**APPROVED**

On 02/14/18 at 1427 hours, I arrived at Marjory Stoneman Douglas HS (5901 Pine Island Rd.) in reference to an Active Shooter (AOJ).

I parked my marked unit in the south bus loop, took my rifle and began running northbound on the eastside of the school. I did not hear any gunfire and the hallways were completely clear. All of a sudden, a Douglas employee driving a golf cart came to my aid and stated "Jump in with me, I'll take you where you need to go." The employee provided me with suspect information that I immediately BOLO'd over the radio (white male, burgandy shirt (ROTC emblem), black pants, last seen around the 3 story building (1200 bldg.) or the northeast parking lot.) The employee advised he no longer wished to drive any further, due to approaching the unsecure parking lot. I exited the golf cart and ran westbound towards the 1200 bldg. while still trying to keep an eye on the northeast parking lot. I still did not hear any gunfire, and took cover behind a tree trunk and a black SUV directly in front of the 1200 building (east doors). About 40 yards to my left, I observed Dep. Peterson (Douglas SRO) seeking cover behind a concrete column. Dep. Peterson advised he hadn't heard any gunfire for a few minutes and didn't know the exact location of the shooter. Dep. Peterson advised that I needed to watch my back in case the shooter was behind me, hiding in the parking lot. Moments later, CSPD officers and BSO arrived on scene and started search teams entering the 1200 bldg. I held my position in case there was a possible ambush from the parking lot. Other CSPD officers joined me in securing the northeast lot. After a brief wait, we were advised via radio, that the shooter was seen on video exiting the 1200 building (westbound) prior to my arrival.

I joined one of the search teams and assisted gunshot victims by placing them on a golf cart, driven by Ofc. Wilkins, who took them to the rescue staging area. I was approached by a female student who advised she couldn't walk anymore, due to a gunshot wound in her left hip. I carried her to Pine Island Rd. and handed her off to a Deputy. I ran back and observed Ofc. Maclean assisting a female with gunshot wounds to her knees. We lifted up the female and walked her to the CSPD "Bear Cat" vehicle, who took her to the rescue staging area.

I was asked by Sgt. Kozlowski to join another search team to clear the band/theater building of the school. We made contact with students in the band room who advised they were ok. The rest of the building was clear.

I had no further involvement in this incident.

On 2/14/18 I responded to Marjory Stoneman Douglas H.S. (Parkland) in reference to an active shooter. Upon my arrival on the SE corner of the school property I coordinated the clearing of the school's SE parking lot along with Det. Bruna, Det. Kull, Officer Mulvey, Officer Coldoros and Officer Anderson. We cleared all cars (east to west) and moved up to several small portable units located on the south side of the property. All unsecured portables were cleared and no contact was made during our searches.

I then assisted in the clearing of the 100 building (Administration Building) 1st floor, with officers from multiple jurisdictions. Upon clearing the 1st floor it was learned that a classroom on the 2nd floor of this building still contained students. Officer Mulvey and I then joined Hallandale SWAT Operators and cleared the building's 2nd floor.

Upon leaving the school I responded to the Marriott Hotel which had been designated a staging area for families and children evacuated from the school and for those who were trying to locate missing family members. There I met with CSPD Victim Advocates (Linarte and Berrios) and coordinating members of the FBI and BSO who were actively trying to determine the names of those killed in the incident. Due to the number of impacted families, I requested detectives from Special Investigations respond in order to assist with coordinating death notifications (Detectives Crawford, Hallman, Kull, Bruna, Mitter, Randazzo, Payne and Koenig).

Later, members of BSO determined that they did not require additional outside support and released all non-BSO members from their assignments. I confirmed with members of the FBI that no further CSPD assistance was needed and all detectives were released from the scene.

Berrios and Linarte remained at the Marriott in order to assist with counseling and death notifications.

I took no further action.

