ORIGINAL NARRATIVE

On July 17, 2011 at 0424 hrs Officer Greene (#617) and myself were dispatched to [REDACTED] NE Granduer Ave, in the city of Port St Lucie, St Lucie County, Florida in reference to an Anonymous call. [REDACTED] The anonymous caller stated they had information stating a seventeen year-old male named [REDACTED] killed his parents [REDACTED] on July 16, 2011, using [REDACTED] placed them in their bedroom.

Once we arrived, we parked our patrol vehicles on the south end of NE Granduer Ave, and walked towards the house. The house had [REDACTED] vehicles parked next to it. A [REDACTED] in the swale, a [REDACTED] and a [REDACTED] in the driveway. The [REDACTED] was registered to [REDACTED] and a [REDACTED], while the other two vehicles were registered to a [REDACTED]. As we were walking up the driveway there was a light on inside the residence. There was a large front bay window and we could see a shadow of a person walking back and forth. Officer Greene was able to peer through an opening in the blinds. He noticed a white male later identified as [REDACTED]. Then he noticed [REDACTED] grabbed [REDACTED] back bedroom, entered [REDACTED] window believing [REDACTED] as approaching the front door, however he did not. We knocked on the door, however no one answered or responded. After approximately five minutes the lights inside the house went off. Ofc. Greene knocked a second time with no answer. We asked for additional units to assist in maintaining a perimeter as we did not know where [REDACTED] could be inside the house. Prior to other units arriving, [REDACTED] answered the door. [REDACTED] was [REDACTED]. When [REDACTED] answered the door, [REDACTED] At the time I did not know if he was concealing a weapon, at which point I ordered [REDACTED] to show up his hands. [REDACTED] exited the house, checked for weapons and placed into handcuffed for our safety as we continued with our welfare check.

I asked [REDACTED] if any adults were at the residence, which he answered [REDACTED]. While speaking to [REDACTED] he appeared [REDACTED] appeared to have a [REDACTED] with his [REDACTED] very large. I then asked if anybody was inside the residence, he stated [REDACTED]. I asked if his parents were home he stated [REDACTED]. I asked him how could he contact them, he stated [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] then stated we (Police) could not enter into the house.

Based on the detailed information regarding the call [REDACTED] the unusual behavior displaced by [REDACTED] myself and Officer Swanchak made entry into the house to conduct a welfare check. We announced our presence and entered. The interior of the house was in [REDACTED] there were several [REDACTED] throughout the house, along with [REDACTED]. It appeared a house party was conducted at the house. The kitchen had several [REDACTED], along with more [REDACTED]. We entered into the bedroom on the west side of the house. The room [REDACTED] there was the [REDACTED] on the floor, along with approximately [REDACTED] on the bed. A second bedroom was on the opposite side of the hallway. This room was in complete disarray the [REDACTED] was turned over, [REDACTED] and miscellaneous [REDACTED] were throughout the room. We then walked past the kitchen, towards a third bedroom on the east side of the house. Ofc. Swanchak attempted to open the door, however it was locked from the inside. Ofc. Swanchak then asked [REDACTED] if he had a key to the room, and who's room was it. [REDACTED] stated no to the keys and it was his parent's room. While I was standing next to the door, I noticed what appeared to [REDACTED] a wood colored hutch, and the base boards. After seeing the [REDACTED] Sgt R. Vega (#313) was contacted and responded. Ofc. Swanchak was able to turn the knob hard enough to where the door opened. As the door opened, there was large amounts of [REDACTED]. The room had what appeared

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to be every piece of [REDACTED] from the interior of the house in the room. There were [REDACTED] a [REDACTED] In the doorway, just inside the barrier [REDACTED] covered by some of the furniture. I removed two [REDACTED] in order to enter the room and placed them on-top of the bed. As I removed the [REDACTED] I noticed the leg of a male covered in [REDACTED] and cold to the touch. At this point I got on-top of the bed to check the closet and bathroom; I checked the rooms, and only [REDACTED] [REDACTED] I then walked back towards the doorway. While at the door I removed a [REDACTED] uncovering an arm to second person. After discovering this we exited the residence and secured the house. Ofc. Goodwin (#436) established a crime log and Cordoned off the area. Rescue #3 was dispatched and arrived.

Sgt. Vega contacted Lt. Dimeo and advised him of the situation. The Detective Supervisor was contacted, and Detective Kristen Meyer (#451) arrived on scene and assumed control of the incident.
