Respectfully presenting petition for action of court and for cause as follows:


On June 14, 2017, the defendant was transported by way of emergency personnel to the hospital under suspicion of a drug overdose after being found by family unresponsive in the residence. At this time, the defendant remains hospitalized and is being treated for a drug overdose of an unknown origin. The defendant was scheduled to surrender to the Bureau of Prisons on June 15, 2017, for commencement of a ten year sentence. Pretrial Services views the defendant as a danger to himself and opposes an extension to his pretrial release.

In view of the aforementioned, and in consideration of defendant's safety, it is respectfully recommended that the defendant's bond be canceled, and a warrant be issued for his arrest.
