel was already at the location. Officer Brazil and SO Warren advised AP Bogins that the teacher Mrs. Williams asked student [REDACTED] for an elevator pass. As mentioned in earlier interviews, it is Cass Tech's rules that students do not ride the elevator unless they have valid elevator pass.

Also, AP Bogins states that student [REDACTED] could not produce a pass, and when asked for her school identification by Mrs. Williams, she handed it to her then snatched it back out of Mrs. Williams hands and refused to give it back. AP Bogins stated that once student [REDACTED] was in front of him, he began to ask her several questions so that he could get an understanding as to what was going on, and she became very irate with him as well. AP Bogins stated that he with the assistance of DPS Officer Braziel were trying to talk to student [REDACTED], but she had a very nasty tone and was clearly upset.

AP Bogins stated that as he was speaking with student ██████████, she was on her cell phone and had her ear piece in her ears. AP Bogins reported that he asked her to put the items away “(1)” while he was speaking with her and she refused. AP Bogins said that DPS Officer Braziel then asked student ██████████ to put her phone and ear piece away “(2),” she refused and then was told by DPS Officer ██████████ to give him the items “(3),” and she refused. AP Bogins stated that DPS Officer Braziel told student ██████████ “Let’s go to my office,” but again she refused all request, while being incredibly rude, insubordinate, and refusing to move physically.

AP Bogins stated that DPS Officer Braziel attempted to guide student ██████████ towards his office, but when she refused DPS Officer Braziel forced her to move. AP Bogins said that he then called for Securitas Officer Harris to come to the area, but by this time student ██████████ was kicking and elbowing DPS Officer Braziel and refusing to go to the office. At this point AP Bogins stated that DPS Officer Braziel pepper sprayed student ██████████. AP Bogins summoned the school's nurse, Ms. Gandy, to assist with the situation, but student ██████████ started screaming, yelling, crying, pulling her hair, and saying she could not breathe. AP Bogins stated that he called 911 for assistance. AP Bogins reported that they provided water, and fresh air to student ██████████ and she was still irate. AP Bogins also gave this writer a written statement.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED SCHOOL NURSE MS. GANDY AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE ON DECEMBER 9,2015 AT 12:30 P.M.

The writer interviewed Nurse Gandy (School Nurse) who stated the following: On December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:30 a.m. Nurse Gandy said that she was walking to the Main office when she noticed AP Bogins, Campus Officer Braziel, and student Destiny Heard in the hallway. Nurse Gandy said that she heard AP Bogins ask student ██████████ to remove her ear buds, but she refused to comply. Nurse Gandy further mentioned she then heard Campus Security Police Officer Braziel ask student ██████████ to remove the earbuds or he was going to take them along with her cell phone. Nurse Gandy stated that student ██████████ said, “You’re not going to take anything from me.”

Nurse Gandy stated that Campus Officer Braziel started walking towards ██████████, and she began swinging at him, at which time Nurse Gandy said that she was asked to go to the office and obtain ██████████ contact information. Nurse Gandy said that when she returned with the students contact information, she noticed ██████████ sitting on the floor in front of the bookstore. Nurse Gandy said that Campus Officer Braziel asked student ██████████ to get up off the floor and go to the office, but ██████████ told him that she was not getting up and going anywhere with him.

Nurse Gandy stated that Securitas Officer Harris and Campus Officer Braziel bent down and tried to help ██████████ up from the floor, and she began kicking, screaming and squirming all over the floor at Campus Officer Braziel. Nurse Gandy stated that both officers tried to restrain ██████████, but stated that she was still fighting with officers. Nurse Gandy said that Securitas Officer Harris and Campus Officer Braziel were able to get ██████████ up on her

feet, and proceeded to the security office with her. Nurse Gandy stated that [REDACTED] began saying that she could not breathe, so she went to her room and retrieved her medical bag so that she could take [REDACTED]'s vital signs.

Nurse Gandy stated that when she made it to the security office, [REDACTED] had been sprayed by Campus Officer Braziel, who was splashing water on her face to ease the burning. Nurse Gandy stated that she took [REDACTED]'s pulse which was 109, but said that she could not get any other vital signs because [REDACTED] was squirming and moving around too much. Nurse Gandy said that Securitas Officer Harris was wiping [REDACTED]'s face while Campus Officer Braziel was flushing her eyes with water. Nurse Gandy stated that another staff member Principal, Mrs. Phillips implied that [REDACTED] suffers from asthma, but Nurse Gandy said that there were no signs to confirm that student [REDACTED] was asthmatic.

Nurse Gandy stated that [REDACTED]'s mother [REDACTED] arrived on location and asked her daughter what was wrong, and [REDACTED] said, "He sprayed me and my eyes hurt." Nurse Gandy said that [REDACTED] began screaming and pulling her hair at which time EMS arrived and asked for some milk, therefore, she went to the cafeteria and retrieved two cartons of milk and turned them over to paramedics. Nurse Gandy also gave this writer a written statement.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED MR. ANTHONY SMITH AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE ON DECEMBER 9, 2015 AT 1:00 P.M.

