THERE'S ANOTHER IMPORTANT GROUP TO THANK: THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS. WITHOUT THEIR SUPPORT – AND SOMETIMES THEY WILL NUDGE ME IN A DIFFERENT DIRECTION – WE WOULDN'T HAVE BEEN ABLE TO ACCOMPLISH SO MUCH FOR OUR RESIDENTS IN THE PAST EIGHT YEARS TO MOVE OUR COUNTY FORWARD.

AND MY SINCERE APPRECIATION TO OUR DISTINGUISHED MAYORS, CITY COMMISSIONERS, SCHOOL BOARD MEMBERS, INCLUDING CHAIRWOMAN PERLA TABARES HANTMAN, AND JUDICIAL OFFICERS, ALONG WITH OUR CIVIC, RELIGIOUS, BUSINESS AND UNION LEADERS.

WE HAVE ACHIEVED MANY GREAT THINGS BY PUTTING DIFFERENCES ASIDE AND WORKING TOGETHER.

WE ARE GOING TO TAKE A WHIRLWIND TOUR OF WHERE WE ARE AND WHERE WE'RE HEADING. FASTEN YOUR SEATBELTS AND GET READY!

BEFORE WE FAST FORWARD, LET'S LOOK BACK A BIT TO UNDERSTAND HOW FAR WE'VE TRAVELLED TOGETHER.

IN MY FIRST STATE OF THE COUNTY ADDRESS IN 2012, WE WERE FACING TOUGH TIMES.

HOUSING PRICES HAD PLUMMETED, FORECLOSURES WERE SKY-ROCKETING IN ALL OUR NEIGHBORHOODS, TOURISM WAS STRUGGLING, OUR PUBLIC HOSPITAL WAS IN THE RED, AND WE HAD A BRAIN DRAIN, WITH YOUNG PEOPLE LEAVING FOR TECH JOBS IN NEW YORK AND SILICON VALLEY.

IN SHORT, MIAMI-DADE COUNTY WAS IN A HORRIBLE PLACE FINANCIALLY, WITH THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE HITTING A STAGGERING 12 PERCENT.

FAST FORWARD TO 2020, AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY'S ECONOMY NOW IS BOOMING, OUR REAL ESTATE MARKET IS ROBUST, AND THE UNEMPLOYMENT RATE STANDS BELOW 3 PERCENT – WHICH IS ESSENTIALLY FULL EMPLOYMENT. THE MEDIAN HOUSEHOLD INCOME IN OUR COUNTY HAS GONE UP ALMOST 20 PERCENT FROM A DECADE AGO, TO MORE THAN \$52,000 TODAY.

WE ACHIEVED ALL THESE ECONOMIC GAINS THROUGH THE HARD WORK OF OUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, LOCAL ENTREPRENEURS AND NUMEROUS COMMUNITY LEADERS AND LABOR PARTNERS.

TOGETHER, WE WORKED OUR WAY OUT OF THE FINANCIAL MESS WE HAD INHERITED.

AND THERE WAS SHARED SACRIFICE AMONG OUR COUNTY EMPLOYEES. TO THEM I SAY: I AM HONORED TO WORK WITH YOU. WE COULDN'T HAVE DONE ALL WE HAVE ACCOMPLISHED WITHOUT YOUR COMMITMENT TO PUBLIC SERVICE.

LET'S GIVE THEM A ROUND OF APPLAUSE.

TODAY, I AM PROUD TO SAY THAT THE STATE OF OUR COUNTY IS STABLE AND STRONG, AND MIAMI-DADE'S FUTURE IS BRIGHT!

ED AND JENN, YOUR LEADERSHIP TO GET MIAMI-DADE'S FINANCIAL HOUSE IN ORDER SET THE STAGE FOR ALL WE HAVE BEEN ABLE TO DO TO GROW AND DIVERSIFY MIAMI-DADE'S ECONOMY.

FOR STARTERS, WE CUT MORE THAN \$400 MILLION FROM THE COUNTY BUDGET. WE ALSO SLASHED THE NUMBER OF COUNTY DEPARTMENTS FROM 42 TO 26, AND WE CUT NEARLY 1,500 COUNTY POSITIONS.

