**Probable Cause Affidavit**

Before me this date personally appeared Detective J. Kogan (BSO), Detective J. Jagers (FLPD), Detective J. Stokes (DPD), and Detective T. Ray (MDPD) who being first duly sworn deposes

and says that on 2-5 Day of NOV, (year) 2010 at BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause to believe the same are as follows:

*On November 6, 2010, officers from the Fort Lauderdale Police Department received a telephone call from John Wick who resides at 2006 Coral Shores Drive, Fort Lauderdale, Broward County, in reference to a suspicious container. Officers arrived on scene and discovered a container that held severed human legs and arms covered in concrete. Subsequently, on November 14, 2010, the Broward Sheriffs Office recovered a severed human head and hand, also covered in concrete, in a bucket located at 1200 Old Griffin Road, Broward County, Fl. DNA testing conclusively determined the arms, legs, and head, were from the same individual. On November 26, 2010, Miami-Dade detectives recovered a male torso in a container in Miami which was also later conclusively linked to the other body parts through a DNA match.*

*On December 6, 2010, a finger print recovered from the hand positively identified the decedent as [REDACTED], a white male, DOB [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] holds a local address of [REDACTED] as listed on his Florida Driver's License. Further I swear the above statement is correct and true to the best of my knowledge and belief.*

**Probable Cause Affidavit**

Before me this date personally appeared SAME DETECTIVES who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on 12/25 Day of: NOV, (year) 10 at BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause t believe the same are as follows:

investigation revealed that [REDACTED] entered the United States from the Dominican Republic via the Miami International Airport on November 2, 2010. An airline document recovered from the torso discovered in Miami-Dade County was later identified as a travel related document issued by American Airlines to [REDACTED]

Detective Anthony Ray of the Miami Dade Police Department and Detective John Stokes of the Davie Police Department responded to [REDACTED] address, [REDACTED] in [REDACTED] on December 4, 2010. The detectives were met at the front door of the residence by Jamie Marlon Saffran, a white male, DOB 04/08/1959, and were invited into the home. Broward County property records listed the owners of the residence as Jamie Saffran and Fatima Saffran, his wife. Jamie Saffran identified [REDACTED] as a friend of many years and advised the detectives that [REDACTED] now resides in the Dominican Republic but uses Saffran's address as his mailing address in the U.S. Saffran claimed to have had contact with [REDACTED] around October 31, 2010, while [REDACTED] was staying in Hollywood. Saffran also claimed that [REDACTED] is currently in Columbia and that he had received e-mail correspondence from [REDACTED] recently. Saffran's stated time frame for having received an e-mail was more than two weeks following [REDACTED] extremities having already been recovered in Fort Lauderdale.

The investigation establishes that the victim was murdered between November 2, 2010, when he returned to this country through MIA and noon on November 5, 2010 when the first of his remains were found. It has been established that the victim had a Chase MasterCard credit card. That card was utilized a number of times after the victim is known to be dead. On November 8th, 2010 this card was used to purchase tires from Fuzzy's Tire at 800 North State Road 7, Plantation Fl. Those tires were installed on a red jeep at a cost of \$379.21. A 2002 red Jeep with Florida tag M894SN is currently registered to Jamie Saffran. A photographic line-up containing a photograph of Saffran and five people similar in appearance was shown to Pablo Fernando Abad of Fuzzy's Tire on December 7, 2010 by Detective Stokes. Mr. Abad positively identified Jamie Saffran as the person who both identified himself as [REDACTED] and charged the Chase MasterCard purchase of the tires on the sale date.

On November 15, 2010 the victim's Chase MasterCard account was used to make a payment in the amount of \$719.62 to Florida Atlantic University. The payment was made towards the account of Jamie Carolina Saffran. Jamie Carolina Saffran is the daughter of Jamie Marlon Saffran according to the Office of Vital Statistics Certification of Birth

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**Probable Cause Affidavit**

Before me this date personally appeared SAME DETECTIVES who being first duly sworn deposes and says that on 12-5 Day of: NOV, (year) 10 at BROWARD COUNTY, FLORIDA (crime location) the above named defendant committed the above offenses charged and the facts showing probable cause I believe the same are as follows:

In the container recovered in Fort Lauderdale on November 6, 2010 and in the container recovered in Dania Beach on November 14, 2010 were leaves later identified as leaves from the Schefflera Sctinophylla, and Schillings Icex trees. The leaves were identified by John J. Pipoly Ph.D., FLS Urban Horticulture Agent for Broward County Florida. While conducting the interview of Mr. Saffran on December 4, 2010, Detective Ray and Detective Stokes observed the Schefflera Sctinophylla and Schillings Icex trees in Mr. Saffran's yard. They also observed in the yard a blue rope similar in size, appearance and construction as the rope that was recovered with the head and hand on November 14, 2010 in Dania.

Finally, [redacted] had a return flight to the Dominican Republic scheduled for November 10, 2010 on American Airlines. On November 8, 2010 a male who identified himself as [redacted] used Saffran's cell phone (954 993-2614) to call American Airlines and cancel [redacted] return flight. [redacted] was known to be dead at this time as some of his remains had been recovered three days earlier.


On December 10, 2010 Dr. R. MacDougall of the Broward County Medical Examiners Office determined [redacted] manner of death to be Homicide with the cause listed as blunt force trauma. The time of death was determined to have been between November 02, 2010 and November 05, 2010.

On December 10, 2010 Judge Imperato reviewed and signed an application for a search warrant of Mr. Saffran's residence, 6410 SW 57 St. Davie Fl. After completion of her review, Judge Imperato approved and signed the warrant.

On December 14, 2010 the search warrant was served at the residence. Cadaver dogs were utilized during the search. The dogs alerted, indicating the odor of human remains. The dogs specifically alerted in the garage, and an outdoor shed located in the fenced yard on the East side of the residence. The shed is covered by a Schefflera tree similar to the tree leaves found with the body parts. Inside the shed was a shovel covered with concrete and a sledge hammer that presumptively tested positive for human blood. Several cutting tools and two bags of cement consistent with the cement that was packed with the body parts were also in the shed.

Saffran was taken into custody as the search warrant was being executed. In Saffran's possession at the time was the cell phone (954 993-2614) used to cancel [redacted] American Airline flight. This cellular phone lists Jamie M. Saffran as the subscriber. Saffran was transported to Davie Police Department where after receiving his Miranda rights he invoked his right to remain silent and gave no statement