The writer interviewed Mr. Anthony Smith who stated the following: On December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:30 a.m. Mr. Anthony Smith stated that he was heading to the administration suite and noticed student [REDACTED] in a physical struggle with Officer Braziel. Mr. Smith stated that [REDACTED] was unyielding and yelling obscenities at Campus Officer Braziel. Mr. Smith stated that [REDACTED] fell to a sitting position in the corner near the bookstore and refused to get up when she was asked to do so by Officer Braziel.

Mr. Smith stated that he believed that the situation was under control, so he proceeded to the administration suite, and by the time he reached the door, he heard [REDACTED] shouting and screaming. Mr. Smith stated that he went back towards the bookstore where he observed officers escorting [REDACTED], one officer on either side of her holding her by the arms escorting her towards the student affairs suite. Mr. Smith stated that Principal Phillips then redirected them to the North Lobby area.

Mr. Smith stated that as they were escorting [REDACTED] to the North Lobby area, and he heard her yell, "I have asthma, I can't breathe." Mr. Smith stated that he noticed Nurse Gandy immediately run towards the student affairs doors. Mr. Smith stated that Principal Phillips and AP Bogins followed the officers and [REDACTED] towards the North Lobby. Mr. Smith stated that Principal Phillips instructed AP Bogins to call 911. Mr. Smith stated that when he reached the North Lobby, he noticed [REDACTED] flopping around on the floor, just as she had when she was near the bookstore.

Mr. Smith stated that he went to get a wheelchair and when he returned the EMS Technicians were on location, as well as the mother of ~~Destiny Hester~~. Mr. Smith stated ~~Destiny Hester's~~ mom asked what happened, and ~~Destiny Hester~~ replied, "They sprayed me." Mr. Smith stated that the EMS Technician then asked ~~Destiny Hester's~~ mother if ~~Destiny Hester~~ suffered from asthma, and her mother stated, "No." Mr. Smith stated that the mother of ~~Destiny Hester~~ kept asking who sprayed her daughter and saying that her daughter is a good girl. According to Mr. Smith, after EMS Technicians conveyed ~~Destiny Hester~~, he returned to his office. Mr. Smith also gave this writer a written statement.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED PRINCIPAL LISA PHILLIPS VIA TELEPHONE ON JANUARY 15, 2016 AT 10:30 A.M.

The writer interviewed Principal Lisa Phillips via telephone who stated the following: On December 9, 2016, at approximately 8:30 a.m. Mrs. Phillips stated that she witnessed student ~~Destiny Hester~~ sitting in a corner near the bookstore refusing all requests to get up from the floor and go with the officers to the code office. Mrs. Phillips stated that ~~Destiny Hester~~ was using profanity and refusing to listen or move. Mrs. Phillips stated that she felt like the situation was being handled properly by the officers, so she left.

Mrs. Phillips stated that minutes later, she heard screaming, so she returned to the scene and witnessed ~~Destiny Hester~~ screaming and crying. Mrs. Phillips stated that someone mentioned that ~~Destiny Hester~~ had been pepper sprayed. Mrs. Phillips stated that the nurse was there as well. Mrs. Phillips stated that she recalls the school nurse screaming "she has asthma, and that ~~Destiny Hester~~ can't breathe," as she was running to get her medical bag in her office. Mrs. Phillips stated that the officers picked ~~Destiny Hester~~ up from the floor and carried her to the security room, and she followed. Mrs. Phillips stated that once she reached the officers' office, the officers were pouring water on her head and face trying to defuse the pepper spray reaction. Mrs. Phillips stated that she immediately requested that someone call EMS. Mrs. Phillips stated that after ~~Destiny Hester~~ had left, she assembled all officers and asked that they make sure they include everything when completing their reports. Mrs. Phillips also emailed this writer a written statement.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 INTERVIEWED CSPO CHARLES BRAZIEL AT CASS TECHNICAL HIGH SCHOOL AT 2501 SECOND AVENUE ON DECEMBER 9, 2015 AT 1:30 P.M.

The writer interviewed CSPO Charles Braziel, who is approximately 5'9,' 220 lbs. Stated the following: On December 9, 2015, at approximately 8:20 a.m. CSPO Braziel stated that he was called to the south wing of the school to assist with irate student ~~Destiny Hester~~. CSPO Braziel stated that when he approached he observed ~~Destiny Hester~~ in a verbal altercation with Assistant Principal AP Bogins regarding her riding the school elevator without a valid pass.

CSPO Braziel stated that as he attempted to assist student ~~Destiny Hester~~, however, ~~Destiny Hester~~ begins to direct her hostility towards him. CSPO Braziel stated that he then asked ~~Destiny Hester~~ to walk down to student affairs with him, but she refused. CSPO Braziel stated that as he

attempted to detain [REDACTED] for disorderly conduct, she elbowed him in the chest and began using profanity towards him.

CSPO Braziel stated that as he continued escorting [REDACTED] to the office, she continued being combative to the point that he had to radio for assistance from Security Officers Warren and Harris. CSPO Braziel stated that [REDACTED] then threw herself into the wall, fell on the floor and then blamed him for hitting her in the head. CSPO Braziel stated that he asked Destiny Heard several times to get up off the floor, but she refused.

CSPO Braziel stated that he along with other security officer attempted to pick [REDACTED] up off the floor, but she began kicking him and tried to bite him on his right hand. CSPO Braziel stated that he advised [REDACTED] that if she did not stop she would be pepper sprayed. CSPO Braziel stated that after advising [REDACTED] several more times after the initial order, she was given one burst of his Department Issued Pepper Spray to the face. CSPO Braziel stated that even after he sprayed, [REDACTED] continued being combative and continued using profanity.