AND WE DID ALL THIS WHILE ALSO CUTTING TAXES TO A HISTORIC LOW.

IN FACT, WE MADE THE LARGEST TAX CUT IN COUNTY HISTORY.

HICIMOS EL RECORTE DE IMPUESTOS MAS GRANDE EN LA HISTORIA DEL CONDADO.

SINCE 2011, WE HAVE SAVED HOMEOWNERS ON AVERAGE MORE THAN \$1,700 ON THEIR TAX BILLS, WHICH ADDS UP TO \$1.8 BILLION IN SAVINGS.AND WE ACHIEVED THIS WHILE EXPANDING COUNTY SERVICES TO RESIDENTS.

SINCE 2011, WE'VE ALSO SAVED TAXPAYERS \$1.8 BILLION IN INTEREST COSTS OVER THE LIFE OF THE BONDS ISSUED.

JUST LAST YEAR, THE COUNTY HAD FIVE REFUNDING BOND ISSUANCES THAT GENERATED \$203 MILLION IN GROSS DEBT SERVICE SAVINGS.

AND OVER AT JACKSON, THANKS TO MONUMENTAL WORK LED BY PRESIDENT AND C-E-O CARLOS MIGOYA, WE SUCCESSFULLY REORGANIZED OUR PUBLIC HOSPITAL.

JACKSON HAS NOW BEEN IN THE BLACK FOR EIGHT CONSECUTIVE YEARS.

AND NEXT MONTH WE WILL OPEN THE MIAMI PROJECT TO CURE PARALYSIS AT U-HEALTH / JACKSON MEMORIAL. THIS

WILL BE THE NATION'S MOST SOPHISTICATED REHABILITATION CENTER TO TREAT SPINAL AND BRAIN INJURIES.

ONE OF THE KEYS TO OUR ECONOMY'S SUCCESS HAS BEEN THE BEACON COUNCIL'S "ONE COMMUNITY ONE GOAL" INITIATIVE, WHICH I'VE CO-CHAIRED SINCE 2011 WHEN WE RE-LAUNCHED THIS GREAT INITIATIVE.

"ONE COMMUNITY ONE GOAL" HAS FOCUSED ON DEVELOPING SEVEN KEY SECTORS OF OUR ECONOMY. IT HAS ALSO STRESSED THE IMPORTANCE OF ATTRACTING, DEVELOPING AND RETAINING TOP TALENT.

UNDER THE STRATEGIC VISION OF BEACON COUNCIL PRESIDENT AND C-E-O MICHAEL FINNEY, OUR COUNTY ADDED ALMOST 2 MILLION SQUARE FEET OF NEW CONSTRUCTION IN 54 PROJECTS THAT BROUGHT IN MORE THAN \$820 MILLION LAST YEAR.

THIS IS THE LARGEST AMOUNT OF NEW CAPITAL INVESTMENT IN THE 34-YEAR HISTORY OF THE BEACON COUNCIL. BEST OF ALL, IT HAS CREATED NEARLY 3,000 LOCAL JOBS, WITH 58 PERCENT OF THESE JOBS IN URBAN PRIORITY AREAS.

WE ARE MOVING FAST IN THE TECH FIELD AND IN LEVERAGING OUR SUNSHINE TO PROTECT OUR ENVIRONMENT.

PARTNERING WITH THE COUNTY, FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT OPENED THE NEW "MIAMI-DADE SOLAR ENERGY CENTER" IN SOUTH DADE WITH 300,000 SOLAR PANELS LAST FEBRUARY.

AND WE WILL SOON UNVEIL FPL'S NEW FLOATING SOLAR PANELS ON THE LAKE RIGHT NEXT TO MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT. THEY ARE A GREAT SOURCE OF RENEWABLE ENERGY, AND THEY WILL GIVE MIAMI-DADE A REALLY COOL, HIGH-TECH VIBE WHEN TRAVELERS FLYING THROUGH M-I-A SEE THESE SOLAR PANELS FROM THE AIR.

