I, the undersigned complainant, being duly sworn, state the following is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief. Beginning on an unknown date, but from at least as early as in or about November 2008, and continuing through on or about August 6, 2010, in Pasco County, in the Middle District of Florida, the defendant did,

knowingly possess a firearm and/or ammunition in or affecting interstate or foreign commerce after having been convicted in a court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term in excess of one year, that is, a felony offense,

in violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section(s) 922(g)(1). I further state that I am a(n) Special Agent with the FBI, and that this Complaint is based on the following facts:

AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF COMPLAINT

Your Affiant, James Bucenell, Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Tampa, Florida, having been duly sworn, states as follows:

1. I am a Special Agent with the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI), Tampa Division, and have been so employed since December 2001. Before my employment with the FBI, I was a law enforcement officer for eight years, the last four years as a Detective in the Major Crimes Unit with the Pasco County Sheriff's Office, New Port Richey, Florida. I am currently assigned to the Pasco-Hernando Resident Agency and tasked with investigating violations of federal laws as they occur within the Middle District of Florida.

2. I am an investigative or law enforcement officer of the United States within the meaning of Title 18, United States Code (USC), Section 2510 (7), and am empowered by law to conduct investigations and to make arrests for violations of federal statutes, including cases involving violations of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

3. I am familiar with the facts and circumstances of this investigation, either as a result of my personal involvement or from other information made available to me by other law enforcement personnel, through official state records, or through information provided by various confidential sources (CS). Therefore, the information provided herein is based upon this combined knowledge and my experience and background unless otherwise specifically attributed.

4. Since this affidavit is being submitted for the limited purpose of securing a Complaint and Arrest Warrant, I have not included each and every fact known to me concerning this investigation. I have set forth only the facts believed to be necessary to establish probable cause to charge Josiah Fornof with a violation of Title 18, United States Code, Section 922 (g)(1). Further, the consensually monitored conversations referred to herein set forth only relevant summaries and do not relate the entire conversation that may have occurred.

5. 18 U.S.C. Section 922(g)(1) deems it unlawful for any person who has been convicted in any court of a crime punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year, to ship or transport in interstate or foreign commerce, or possess in or affecting commerce, any firearm or ammunition; or to receive any firearm or ammunition which has been shipped or transported in interstate or foreign commerce.

BACKGROUND FACTS OF THE INVESTIGATION

6. On June 28, 2009, the Pasco County Sheriff's Office (PCSO) received a complaint from a Source of Information (hereafter referred to as SOI #1) regarding a residence located at 18060 Owen Drive, Hudson, Florida (hereafter referred to as subject residence or subject property), that had a homemade firing range on the property. According to SOI #1, the residents were firing weapons on the weekends and were not using the proper safety precautions to protect nearby residents/residences. On at least one occasion, SOI

#1 had rounds (fired ammunition) travel across his/her property. SOI #1 believed the resident at the subject residence who was doing most of the shooting was Josiah Fornof, whom SOI #1 also believed was a convicted felon. Through investigation, PCSO discovered the identity of SOI #1, and formally interviewed him/her on July 6, 2009, as noted below.

7. During an interview on July 6, 2009, SOI #1 said he/she could not observe the firing range from his/her residence because the subject residence is between the location of the firing range and his/her residence. However, SOI #1 has heard several gunshots, believed to be from different types of guns, coming from the location of the subject residence. SOI #1 also advised that the subject property contained multiple tree stands and an observation tower which is manned at all hours by a lookout. Although SOI #1's information regarding a firing range and weapons being present at the subject residence was corroborated, the investigation did not reveal a manned observation tower on the subject property and only one tree that appears to be used as a vantage point to observe individuals approaching the subject property. For information purposes, it should also be noted that SOI #1 was arrested for a controlled substances offense within a year of providing the aforementioned information.