CSPO Braziel stated that after escorting [REDACTED] to the security office, she was given water to her face, and school Nurse Gandy gave medical attention. CSPO Braziel reported that someone called EMS for [REDACTED], and Medic #1 responded and transported [REDACTED] to Children's Hospital for medical treatment with her mother in tow. CSPO Braziel reported that [REDACTED] condition was temp-serious, per Dr. Sarnark, with a chart #78001266720. CSPO Braziel also completed a Crisnet Report, a Chemical Spray Report and a JC01 Packet.

SERGEANT EMMITT SMITH, BADGE S-35 RECEIVED VIDEO EVIDENCE FROM DPS IT TECH ANGELO MURPHY ON DECEMBER 10, 2015 AT 1:00 PM

The writer obtained video evidence of the incident that occurred between CSPO Braziel and complainant [REDACTED] on December 10, 2015, at approximately 1:00 p.m. DPS IT Tech Angelo Murphy downloaded the video evidence and saved on a disk.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Writer reviewed CSPO Charles Braziel's personnel file and found there to be no prior disciplinary actions.

FINDINGS

According to our department **Force Continuum Policy**, CSPO Braziel made several attempts to de-escalate a disgruntled and potential volatile students without subjecting her to physical force. As per the Detroit Public Schools Police Officer Manual, Section 304.2 – 3.1, **Actively Resisting**, "Means the subject is making physically evasive movements to defeat an officer's attempt at control, including bracing, tensing, pulling away, or pushing."

Officer Charles Brazil had followed proper procedure before he sprayed [REDACTED] with his department issued spray by using the below list steps.

Step One: he advised Student [REDACTED] that she was under arrest for being a disorderly person
(creating improper diversion inside a Detroit Public School while in session)

Step Two: he made several request for Student [REDACTED] to remove herself from the floor. As he was attempting to pick her up from the floor, she continued using profanity and struggling with Officer Charles Braziel, even trying to bite his arm?

Step Three: after Officer Charles Braziel had exhausted all his resources to gain control of the situation; he gave [REDACTED] one burst of his department issued (STREAM LAW ENFORCEMENT FORMULA FOX SPRAY).

After [REDACTED] had been pepper sprayed, she started yelling and screaming excessively, also using profanity. With the assistance of Securitas Security Officers, Officer Braziel was able to detain D [REDACTED]

Step Four: Student [REDACTED] was taken immediately to a secured area, where her face and eyes rinsed out with water by Officer Braziel the school's nurse Mrs. Gandy. EMS Unit #1 responded and also rendered aid to [REDACTED] and conveyed Ms. Destiny [REDACTED] to Detroit Children's Hospital. While Childrens' Hospital Destiny received treatments and released the same day.

Based on the facts above of this incident, the action exhibited by CSPO Charles Braziel was found to be **proper, considering** all the witnesses interviewed, statements were consistent, also due to the video evidence regarding this matter. The allegation is **unfounded**; it is demonstrably false, or there is no credible evidence to support it.

RECOMMENDATIONS

The writer recommends closure to this Investigation and Report of Force and Demeanor by Officer Braziel. Furthermore, this report is being forwarded for executive perusal.

The writer has read the investigation and reports submitted by Sergeant Emmitt Smith, Badge #S-35, and viewed the partial video of the incident regarding a Citizen Complaint with areas of concern of **Force** and **Demeanor** against Campus Security Police Officer Charles Braziel.

Specifically, the department defines **Force** and **Demeanor** as follows:

Force: Complaint regarding the use or threatened use of force against a person.

Demeanor: Complaint regarding a department member's bearing, gesture, language or other action which allegedly is offensive or of doubtful social propriety or gives the appearance of conflict of interest, misuse of influence or lack of jurisdiction or authority.

The complainant, a Cass Technical High School Student, ~~REDACTED~~ along with her mother, ~~REDACTED~~, of 185 E. Grand Blvd., Detroit, MI. 48207, made these above allegations at DPSPD Police Headquarters (see attached complaint form 15-058).

After reading Sergeant Smith's report, the writer finds it to be thorough and complete. Also, the writer is in concurrence with Sergeant Smith findings that the action taken by Officer Braziel to subdue [REDACTED], was consistent with the Department Use of Force Policy. The majority of the witnesses' statements concurred that Student [REDACTED]'s conduct and language during the entire encounter was abusive, disruptive and inappropriate during school hours. Student [REDACTED] not only disregarded the commands of Officer Braziel, she also, ignored the directives articulated by school administrators and security officers.


After exhausting all the de-escalation methods, Officer Braziel made an attempt to arrest Student [REDACTED] for Disorderly Conduct. According to statements, Student [REDACTED] continued to resist, and Officer Braziel sprayed Student [REDACTED]. For a brief moment, Student [REDACTED] began kicking and screaming and was carried away by a Securitas Officer and administered first aid.