ANOTHER HIGH-TECH BOON FOR MIAMI-DADE THAT WE'VE SUPPORTED SINCE DAY ONE IS THE ANNUAL E-MERGE CONFERENCE. IT HAS BROUGHT MAJOR GLOBAL INVESTORS TO OUR LOCAL BUSINESSES – HEAVY HITTERS, LIKE SOFT-BANK AND STEVE CASE'S REVOLUTION GROWTH FUND.

THE COUNTY'S GROWING DOMINANCE IN THE TECH SECTOR PROMPTED "INC." MAGAZINE TO NAME MIAMI-DADE AMONG THE TOP 10 PLACES IN THE NATION FOR START-UP ACTIVITY IN ITS ANNUAL "SURGE CITIES" LIST.

THE JOB GENERATORS WE HAVE CREATED SPAN A WIDE RANGE OF FIELDS.

IN MIAMI LAKES, THE \$4 BILLION "AMERICAN DREAM ENTERTAINMENT AND SHOPPING COMPLEX" WILL GENERATE 25,000 CONSTRUCTION JOBS AND PROVIDE AT LEAST 14,500 JOBS WHEN IT'S BUILT OUT.

AND AMAZON'S NEW FULFILLMENT CENTER IN COMMISSIONER BARBARA JORDAN'S DISTRICT IN OPA-LOCKA ALREADY EMPLOYS MORE THAN 1,500 WORKERS.

THESE ARE GOOD-PAYING JOBS WITH HEALTH INSURANCE AND RETIREMENT BENEFITS.

WE HAVE ALSO HELPED NEARLY 3,000 PEOPLE GET TRAINING AND FIND JOBS THROUGH OUR COUNTY'S "EMPLOY MIAMI DADE" INITIATIVE.

LOOKING TO THE FUTURE, WE ARE WORKING WITH M-I-T AND LOCAL UNIVERSITIES, HEALTH-CARE PROVIDERS AND BUSINESS LEADERS TO DEVELOP TECHNOLOGICAL ADVANCES THAT WILL REVOLUTIONIZE HEALTH CARE IN OUR COUNTY.

THERE WILL BE MORE TO SHARE IN THE COMING WEEKS ABOUT THIS FANTASTIC COLLABORATION WITH M-I-T AND OTHER COMMUNITY PARTNERS.

TECHNOLOGY ISN'T ONLY ABOUT SMART PHONES AND APPS OR – MY FAVORITE – THE ELECTRIC VERTICAL-LIFT VEHICLES OR "FLYING CARS" THAT ARE BEING DEVELOPED RIGHT NOW AS WE SPEAK.

NO, TECHNOLOGY IS MUCH MORE THAN THAT. AND IT TOUCHES ALL ASPECTS OF OUR LIVES, EVEN OUR FOOD SUPPLY.

DID YOU EVER IMAGINE THAT SOUTH FLORIDA COULD SERVE AS THE WORLD'S LARGEST SITE FOR SALMON PRODUCTION?

**WELL, WE SOON WILL.** 

ATLANTIC SAPPHIRE'S NEW SALMON FARMS IN COMMISSIONER DENNIS MOSS' DISTRICT IN SOUTH DADE WILL EXPAND OUR MARKET SHARE IN THIS GROWING INDUSTRY.

IT'S ALREADY IN PRODUCTION, AND THE FIRST BATCH WILL BE READY IN JULY. THIS MASSIVE FACILITY WILL PUT OUR COUNTY ON TRACK TO BE THE WORLD'S TOP SALMON PRODUCER BY 2030.

THANKS TO TECHNOLOGY, THESE INDOOR FARMS WILL PROVIDE A SECURE FOOD SUPPLY PRODUCED IN CLIMATE-CONTROLLED TANKS FREE FROM MICROPLASTICS.

TECHNOLOGY CAN BE DISRUPTIVE, BUT WE ARE NOT RUNNING AWAY FROM IT. WE ARE SEIZING THIS AS AN OPPORTUNITY TO CREATE BETTER JOBS.

