
July 16, 2011 Tyler Joseph Hadley did unlawfully, by an act imminently dangerous to another and evincing a depraved mind regardless of human life, although without any premeditated design to effect the death of any particular individual, kill and murder Blake Hadley a human being, and during the commission of said offense the defendant carried, displayed, used, threatened to use, or attempted to use any weapon, to wit: a hammer, in violation of Florida Statutes 775.087(1)(a) and 782.04(2);

A. Ct. 2 SECOND DEGREE MURDER WITH A WEAPON (F-1)

July 16, 2011 Tyler Joseph Hadley did unlawfully, by an act imminently dangerous to another and evincing a depraved mind regardless of human life, although without any premeditated design to effect the death of any particular individual, kill and murder Mary Jo Hadley, a human being, and during the commission of said offense the defendant carried, displayed, used, threatened to use, or attempted to use any weapon, to wit: a hammer, in violation of Florida Statutes 775.087(1)(a) and 782.04(2);

I do hereby state that I am instituting this prosecution in good faith.