Point of Interpretation, when everyone reviews the five (5) minutes video of an approximately thirty (30) minute ordeal, involving [REDACTED] and Officer Braziel, viewers will focus on Officer Braziel kicking [REDACTED]. I attribute Officer Braziel reactions as a split second response to being kicked or a sensory stimulus (ascribe to a temporary discomfort to his leg) and his subsequent behavioral response. Also, the videotape of the incident provided limited footage of the entire incident, which began on the first floor by the elevator and ended on the second floor at the Book Store. Therefore, the vantage points of the submitted videotape was skewed.

A not in custody petition for [REDACTED] was filed with the 3rd Circuit Court, Juvenile Division. The 3rd Circuit Court adjourn the Hearing Date from March 4th, 2016, to April 11th, 2016.

Based on the totality of the incident and the witness statement, the writer finds that Officer Braziel's conduct to be proper. Meaning, the action of the department or its member(s) was consistent with department policy. Also, the writer recommends no further action be taken, and this matter concluded.



CPO Braziel than inform us to take her to the security office in the North Lobby. On Wednesday, December 9, 2015, I overheard Securitas Officer Payne call for DPS Officer Black or Brazil to come to the South Lobby immediately. Once I arrived, there was Securitas Officer Kennedy, Warren and DPS Officer Brazil sharing the details of the incident. They informed me that student [REDACTED] had a confrontational dialogue with a teacher regarding violating one of Cass Tech's rules-to not ride the elevator, unless you have an elevator pass. The teacher and student's dialogue is as follow:

"Ms. Williams, asked for a pass. Student could not produce one. She asked for the student to give her, her ID. The student did, but then somehow snatched it back from the teacher. The student was told that she should move and go to the office. The student refused. This is why DPS Officer Brazil was called to assist."

Once the student was in front of me, I begin to ask her several questions to grab an understanding of what happened. The student was very irate and obviously upset over the situation. DPS Officer Brazil and I were trying to talk to her, but she had a nasty tone with us and her body language implied that she was extremely upset. We proceeded to ask questions to grab an understanding of the entire incident. When I began to tell her how this could be avoided, she refused to look at me. I told her to look at me while I was talking and to put her phone away and to take her ear piece out of her ear. She followed my request but soon after, she took the phone back out and put the ear piece back in her ear. I asked her to put it away. She would not. Officer Brazil asked her, she did not. Officer Brazil then asked for the items and she would not give them to him. He then said, "let's go to my office." She refused, all while being extremely rude, insubordinate, and refusing to move physically. Officer Brazil guided the student to go to his office and she refused and then he had to use force to get her to go. I then called for Securitas Officer Harris to come to the area. By this time, the student was fighting back with Officer Brazil, kicking and elbowing him, refusing to go to the office. Next, we had Nurse Gandy, Mr. Smith, Mrs. Phillips, trying to understand the situation as the student resist to follow what the officers asking her to do. Finally, the student was picked up to go to another office, being carried by Securitas Officers Warren and Harris. The student begin to say she couldn't breathe. They gave her water, she was screaming, crying, pulling her hair. Finally, I was instructed to call 911 and have the student assisted.

Upon leaving the grand theatre enroute to the administration suite, I noticed ██████ in a physical struggle with Officer Brazil. I heard the officer telling ██████ to "stop." She was unyielding and she was yelling obscenities at Officer Brazil. She fell to a sitting position in the corner near the bookstore and refused to get up when Officer Brazil instructed her to do so. Other security officers had come by the time I reached them. Believing that the situation was being properly handled, I proceeded on toward the administration suite.


Before entering the suite, however, I heard ██████ shouting and screaming. I went back around the staircase to find out what was happening. I saw the officers escorting Destiny, one officer on either side of her holding her by the arms, in the direction of the student affairs suite. They were instructed by Principal Phillips, who had also come from the area of the administration suite, to take her to the North Lobby instead of the student affairs suite.

As they were walking, I heard ██████ yelling, "I have asthma, I can't breathe." I saw Nurse Gandy immediately head toward the student affairs doors. Mrs. Phillips, Mr. Bogins, and I were following the officers and ██████ toward the north lobby. As we approached the Student Affairs Suite, Mrs. Phillips told me to make sure Nurse Gandy knew that ██████ said she had asthma and to see if there was something she could do. Mr. Bogins, she instructed to call 911. We complied. Upon relaying the message to Nurse Gandy, she said that she heard ██████ and she was already handling it.

By the time I reached the North Lobby, ██████ was flopping down toward the floor, much as she had done when she sat in the corner. I went to get a wheelchair. Upon my returning to the North Lobby, the ambulance had come. ██████'s mother came very shortly thereafter.

I heard the mother asking, "what happened?" ██████ said, "they sprayed me." The emergency technician asked the mother, "does she have asthma?" The mother replied, "no." She kept asking who sprayed her daughter mixed with her exclamations that her daughter is a good girl and "this is not like her."

Once the emergency technicians wheeled ██████ to the ambulance, I returned inside to ascertain what happened. Officer Brazil told me his account of what happened. I went to my office and wrote this report.

