



SUBJECT: Appointment - Acting Police
Chief



Effective today, September 6, 2011, I suspended Chief Miguel Exposito. In the interim and until such time as the City Commission has the opportunity to hear this matter pursuant to Section 26 of the City Charter, I have appointed Major Manuel Orosa as Acting Police Chief. Major Orosa is a 31 year veteran of the Miami Police Department and is the most senior member of the Police Department staff. He brings with him years of experience and knowledge including experience in Communication, Patrol (all districts), Internal Affairs, Street Narcotics, Special Events, Special Investigations, Criminal Investigation and support services.

Major Orosa is a graduate of the University of Louisville's Southern Police Institute, the Senior Management Institution for Police (SIMP) Police Executive Research Forum's – Executive Strategies Management – Boston University, Harvard University's John F. Kennedy School of Government, Florida Police Chiefs Association's "Future Chiefs" and the Drug Enforcement Administration's Drug Commanders School.

Should the City Commission uphold the action I have taken in this matter, it is my intent to initiate a national search for this position and upon conclusion, select a qualified candidate to assume this role.