8. On July 6, 2009, an anonymous tip (later determined to have originated from SOI #1) was sent to the PCSO regarding a subject, Wyatt Eugene Blevins, with an active warrant possibly residing at the subject residence. Two PCSO deputies responded to the subject residence in an attempt to locate Wyatt Eugene Blevins who did have an active warrant for his arrest. Upon arrival at the residence, the deputies checked the license tag affixed to a tan colored Mercury station wagon (Florida tag #H29-2CR) parked at the subject property, which registration showed that the vehicle belonged to Kimberly Blevins. The deputies then attempted to make contact with someone at the subject property by knocking on the front door of the residence but no one answered. Within a few moments, Josiah Fornof (Kimberly Blevins' son) came around from the rear of the residence and met the deputies. Fornof told the deputies that Wyatt Eugene Blevins did not live at the subject residence. Fornof then told the deputies that they were trespassing on his property and he wanted them to leave. Shortly thereafter, Kimberly Blevins and Nathan Fornof (Josiah Fornof's brother) exited the residence and also advised the deputies that they were trespassing on their property and wanted them to leave. During the encounter, Josiah Fornof attempted to serve one of the deputies with a packet of paperwork that supposedly contained a trespass warning and a letter addressed to the President of the United States. After a verbal altercation, the deputies proceeded to their vehicles while Josiah Fornof approached them with a video recorder talking about the paperwork and advising the deputies that they were "responsible for knowing what it says." As the deputies were leaving the property, Josiah Fornof yelled, "Sir, if you come back, we may bear arms against you" and "We are prepared to protect ourselves." As the deputies left the property, Fornof told his mother, "I'm going to suit up mom." Josiah Fornof later posted the video he made, titled "sheriff trespass", on the internet at his My Space page at Friend ID#485191644 through the use of a computer.

9. As noted above, on July 6, 2009, Josiah Fornof attempted to serve paperwork to the two PCSO deputies. Included in the paperwork was a letter addressed to the President of the United States dated January 7, 2009. Within the text of the letter, Fornof indicated, in part, "I have the right to bear arms against such unlawful entities, up to and including the President of the United States, that are coming against me unlawfully, lethally, and genocidally." At the bottom of the letter is a copy of Fornof's Florida identification card which reflects an address of 10635 Patrick Avenue, Hudson, Florida. However, "Josiah Robert Fornof, 18060 Owen Drive, Hudson, Florida, 34667-6659" is typewritten at the top of the letter. The letter, the entirety of which is set forth in Exhibit A, was posted to Kimberly Blevins internet website (www.breachofwaters.blogspot.com) via a computer.

10. On July 6, 2009, Kimberly Blevins posted a self-authored letter onto her internet website (www.breachofwters.blogspot.com), and titled her daily blog entry, "IT IS ON". The letter was addressed to PCSO Sheriff Bob White, and forwarded to Sheriff White via electronic mail on July 6, 2009, at 7:03 PM. The letter was also sent to Pinellas-Pasco State Attorney Bernie McCabe, Pasco County Administrator John Gallagher, Florida Governor Charlie Crist, and president@whitehouse.gov. The body of the letter indicates, in part, that "we--I and mine--have the right to defend ourselves, including to bear arms against you or any of yours" and had "the right to shoot and kill" the deputies who were at their property that day. The letter, the entirety of which is set forth in Exhibit B, was posted to Blevins' internet website via a computer, along with the aforementioned video titled "sheriff trespass".

11. During her daily blog entry on July 15, 2009, Blevins posted a letter she authored and electronically mailed to Special Agent in Charge Steven Ibison of the Tampa Office of the FBI. Within the text of the letter, Blevins indicated, in part, "Do not under any circumstances send any governmental representative out here to my home or property. Be advised that my property extends to the middle of Owen Drive: the right of way I grant is for the conduct of lawful business only. Any and all trespassers are subject to being dealt with immediately and without hesitation by me and mine to the fullest extent the law allows, including that the law allows me and mine to bear arms against such." The letter, the entirety of which is set forth in Exhibit C, was posted to Blevins internet website via a computer.