Per our conversation, I am providing my account of the incident between [REDACTED] and Officer Braziel. On December 9, 2016, I witnessed student [REDACTED] sitting in a corner near the bookstore refusing all requests to get up from the floor and go with the officers to the code office. [REDACTED] was using profanity and refusing to listen or move. I felt like the situation was being handled properly by the officers, so I left. Minutes later, I heard screaming, so I returned to the scene and witnessed [REDACTED] screaming and crying. It was mentioned that she had been sprayed with pepper spray. The nurse was there as well. Our school nurse screamed "she has asthma and she can't breath," as she was running to her office to get her medical bag. The officers picked [REDACTED] up from the floor and carried her to their office. I followed. Once I reach their office, I entered. The officers were pouring water on her head and face trying to defuse the pepper spray reaction. I immediately asked for EMS to be called. After she left, I assembled all officers and asked that they make sure they cross and dot everything when completing their reports.

I was walking to the main office when I noticed Mr Bogins, officer Braziel and a student in the hallway. Mr Bogins asked the student to remove her ear buds. She would not comply so officer Braziel asked her to remove them or he will take her whole phone. She stated that he wasn't going to take anything from her. Officer Braziel moved toward her and the student started swinging at him; they were on the stairs leading up to the dining commons when Mr Bogins asked me to go in the office to obtain her contact information.

My next encounter with the student is when she was sitting on the floor in the corner by the book store with officer Harris, officer warren and officer Braziel. Officer Braziel asked her to get up and go with him to his office down in the North Lobby. She said she wasn't moving or going anywhere with him. Officer Harris asked if she would walk with her and [redacted] said yes. Officer Braziel + Officer Harris went down to help her up off the floor

when the student started kicking and screaming at officer Braziel, squirming and rolling on the floor. Officer Harris & Braziel tried to restrain her, student kept yelling and screaming and fighting. Finally officer Harris & Officer Warren was able to get her up to her feet and was escorting her down to the north lobby. While walking down the hall she started saying she couldn't breathe so I ran to my office to obtain my bag + some water so I can check her vitals. The officers continued to take her down to the North lobby.

When I reached the North lobby I can hear her screaming & yelling in Officer Braziel's office so I knocked on the door. When I got in there she was sitting in a chair shirt wet, crying, eyes red. Officer Braziel was splashing water in her face, eyes. She was coughing, slobbering & rubbing her eyes, stating it hurts & burns. I obtained her Pulse O₂ which was 99% pulse was 109. She kept squirming & moving around but I couldn't obtain her vitals. Officer Harris was wiping her face & Officer Braziel was flushing her eyes. Mrs. Phillips came to the door to check

on the situation and stated that the student has Asthma, but there were no signs to show that. She asked what happened and i heard officer Braziel state he had to spray her because she was assaulting him. She stated call 911, when then took the young lady out into the vestibule of the North lobby so she can get some air. Mr Butler brought down a wheel chair for us. Destiny was sitting in the chair; i gave her some water which some she drank and some she poured on her face. Officer Payne called me over the radio for my location because Destiny's mother was here. I told her our location. When the mother reached us, 911 was at the ~~curb~~ curb. The mother asked what was wrong & Destiny started screaming and pulling on her hair. She said ~~He~~ He sprayed me, my eyes hurt. EMS worker asked for some milk and i ran to dining commons & retrieved two cartons of milk and returned to lobby. Handed them to the EMS worker and backed down.



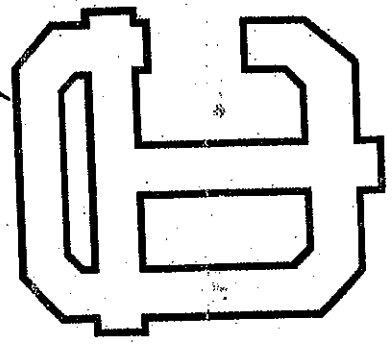

USE OF FORCE

304.2 - 1 PURPOSE

To establish policy, guidelines and limitations for the Detroit Public Schools Police Department (DPSPD) concerning the appropriate and acceptable use of deadly and less lethal force.

304.2 - 2 POLICY

An improper use of authority and/or excessive or unjustified use of force undermine the legitimacy of an officer's authority and hinders the Department's ability to provide effective law enforcement services to the community. Officers who use excessive force or an unauthorized use of force shall be subject to discipline, possible criminal prosecution, and/or civil liability. **Use of force is only authorized when it is objectively reasonable and for a lawful purpose.** Research indicates that one of the most common factors found in both police excessive or unjustified use of force, and officer injuries and fatalities during force encounters is an officer's perceived compulsion to press forward, rather than to disengage (e.g., "back off") and explore other options. The most appropriate response choice to a situation often involves de-escalation, disengagement, area containment, surveillance, waiting out a subject, summoning reinforcements, or calling in specialized units. **Following any use of force resulting in a citizen's injury, officers shall notify a supervisor and ensure that appropriate medical aid and/or emergency medical service is rendered as soon as possible.**

304.2 - 3 Definitions

304.2 - 3.1 Actively Resisting

Means the subject is making physically evasive movements to defeat an officer's attempt at control, including bracing, tensing, pulling away, or pushing.

304.2 - 3.2 Command Investigation

Means an investigation conducted by a Detroit Public Schools Police Department supervisor.

304.2 - 3.3 Control

Control is the ability to command or direct with or without voluntary compliance. Officers shall control with the subject's consent, if possible, but force the subject to comply, if necessary.

304.2 - 3.4 Critical Discharge of a Firearm

Each discharge of a firearm by an officer with the exception of range and training discharges and discharges at animals.

304.2 - 3.5 Deadly / Lethal Force

Deadly or lethal force is any force used by an officer that has a reasonable probability of causing death or serious bodily injury.