ON 2/14/18 I RESPONDED TO THE LISTED ADDRESS IN REFERENCE TO AN ACTIVE KILLER INCIDENT. UPON ARRIVAL I APPROACHED THE NORTH WEST STUDENT PARKING ENTRANCE. OFC. BURTON ADVISED THAT THE SHOOTING OCCURRED IN THE THREE STORY BUILDING ON THE NORTH SIDE OF THE CAMPUS. I WAS DIRECTLY NORTH OF THE WEST ENTRANCE INTO THAT THREE STORY BUILDING (1200 BUILDING). I OBSERVED TWO DEPUTY'S IN THE PARKING LOT, I ASKED THEM WHERE THE SHOOTER WAS BUT THEY ADVISED HIS LOCATION WAS UNKNOWN. I DIRECTED MY ATTENTION TO THE 1200 BUILDING WHERE I OBSERVED A [REDACTED] LYING ON HIS BACK, LATER IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED]. I OBSERVED THE THIRD FLOOR WEST WINDOW WAS STILL INTACT BUT HAD VISIBLE BULLET IMPACT MARKS.

AS I BEGAN MY APPROACH INTO THE BUILDING, I WAS JOINED BY SGT. MAZZEI, SGT. MYERS AND OFC. WILKINS. WE APPROACHED THE WEST DOORS OF BUILDING 1200 AND CHECKED ON [REDACTED] BUT [REDACTED] WAS UNRESPONSIVE. IT SHOULD BE NOTED THAT AT THIS TIME WE WERE UNABLE TO DETERMINE THE SUSPECTS/GUNMAN (NIKOLAS CRUZ) LOCATION AND WERE ACTIVELY SEARCHING FOR HIM. WE ENTERED THE BUILDING AND IMMEDIATELY ENCOUNTERED A [REDACTED] WHO HAD BEEN SHOT, STANDING AGAINST A WALL. THE [REDACTED] LATER IDENTIFIED AS [REDACTED]. [REDACTED] WAS CONSCIOUS AND BREATHING BUT FELL TO THE FLOOR AND WAS IN SHOCK. [REDACTED] COULD NOT SPEAK OR GIVE ME ANY INFORMATION AS TO THE LOCATION OF THE GUNMAN. WE MOVED TOWARD [REDACTED] AND I GRABBED [REDACTED] BY HIS ARMS DRAGGING HIM OUT OF THE BUILDING, WITH THE ASSISTANCE OF OFC. WILKINS. I LEFT [REDACTED] WITH OFC. WILKINS AND REENTERED THE BUILDING, TO CONTINUE THE SEARCH FOR THE GUNMAN. THE HALLWAY WAY QUIET AND FULL OF THICK SMOKE FROM GUNFIRE. AS WE MOVED EAST, I ENCOUNTERED A WHITE FEMALE TAKING SHELTER IN AN OFFICE, NEAR WHERE [REDACTED] WAS AND REMOVED HER FROM THE BUILDING.

AT THIS POINT MORE CORAL SPRINGS OFFICERS MADE ENTRY INTO THE EAST DOORS OF BUILDING 1200. IN ORDER TO AVOID A CROSS FIRE, WE MADE THE DECISION TO CONTINUE THE SEARCH FOR THE GUNMAN ON THE SECOND FLOOR. ONCE ON THE SECOND FLOOR WE BEGAN LOCATING STUDENTS AND TEACHERS HIDING IN THE CLASSROOMS. WE STILL DID NOT KNOW THE GUNMAN'S LOCATION AND AS SUCH KEPT THE STUDENTS IN THE CLASSROOMS. ONCE THE SECOND FLOOR WAS SECURED, I MOVED TO ASSIST WITH CLEARING THE THIRD FLOOR. ON THE THIRD FLOOR I ENCOUNTERED SEVERAL DECEASED STUDENTS THROUGHOUT THE HALL WAY. I MADE MY WAY EAST, DOWN THE HALLWAY WHERE I WAS ASKED (BY BSO SWAT) TO STAND BY AND HOLD ON A DOOR. ONCE THE THIRD FLOOR WAS RENDERED SAFE AND CLEARED OF ANY THREATS, I RESPONDED TO BUILDING 13 AND ASSISTED CLEARING ROOMS THERE. BUILDING 13 WAS CLEARED OF ALL THREATS AND RENDERED SAFE.