12. On May 27, 2010, your Affiant conducted a criminal records inquiry for Josiah Robert Fornof. Your Affiant learned Josiah Robert Fornof has been convicted of the following felony crimes: On December 11, 2000, a Pasco County jury found Fornof guilty of two (2) counts of Aggravated Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer (case #99-01478CFAWS), one (1) count of Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer (case #99-01481CFAWS), and one (1) count of Escape (case #99-01481CFAWS). According to Florida State Statutes, Aggravated Assault on a Law Enforcement Officer is a Second Degree Felony; Battery on a Law Enforcement Officer is a Third Degree Felony; and Escape is a Second Degree Felony, all of which are crimes punishable by imprisonment for a term exceeding one year. The aforementioned convictions relate to an incident which occurred on April 24, 1999, which involved Fornof's use and possession of a Haskel .45

caliber semi-automatic handgun during a confrontation with law enforcement officers. That firearm was recovered by the PCSO. According to the court records, Fornof was sentenced to 33.1 months in prison.

13. On June 1, 2010, the Office of Executive Clemency, Tallahassee, Florida, conducted a thorough search of clemency records and certified there "is no record of restoration of civil rights, nor a specific authority to own, possess, use or receive firearms of any kind, nor a pardon of any kind, having been granted by the Governor and Cabinet of the State of Florida to Josiah Robert Fornof, DOB 7/17/1980, in connection with any conviction in the State of Florida."

14. On September 24, 2009, Matthea Stout (sister of Josiah Fornof, hereafter referred to as Matthea) contacted the PCSO in regards to a criminal matter unrelated to this investigation. During the investigation, Matthea mentioned to a PCSO deputy that Josiah and her family have "a lot of guns" at the subject residence. That case was referred to PCSO Detective Brad Seltman.

15. On October 13, 2009, in light of an Officer Safety bulletin issued to all PCSO personnel regarding Josiah Fornof, PCSO Detective Seltman conducted a controlled (recorded) telephone call to Josiah Fornof in an effort to interview him about the criminal matter referred by Matthea. During the call, Detective Seltman explained to Fornof that he (Seltman) "could have just come out there with two or three (squad) cars" and Fornof replied, in part, "And I could have beared arms against you."

16. On November 24, 2009, Matthea was telephonically interviewed by FBI agents regarding her knowledge of Josiah Fornof. Matthea expressed concern over Fornof's mental stability and said that she was afraid that Fornof may harm himself or a member of law enforcement should law enforcement attempt to contact him. Further, Matthea confirmed that there were firearms inside the subject residence and that, to her knowledge, the firearms belonged to Fornof. She also admitted her lack of knowledge regarding guns but recalled that one of the firearms was a 9mm (millimeter) pistol.

17. On December 2, 2009, John Stout (ex-husband of Matthea Stout, hereafter referred to as Stout) was interviewed by FBI agents regarding his knowledge of Josiah Fornof. Stout advised he has been in the subject residence but has never observed any firearms.

18. On January 21, 2010, a Source of Information (hereafter referred to as SOI #2) was interviewed by FBI agents regarding his/her knowledge of Josiah Fornof. SOI #2 has lived in the neighborhood since May 2009. SOI #2 is an avid firearm shooter and shoots on his/her property occasionally. Shortly before Thanksgiving 2009, SOI #2 was working in his/her yard when he/she heard gunshots coming from the direction of the subject residence. SOI #2 described hearing several shots being fired towards his residence and recalled hearing a "whizzing" noise (consistent with the sound of a bullet) subsequent to hearing the shots. On November 29, 2009, SOI #2 was getting his/her mail and noticed a white male subject standing at the end of the driveway to the subject residence. The

male subject, who was then unknown to SOI #2, told SOI #2, "When I shoot, I shoot at the ground."

