(April 28, 2016) - The building that previously occupied the site of the Fendi Chateau Residences, located at <u>9380 Collins Avenue in Surfside</u>, was not demolished by Coastal Construction. However as the general contractor for Fendi Chateau Residences, Coastal was required to sift the sand in accordance with the Department of Environmental Protection. The DEP, as customary, conducted an inspection and the removal passed inspection. It was later discovered that the sifting process did not produce the desired results. As such, the DEP issued a permit for a remediation plan to remove and resift the existing sand between 54th street and 63rd road, and that new sand be replaced as necessary. The work is expected to be completed this week for final inspection ahead of turtle season May 1st. Coastal is very proud of its commitment to the environment and its efforts to minimize environmental impact on our jobsites.