WE WERE DISRUPTIVE WHEN THE COUNTY OPENED THE WAY FOR POPULAR RIDE-SHARE COMPANIES LIKE UBER AND LYFT TO COMPETE IN OUR MARKET. I WANT TO THANK COMMISSIONER STEVE BOVO FOR HIS WORK ON THIS FRONT.

WE ARE NOW IN PARTNERSHIP WITH FORD MOTOR COMPANY TO TEST DRIVER-LESS VEHICLES ON OUR COUNTY'S STREETS. I'VE BEEN ON SOME OF THOSE TEST RIDES. AND LET ME TELL YOU, THEY ARE WILD!

AND JUST LAST MONTH, MIAMI-DADE BECAME THE FIRST PLACE ON THE EAST COAST TO HAVE THE NEW "UBER WORKS" APP THAT WILL SERVE AS A STAFFING AGENCY AND HELP PEOPLE FIND FLEXIBLE JOB SHIFTS.

FROM THE VERY FIRST DAY OF MY ADMINISTRATION, I'VE FOCUSED ON HOW TECHNOLOGY CAN MAKE RESIDENTS' LIVES BETTER, AND HOW GOVERNMENT CAN HELP ENCOURAGE PRIVATE ENTERPRISE TO MEET THOSE NEEDS.

A STRONG ECONOMY GIVES US THE RESOURCES WE NEED TO BE FLEXIBLE AND RESILIENT SO THAT WE CAN MEET FUTURE CHALLENGES HEAD-ON.

THIS YEAR, THE COUNTY IS INVESTING \$466 MILLION OF ITS OPERATING BUDGET TO PROMOTE RESILIENCY EFFORTS.

THIS WILL HELP US OVERCOME THE CHALLENGES OF SEA LEVEL RISE AND OTHER SHOCKS, LIKE THE HURRICANES THAT INEVITABLY WILL HIT OUR COUNTY.

WE ALSO HAVE CLOSE TO \$3.2 BILLION DEDICATED TO OUR COUNTY'S COMMUNITY RESILIENCE CAPITAL PLAN.

THIS IS A WHOLE NEW WAY OF LOOKING AT MIAMI-DADE'S BUDGET.

DURING MY FIRST TERM, WE CREATED THE NATION'S FIRST COUNTYWIDE OFFICE OF RESILIENCE, LED BY JIM MURLEY.

HIS OFFICE IS WORKING WITH EVERY DEPARTMENT WITHIN OUR COUNTY GOVERNMENT TO PLAN FOR THE FUTURE.

I WANT TO THANK VICE CHAIRWOMAN REBECA SOSA FOR HER OUTSTANDING LEADERSHIP ON RESILIENCY.

PLEASE JOIN ME IN THANKING HER WITH A ROUND OF APPLAUSE.

WE ARE USING TECHNOLOGY TO FIGHT THE CHALLENGES PRODUCED BY SEA LEVEL RISE. MIAMI-DADE IS THE FIRST COUNTY IN THE NATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE ROCKEFELLER FOUNDATION'S 100 RESILIENT CITIES PROGRAM.

PARTNERING WITH THE CITIES OF MIAMI AND MIAMI BEACH, WE LAUNCHED THE RESILIENT-305 STRATEGY IN MAY, AND IT'S WELL UNDERWAY. THAT PLAN CLEARLY DESCRIBES 59 ACTION ITEMS THAT WILL HELP US DEAL WITH SHORTTERM SHOCKS AND LONG-TERM STRESSES RESULTING FROM OUR CHANGING ENVIRONMENT.

THIS YEAR, WE BEGAN A COUNTYWIDE INFRASTRUCTURE INVESTMENT PROGRAM TO BRING FACILITIES AND ASSETS UP TO CODE. THIS PROGRAM WILL IMPROVE ENERGY USE, HEIGHTEN SECURITY, AND ACHIEVE OTHER RESILIENCE GOALS NOW AND FAR INTO OUR FUTURE.