19. On January 25, 2010, SOI #1 was again interviewed by FBI agents regarding his/her knowledge of Josiah Fornof. SOI #1 has lived in the neighborhood since April 2009. SOI #1 said that he/she initially got along with Fornof but the relationship deteriorated and led to several incidents where Fornof and SOI #1 were shouting at one another upon sight. On one occasion, after a verbal altercation with Fornof, SOI #1 discovered a subject named Wyatt Blevins on the PCSO website who had a warrant for his arrest. SOI #1 knew Fornof's mother's last name was Blevins and sent an anonymous tip to the PCSO indicating that Wyatt Blevins could possibly be located at the subject residence. In the anonymous tip, SOI #1 indicated the subject residence had a homemade firing range on the property. Although SOI #1 could not observe the firing range due to the obstructed view caused by the residence, SOI #1 heard shots that sounded like they were coming from the subject residence. According to SOI #1, the firing range was primarily used every Sunday for approximately one month between May 2009 and June 2009. During that time, SOI #1 heard a large amount of shooting taking place on the subject property mostly during the afternoon and evening hours, and occasionally late at night. SOI #1 had not heard any gunfire coming from the subject residence since the incident with the PCSO deputies in July 2009.

20. On February 2, 2010, a Source of Information (hereafter referred to as SOI #3) was interviewed by FBI agents regarding his/her knowledge of Josiah Fornof. SOI #3 has lived in the neighborhood since June 2009. SOI #3 has heard frequent gunfire coming from the subject residence, but SOI #3 has never observed any person(s) shooting guns on the property. On January 30, 2010, SOI #3 heard multiple gunshots come from the subject residence between approximately 3:00 PM until approximately 5:30 PM, and SOI #3 believed some of the shots sounded as if they came from a rifle.

21. On February 6, 2010, during a physical surveillance conducted by law enforcement, at least two gunshots were heard coming from the direction of the subject residence.

22. On February 16, 2010, a Source of Information (hereafter referred to as SOI #4) was interviewed by FBI agents regarding his/her knowledge of Josiah Fornof. As a result of his relationship with the family, SOI #4 had been inside the subject residence. SOI #4 advised that in November 2008, SOI #4 noticed a rifle propped up against the window sill in a room inside the subject residence where Josiah Fornof slept. SOI #4 expressed his concern to Josiah Fornof regarding the firearm's easy accessibility to children in the residence. According to SOI #4, Fornof said the rifle was a 9mm caliber rifle that was fed by a "clip" and Fornof eventually removed the rifle to another unknown room within the residence. SOI #4 did not observe any other firearms in the residence and has never observed Fornof in possession of any other firearms.

23. On March 1, 2010, a Confidential Source (hereafter referred to as CS #1) was passing out flyers seeking possible employment as a handyman in the area of the subject residence and made contact with Kimberly Blevins.

24. On April 13, 2010, SOI #2 was interviewed by FBI Agents regarding his/her knowledge of Josiah Fornof. According to SOI #2, in late February 2010, SOI #2 spoke to Josiah Fornof near his mailbox. SOI #2 observed a handgun (possibly manufactured by Glock) within a holster on Fornof's right hip. Further, SOI #2 indicated in mid March 2010, SOI #2 heard a gunshot that came from the front yard of the subject residence and when SOI #2 looked across the street the only person he/she observed was Josiah Fornof.

25. On May 7, 2010, CS #1 traveled to the subject residence for the purpose of providing assistance with the construction of a shed. CS #1 made contact with a white male later identified as Josiah Fornof. While Josiah Fornof was bending over getting some wood from under a tarp, CS #1 observed a handgun on Josiah Fornof's right hip, partially concealed by a shirt. At one point during the day, Fornof went inside the residence and when he came back outside, CS #1 noticed that Fornof no longer had the handgun.

26. During their contact on May 7, 2010, Fornof and CS #1 discussed the conflict with the PCSO which occurred on July 6, 2009. Afterwards, Fornof showed CS #1 a tree located on the property that had several pieces of wood nailed to it, which appeared to CS #1 as a makeshift ladder. Fornof climbed up the steps, laid across the branches of the tree, and made a motion as if he were aiming a rifle towards the metal entrance gate in the driveway. Fornof advised he had a good view of the gate and said "they would never know where it was coming from". CS #1 interpreted Fornof's comments to mean that he would shoot at law enforcement should they return to the property.