304.2 - 3.6 Discipline

A written reprimand, suspension, demotion or dismissal.

304.2 - 3.7 Escorting

The use of light physical pressure to guide a person, or keep a person in place.

304.2 - 3.8 Force

The term "force" means the following actions by an officer: any physical strike or instrumental contact with a person; any intentional attempted physical strike or instrumental contact that does not take effect; or any significant physical contact that restricts the movement of a person. The term includes the discharge of a firearm; the use of chemical spray, chokeholds or hard hands; the taking of a subject to the ground; or the deployment of a canine. The term does not include escorting or handcuffing a person, with no or minimal resistance. Use of force is lawful if it is **objectively reasonable** under the circumstances and the minimum amount of force that is necessary to affect an arrest or protect the officer or other person is used.

304.2 - 3.9 Hard Hands

Using physical pressure to force a person against an object or the ground, or the use of physical strength or skill that causes pain or leaves a mark.

304.2 - 3.10 Imminent Threat

An imminent threat is an officer's reasonable perception of impending danger of death or serious injury from any action or outcome that may occur during an encounter. Thus, a subject may pose an imminent or impending danger even if he or she is not at that very moment pointing a weapon at the officer if, for example, he or she has a weapon within reach or is running for cover carrying a weapon or running to a place where the officer has reason to believe a weapon is available.

304.2 - 3.11 Injury

Any impairment of physical condition or pain.

304.2 - 3.12 Less Lethal Force

Any force used by an officer that would not reasonably be expected to cause death.

304.2 - 3.13 Objectively Reasonable

This term means that, in determining the necessity for force and the appropriate level of force, officers shall evaluate each situation in light of the known circumstances, including, but not limited to, the seriousness of the crime, the level of threat or resistance presented by the subject, and the danger to the community.

304.2 - 3.14 Prisoner Injury

An injury or complaint of injury that occurs in the course of taking or after an individual was taken into DPSPD custody that is **not** attributed to a use of force by a DPSPD employee.

304.2 - 3.15 Proper Use of Force Decision Making

The use of reasonable force, including proper tactics, and de-escalation techniques.

304.2 - 3.16 Serious Bodily Injury

Serious bodily injury is any injury that involves any of the following conditions: a loss of consciousness; extreme physical pain; disfigurement; prolonged loss or impairment of the function of a body part or organ; or a substantial risk of death.

304.2 - 3.17 Serious Use of Force

Any action by an officer that involves: 1) the use of deadly force, including all critical firearm discharges; 2) a use of force in which the person suffers serious bodily injury or requires hospital admission; 3) a canine bite; and 4) the use of chemical spray against a restrained person.

304.2 - 4 Authorization and Limitations

304.2 - 4.1 Less Lethal Force

1. Sworn members are authorized to use DPSPD approved less lethal use of force techniques and DPSPD issued equipment where necessary to:

- a. Protect the officer or another person from physical harm;
- b. Make a lawful arrest when a subject offers resistance;
- c. Stop potentially dangerous and/or criminal behavior; or
- d. Protect subjects from injuring themselves.

2. Where less lethal force is authorized, members shall assess the incident to determine which less lethal technique or weapon will best de-escalate the incident and bring the situation under control in a safe manner;

3. Use of force, restraints and/or weapons shall never be used as punishment or retaliation.

304.2 - 4.2 Deadly Force

1. Use of deadly force is only authorized:

- a. Against a subject who poses an imminent threat of death or serious bodily injury to the officers or others; and only when bystanders are not in jeopardy;
- b. To prevent a subject's escape from a violent felony crime **and** only if the officer has probable cause to believe that the subject poses a continuing threat of death or serious bodily injury to anyone should he or she successfully escape, Tennessee v. Garner, 471 U.S.1, 85 (1985).

2. If less lethal force could reasonably be used to prevent the escape of a dangerous fleeing subject, or a subject fleeing from a violent felony crime, then deadly force is not authorized;
3. If feasible, officers shall identify themselves and state their intention to shoot before using a firearm;
4. A strike to the head of any person with an instrument constitutes a use of deadly force;
5. In addition to the above, the DPSPD further limits the use of deadly force to effect the arrest or to prevent the escape of a fleeing felon to the following felonies and only if the officer has probable cause to believe the fleeing felon will pose a significant threat of death or serious physical injury to the officer or others should he or she successfully escape:
 - a. Murder or attempted murder;
 - b. Assault with intent to commit murder;
 - c. Criminal sexual conduct, first and third degree;
 - d. Armed robbery or attempted armed robbery, or
 - e. Assaults that result in life-threatening bodily injury.

304.2 - 4.3 Prohibited Holds

The following neck restraints are prohibited except where deadly force is authorized:

1. Carotid submission hold;
2. A hold which interrupts the blood's flow to the brain;
3. A "sleeper hold" that can result in a person losing consciousness and/or death;
4. Bent arm submission hold/Hammer lock carotid hold. This hold restricts airflow to the trachea and can result in a loss of consciousness and/or death;
5. All other chokeholds.