27. During an unrecorded conversation prior May 7, 2010, CS #1 told Kimberly Blevins that he is a certified concealed weapons instructor and Blevins expressed an interest in obtaining a concealed weapons permit. During the visit to the subject residence on May 7, 2010, CS #1 asked Kimberly Blevins if she was still interested in obtaining a concealed weapons permit. CS #1 explained to Blevins that in order to complete the process an instructor had to observe each applicant shoot a firearm, and prior to receiving a permit, the applicants had to answer questions on documents provided by the State of Florida. CS #1 told Blevins and Fornof that he did not have the paperwork with him and would have to return with it another day. However, Blevins said she wanted to shoot a gun and so CS #1 retrieved his handgun from his vehicle. Fornof then entered the subject residence and emerged with a handgun tucked into the waistband of his pants near the small of his back. Fornof asked CS #1 if he could shoot his personal firearm and CS #1 responded that he could. CS #1 then watched as Fornof fired his handgun. Fornof told CS #1 the handgun was a 9mm and that he also had two shotguns, however, CS #1 did not observe Fornof with the shotguns.

28. On May 15, 2010, CS #1 made contact with Josiah Fornof at the subject residence. During a recorded conversation, Fornof and CS #1 spoke about the legalities of shooting

firearms on personal property. During the conversation, Fornof said, "Well I'll tell you what, if I have to shoot somebody with a badge because they're doing something stupid like trying to be an asshole...and thinking they could do it, I'm just going to have to keep shooting them, 'cause they ain't going to stop you know?" Attached hereto as Exhibit D is an excerpt of the transcript relative to this comment.

29. On May 23, 2010, CS #1 traveled to the subject residence for the purpose of conducting the concealed weapons permit class. CS #1 brought several firearms to the subject residence for instruction purposes but did not bring any ammunition for any of the those firearms. Prior to the verbal instruction, Josiah Fornof exited the residence with three firearms: a shotgun, a rifle, and a handgun, along with a bag of ammunition. CS #1 told Fornof to take the firearms back into the subject residence because CS #1 did not want anybody handling any firearms during the verbal instruction. After the verbal instruction, Fornof went inside the residence and again later appeared on the west side of the subject residence carrying long guns (shotgun and rifle). He also had a handgun tucked into the waistband of his pants near the center of his back. CS #1 observed Fornof fire each of the aforementioned weapons and video footage of Fornof in possession of the weapons was captured by law enforcement. For the limited scope of this affidavit, your Affiant has attached hereto as Exhibit E four still photographs taken from video footage that shows Fornof in possession of those firearms.

30. On May 23, 2010, CS #1 observed Josiah Fornof with a handgun. During a recorded conversation, Fornof identified the handgun as a "...Browning...(or) a Herstal...built in Belgium..." Attached hereto as Exhibit F is an excerpt from the recorded conversation which is relative to Fornof's comment.

31. On May 23, 2010, CS #1 observed Josiah Fornof with a shotgun. During a recorded conversation, Fornof told CS #1 the shotgun was a "Mossberg" shotgun. Attached hereto as Exhibit G is an excerpt from the recorded conversation which is relative to Fornof's comment.

32. On May 27, 2010, a Source of Information (hereafter referred to as SOI #5) was interviewed by FBI agents regarding his/her knowledge of Josiah Fornof. SOI #5, who lives near the subject residence, came in contact with Fornof on May 23, 2010. According to SOI #5, at some point during the afternoon, Fornof told SOI #5 that his family was going to be taking a class on home protection and they would be shooting guns on the subject property. SOI #5 did not observe any firearms in Fornof's possession at that time. Later, while working in his/her yard, SOI #5 heard gunshots coming from the subject property. SOI #5 then observed Fornof shoot a long gun once and observed Fornof with a handgun tucked in the waistband of his pants near the center of his back.

33. On August 6, 2010, CS#1 make contact with Josiah Fornof. During a recorded conversation, CS #1 inquired whether Fornof and his family sent in the concealed weapons paperwork. Fornof told CS #1 the family had not sent the paperwork in, but felt he didn't need to send in the paperwork to enjoy the privileges of carrying a firearm. Fornof told CS

#1, "I know, I know, it'll allow, open a door for them to screw with me, but why don't I just shoot them...'cause I'm gonna' have to keep shooting until they finally kill me." Later, during a recorded conversation, CS #1 asked Fornof about a .22 caliber rifle which was previously possessed by Robert Fornof, Fornof's grandfather, who currently lives at the subject residence. Fornof told CS #1 Robert Fornof gave the rifle to Kimberly Blevins, who resides at the subject residence. Fornof told CS #1, "so at least, right now, she's got a, (unintelligible sound), a long rifle."

34. Since March 13, 2010, law enforcement surveillance has established that Josiah Fornof is residing at the subject residence located at 18060 Owen Drive, Hudson, Florida. The aforementioned observations by CS#1 of Josiah Fornof in possession of firearms and the recorded meetings between CS #1 and Fornof have occurred at the subject property. Fornof has been observed by law enforcement taking personal items from the subject residence and also placing personal items into the subject residence.

35. On May 23, 2010, Josiah Fornof was in possession of a 9mm handgun believed to be manufactured by Herstal or Browning, and a shotgun believed to be manufactured by Mossberg. Further, on August 6, 2010, Josiah Fornof confirmed that he was still in possession of firearms. Your affiant has learned through the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, and Firearms that neither the 9mm nor the shotgun, or the ammunition for same, is manufactured in the State of Florida. The Mossberg firearm would likely have been manufactured in the state of Connecticut and the Herstal/Browning would likely have been manufactured in the country of Belgium. Also, neither 9mm nor shotgun ammunition is completely manufactured in the State of Florida although some component parts (e.g. primers or shell casings) may be. Consequently, the firearms and ammunition would have likely traveled in and affected interstate or foreign commerce in order to be found in the state of Florida.

36. Based on the aforementioned factual information, your Affiant respectfully submits that there is probable cause to believe that beginning on an unknown date, but from at least as early as in or about November 2008, and continuing through on or about August 6, 2010, Josiah Robert Fornof, a convicted felon, is in possession of firearms and has violated and is continuing to violate, Title 18, United States Code, Section 922(g)(1).

Further Affiant sayeth naught.

Dear Sheriff White:

At or about 4:09 PM today, July 6, 2009, you via your agents of terror -- two flak-jacketed, armed, hatless, but otherwise uniformed Caucasians in unmarked cars -- came on the unlawful, lethal, genocidal attack against me and mine at our home here at 18060 Owen Drive, Hudson, Florida 34667-6659, and you did so by stealth, with lethal force, under cover, while I was working, no less!

Be advised that as *Americans* we -- I and mine -- have the right to defend ourselves, including to bear arms against you or any of yours, not just on this, my property, but anytime, anyplace that you, via them, attempt to further terrorize us, and we will not hesitate to do so. We are on our guard and will remain so until we see clear and convincing evidence that you have become lawful and will remain lawful.

We do not want to have to defend ourselves with arms: we want what we have always wanted, lawfulness, including of course lawful process. Did these two men, representing you, know that we had, and have, the right to shoot and kill them on sight? Did you send them up here to sacrifice them, hoping that we would do just that, so you could then swarm in with your unlawful lethal force and claim whatever? Do these men realize that you self-evidently consider them expendable? Do their families and friends realize that?

How dare you come against the people, against Americans, against America, as you are doing? The position you occupy will not forever provide you refuge from accountability for your own actions, and the actions of your reciprocal benefactors, including but in no manner limited to State Attorney Bernie McCabe and County Administrator



John J. Gallagher and theirs.

You have made it so that we -- I and mine -- are answerable to no authority but to the Lord God Almighty, and He is most definitely with me and mine.

As for me and mine, our properties and persons are absolutely off limits to you and to yours: you and yours means the inescapably in-breach-of-contract governing powers of these United States of America, across the board, federal, state, local. This is serious. You, via your agents, have been served, and noticed. Govern yourself/yourselves accordingly.