304.2 - 4.4 Unauthorized Use of Deadly Force

1. Deadly force shall not be used against persons whose conduct is injurious only to themselves;
2. Firing at, or from a moving vehicle is prohibited absent extremely serious, exigent circumstances. Moreover, officers shall not intentionally place themselves in the path of a moving vehicle;
3. Warning shots are strictly prohibited;
4. Under no circumstances can shooting a firearm be justified to make an arrest for a misdemeanor charge or to apprehend a person fleeing from such a charge;
5. An officer shall not shoot a firearm in an attempt to apprehend a person merely on suspicion that a crime, no matter how serious, was committed, or if there is only a suspicion that the person being pursued committed the crime. An officer shall either have witnessed the crime, or shall have probable cause to believe that the person committed an offense that allows using deadly force.

304.2 - 4.5 Dangerous Animals

1. An officer may shoot a dangerous and/or rabid animal that is posing an imminent threat of danger to the officer or others and only when bystanders are not in jeopardy;
2. If the circumstances permit, when a member of the department has to shoot an animal suspected of being afflicted with rabies, the dog shall **NOT** be shot in the head. The carcass of the animal should be preserved for analysis of rabies;
3. The carcass of any animal that has been shot and that is believed to be afflicted with rabies shall be taken to the Animal Control Division. Immediate refrigeration of the carcass is of the utmost importance in the determination of rabid content;
4. When an officer comes in contact with a seriously injured or dangerous animal, the officer shall notify the proper agency (e.g., City of Detroit Animal Control, Michigan Humane Society, etc.);
5. In any instances where a member kills an animal, the officer's supervisor shall prepare a Destruction of Animal (DOA) Report.

304.2 - 5 Proper Use of Force Decision Making

304.2 - 5.1 General

When evaluating the force used by law enforcement, the U.S. Supreme Court, in the case of *Graham v. Connor*, 490 US 386 (1989), made clear that the determination requires a commonsense pragmatic approach stating that an officer's decision to use force occurs in "circumstances which are tense, uncertain, and rapidly evolving," and that there is no universal rule or "mechanical rule," that can be applied to all of the various situations encountered by a law enforcement officer.

304.2 - 5.2 Force Continuum

Just as officers must be prepared to respond appropriately to rising levels of resistance, they must likewise be prepared to **immediately** de-escalate and/or disengage from the use of force as the subject de-escalates or comes under the officer's control. **At times the most appropriate response option to a situation involves de-escalation, disengagement, area containment and/or surveillance, waiting out a subject, summoning reinforcements, or calling in specialized units. It is important for officers to remember that even at its lowest level; the use of force is a serious responsibility.** The force continuum is a model developed for illustrative purposes, defining the various levels of resistance and force exercised during a use of force incident. The continuum is based on the concept that as the resistive individual(s) increases the level of resistance or threat to the officer, the officer may increase the level of force necessary to overcome the resistance and conversely de-escalate and/or disengage as compliance is attained. The levels of resistance include:

- **Inactive Resistance:** Includes psychological intimidation (non-verbal cues indicating the subject's attitude, appearance and physical readiness) and verbal non-compliance (verbal responses indicating the subject's unwillingness to comply with direction may include verbal threats made by the subject).

- **Passive Resistance:** Physical actions that do not directly prevent the member's attempt of control.
 - **Active Resistance:** Means the subject is making physically evasive movements to defeat an officer's attempt at control, including bracing, tensing, pulling away, or pushing.
 - **Active Aggression:** Physical acts of aggression;
 - **Deadly Force:** Physical acts of aggression directed toward a member or another that are likely to cause serious bodily injury or death.
- The levels of force are:

- **Officer Presence/Verbal Direction:** The identification of authority through the officer's presence in uniform or by other means, such as a badge and identification card or apparel clearly identifying the member as an officer and/or communication directed toward controlling the actions of a subject. This may include direction, orders or commands;
- **Compliance Controls:** Physical techniques employed by officers (e.g.,escorting, touch pressure, joint locks, etc.) and the PR-24 Collapsible Baton as a non-impact control device;
- **Physical Controls:** (e.g., pain compliance, hard hands, etc.)
- **Intermediate Weapons:** The use of authorized less lethal weapons including impact weapons, chemical agents, and canines;
- **Deadly Force:** A tactic or use of force that is likely to cause serious bodily injury or death. When applying the concept of a force continuum, the totality of the circumstances involved in the incident must also be considered. Officers may initiate the use of force at any level of the force continuum that is appropriate under the circumstances. However, circumstances that may influence an officer may influence an officer's decision to escalate or de-escalate the amount of force used include, but are not limited to:
 - The nature of the offense;
 - Influence of drugs or alcohol;
 - Presence/proximity of weapons;
 - Officer/Subject factors (e.g., age, size, strength, etc.);
 - The feasibility and availability of alternative responses;
 - The availability of additional officers.

304.2 - 6 Training and Qualifications

304.2 - 6.1 General

All members shall be trained by qualified instructors in any authorized lethal or less lethal weapon they carry.

304.2 - 6.2 Firearms

1. While on and off duty, officers shall carry only weapons and ammunition authorized and approved by this Department;

2. Authorized weapons are those with which the officer has qualified and received Departmental training on proper and safe usage, and that are registered and comply with Department specifications;
3. Officers are required to attend regular use of force training and qualification sessions for duty and off-duty weapons (bi-annually). An off-duty weapon that is approved by DPSPD's Firearms Instructor, and that the member has qualified with, may be carried by members as a secondary weapon while on-duty;
4. An officer who has suffered from an illness or injury that could affect his or her use of firearms ability shall be required to re-qualify prior to returning to enforcement duties.