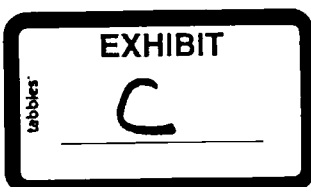
Dear Special Agent Ibison:

Matthew B. Ratner, of the Office of the AAG, National Security Division, U.S. Department of Justice, has referred me to you regarding matters of national security that I have to address *posthaste* with the United States governing bodies, including of course with you.

My parents Ruth Elvada Denniston Blevins (1923-1997) and Robert Frank Blevins (1925-) and theirs -- We the People -- are endowed *by our Creator* with certain unalienable rights. There is only one God: *Echad Adonai*. Blessed be the name of the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

Be advised that the United States governing bodies, top to bottom, across the board, federal, state, local, are inescapably in breach of contract against my parents and theirs, which includes of course, against me and mine, against We the People, against any and all lawful entities. The aforesaid governing bodies have rendered the contract voidable, void as to itself/themselves, the wrongdoers, but not void as to me, the wronged party, unless I elect to so treat it. Void contract is one which *never had any legal existence or effect, and cannot in any manner have life breathed into it!*

From at least as far back as September 11, 1986, contiguously, we have suffered a "long train of abuses" and escalating unlawful aggression by the aforesaid governing bodies against my parents and theirs. Such long train of abuses triggers certain set and well delineated lawful responses from American citizens, demands such, in fact.



In addition to the aforesaid, from November 12, 1985, I have been and remain an oath-bound, absolutely hands-clean public servant, which gives me lawful excuse and legal leverage that is not to be underestimated.

Do not under any circumstances send any governmental representative out here to my home or property. Be advised that my property extends to the middle of Owen Drive: the right of way I grant is for the conduct of lawful business only. Any and all trespassers are subject to being dealt with immediately and without hesitation by me and mine to the fullest extent the law allows, including that the law allows me and mine to bear arms against such. Keep your communication with me lawful, peaceful, and keep it in writing. You may start by responding to the charge I put upon the two agents the Tampa FBI unlawfully sent against me previously (about four and a half years ago); namely, to read and respond lawfully to:

Blevins, R.F. (1997, Dec. 7). Letter to the United States Department of Justice.

Blevins, K.A. (2005, Feb. 10). Terrorist Event Theory (Formerly: Surrogate Victim Theory). Prepared for President George W. Bush.

I am still waiting for your, the Tampa FBI's lawful response to the aforesaid.

Had the governing bodies responded lawfully years and years ago when we turned to them for help (see p. 35 of my father's December 7, 1997 letter to the USDJ), had they provided the help and protection to us that they are lawfully obligated to provide, we would not be facing this matter of the aforesaid governing bodies' escalating unlawful aggression against us. Except by the grace of Almighty God - YHWH, the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob -- we are not secure in our homes, neither are we secure in our persons. We do, however, live under the grace and protection of Almighty God, who is not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance (John 3:16, 2 Peter 3:9). All these years our demand to the wrongdoers has been simple: become lawful, remain lawful. In other words: *repent*.

You are to become lawful and remain lawful: go back to September 11, 1986, and come forward, dealing lawfully all along the way. Arrest Pasco County Sheriff Bob White, including for his unlawful, terrorist trespass raid against me and mine on Monday, July 6, 2009, but in no manner thus limited. (See: sheriff trespass). Pull William R. Webb, an attorney falsely posturing as a judge, off the judicial bench,

and throw him in jail for the murder of my mother Ruth Elvada Denniston Blevins. Arrest State Attorney Bernie McCabe, including for misprision of felony, misprision of treason, and the murder of my mother Ruth Elvada Denniston Blevins, but in no manner thus limited.

Again, I stress to you most strongly: do not send anyone out here to my home or property. Do not have any governmental representative approach me when I am in public. You may help, but you may not further harm my father and his. Keep your communication in writing. Any and all correspondence is subject to being posted on the World Wide Web, accessible by the public, including of course, by We the People.