304.2 - 6.3 Less Lethal Weapons and Methods

1. No Department issued piece of equipment that is not designed or authorized to be used as a weapon (for example, flashlight, prep radio, handcuffs), shall be used as a weapon unless deadly force is authorized;
2. An officer is not permitted to use a less lethal weapon unless qualified in its proficient use as determined by a certified training instructor;
3. Intermediate weapons shall be carried or used as issued and authorized by the Department. No changes, alterations, or modifications are permitted.
4. A Department issued chemical spray device is authorized for on-duty or off-duty use. Members, when assigned to patrol or investigative duties, shall carry the device.
5. A PR-24 is an impact tool that offers a less lethal method for apprehending and subduing violent and/or actively resisting subject. Officers should target a subject's torso, arms, and legs. A PR-24 may also be used as a non-impact control device. Only members trained on the PR-24 baton may be equipped and/or carry the PR-24 baton. [
6. Weapons used for striking, other than the PR-24 side-handle baton, are strictly prohibited. Prohibited weapons include, but are not limited to: brass knuckles, blackjacks, nunchukus, saps, slapjacks, and other stick or clubs.

304.2 - 7 Duty to Report/Render Aid

Whenever a DPSPD member employs any use of force as defined by this Directive, such member shall, unless physically incapacitated:

1. Ensure that the subject has been properly restrained or no longer poses an immediate threat to the safety of officers or others;
2. Render first aid and summon Emergency Medical Services (EMS) if needed; and
3. Provide assistance to persons subjected to the effects of a Chemical Spray Device (Freeze+P), including:
 - a. Immediately after spraying a suspect, officers shall be alert to any indications that the individual needs medical care. This includes, but is not necessarily limited to, breathing difficulties, gagging, profuse sweating or loss of consciousness. Upon observing these or other medical problems

- or if the suspect requests medical assistance, the officer shall immediately summon emergency medical aid;
- b. Provide an opportunity for decontamination to a sprayed subject within twenty minutes of the application of the spray or the apprehension of the subject;
 - c. Sprayed subject(s) shall be continuously monitored for signs of a medical complaint. If a person complains of continued effects after having been decontaminated or they indicate that they have a pre-existing medical condition (e.g., asthma, emphysema, bronchitis or heart ailment) that may be aggravated by chemical spray, the subject shall immediately be conveyed to Detroit Receiving Hospital (DRH) for medical treatment;
 - d. Restrained subjects should be placed in an upright or seated position to avoid Positional Asphyxia which is death that occurs when a subject's body position interferes with breathing.

304.2 - 7.1 Use of Force Reporting

1. Officers shall notify their Dispatcher following any use of force or a prisoner injury. The Zone Dispatcher shall notify a non-involved sworn supervisor;
2. A non-involved supervisor **shall** respond to the scene following any use of force that involves a firearm discharge, a visible injury, or a complaint of injury;
3. A non-involved supervisor shall respond to all other uses of force on a priority basis. For the purpose of this Directive a "priority basis" is defined by the current availability of supervisors and the nature of the situation (e.g., highly charged situations, agitated bystanders, potential for violence) whereas response to the scene may increase volatility or be impracticable;
4. Upon arrival at the scene, the supervisor shall interview the officer(s), canvass for witnesses and examine the subject(s) for injury, and ensure that the subject(s) receives, or has received, needed medical attention. No member shall delay rendering medical attention, requesting EMS or the conveyance of any subject to a medical treatment facility, pending the arrival of a supervisor;
5. In the event an injured person has been conveyed for medical treatment prior to the supervisor's arrival at the scene, the supervisor shall interview the subject at the medical facility provided the interview will not interfere with the subject's medical treatment;
6. The supervisor responding to the scene shall make executive notifications of all serious uses of force, uses of force that result in a visible injury, uses of force that a reasonable officer should have known were likely to result in injury, and uses of force where there is evidence of possible criminal misconduct by an officer; and
8. The IOS Inspector shall respond to the scene and investigate all incidents where there is evidence of possible criminal misconduct by an officer; where a prisoner dies, suffers serious bodily injury, or requires hospital admission, or where there is a serious use of force. The IOS Inspector may delegate all other use of force or prisoner injury investigations to the responding supervisor for a command investigation, if deemed appropriate by him/her.

304.2 - 7.2 Use of Force Reporting

In all instances when officers use force, as defined in Section 3.8 of this Directive, each officer who has employed such force shall complete:

1. Any reports made necessary by the nature of the underlying incident;
2. Each individual officer who uses force in an incident shall submit a separate PCR documenting any force, any allegation of use of force, any prisoner injury;
3. All PCR's submitted in such cases shall specify the actions of the subject that necessitated the use of force, the reasons why the officer used force, any subject complaints of injury, medical treatment received, or refusal of medical treatment;
4. The PCR shall be submitted as soon as possible following the incident but prior to the end of the member's tour of duty.

304.2 - 7.3 Supervisors Investigation and Report

In all instances when officers use force, and a prisoner is injured, or complains of injury requiring medical attention, the supervisor shall complete a Supervisors Investigation and Report on the incident.