AND SPEAKING OF WISE PLANNING, MIAMI-DADE IS CURRENTLY IMPLEMENTING THE FIRST-OF-ITS-KIND "RESILIENT SCORECARD." THIS WILL HELP ALL COUNTY DEPARTMENTS TRACK THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS TO OUR COMMUNITY'S FUTURE SO WE CAN SEE THE PROGRESS WE ARE MAKING.

WE ARE ABLE TO TAKE THIS PROACTIVE APPROACH TO RESILIENCE BECAUSE WE HAVE CREATED A STRONG ECONOMY THAT GIVES US THE RESOURCES WE NEED TO TACKLE FUTURE CHALLENGES.

THE TOP TWO DRIVERS OF OUR ECONOMY CONTINUE TO BE PORT MIAMI AND MIAMI INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT.

NEW RECORDS WERE SET AT M-I-A IN 2019, WITH PASSENGER TRAFFIC AT 46 MILLION TRAVELERS AND CARGO SHIPMENTS AT 2.3 MILLION TONS.

WE ALSO ADDED FIVE NEW INTERNATIONAL ROUTES, INCLUDING ROYAL AIR MAROC'S ROUTE TO CASABLANCA IN MOROCCO.

FOR PERSPECTIVE, WHEN I TOOK OFFICE IN 2011, M-I-A HAD HIT A RECORD OF 38 MILLION PASSENGERS.

SO, OUR AIRPORT HAS INCREASED ITS TRAFFIC BY 8 MILLION PEOPLE, WHICH IS MORE THAN 20 PERCENT GROWTH IN LESS THAN A DECADE.

LAST YEAR, THIS GROWTH IN TRAVEL AND CARGO RESULTED IN MORE THAN \$32 BILLION IN DIRECT BUSINESS REVENUE GENERATED AT M-I-A AND THE COUNTY'S GENERAL AVIATION AIRPORTS. THIS AMOUNTED TO A TOTAL ECONOMIC VALUE OF \$118 BILLION FOR THE REGION.

IN ADDITION, M-I-A CONTRIBUTED DIRECTLY AND INDIRECTLY TO MORE THAN 425,000 JOBS, IF YOU INCLUDE AIR FREIGHT.

TO SUPPORT FUTURE GROWTH, OUR COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVED \$5 BILLION IN AIRPORT MODERNIZATION PROJECTS BACK IN JUNE. THIS WILL PAVE THE WAY FOR AN ESTIMATED 77 MILLION TRAVELERS AND FOUR MILLION TONS OF FREIGHT AT M-I-A BY 2040. LET'S TAKE A LOOK AT WHAT'S TO COME.

THAT WAS REALLY IMPRESSIVE, AND THESE ARE THE THINGS THAT WE HAVE TO DO TO KEEP M-I-A COMPETITIVE INTO THE FUTURE!

AT PORT-MIAMI, MULTIPLE RECORDS WERE ALSO SET IN 2019.

ON THE CARGO SIDE, FOR THE FIFTH CONSECUTIVE YEAR, PORT-MIAMI SURPASSED THE 1 MILLION T-E-U MARK. THIS MEANS THAT PORT-MIAMI HANDLED MORE THAN A MILLION CONTAINERS MEASURING AT LEAST 20 FEET LONG AND EIGHT FEET TALL.

THIS GROWTH WAS MADE POSSIBLE THANKS TO MORE THAN \$1 BILLION IN INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS THAT HAVE ALLOWED PORT-MIAMI TO HANDLE MORE THAN 300 POST-PANAMAX VESSELS THAT WOULD <u>NOT</u> HAVE BEEN ABLE TO CALL HERE BEFORE.

IN FACT, IN DECEMBER, WE WELCOMED THE MAGELLAN TO OUR PORT.

YEAH, THAT'S ME CLIMBING
THE MAGELLAN FROM A PILOT BOAT.
WHAT CAN I SAY? THE FIRE-FIGHTER IN ME HAD TO DO IT!

THE MAGELLAN IS THE LARGEST CONTAINER SHIP TO EVER VISIT A FLORIDA PORT, SO WE ARE REALLY PROUD OF THAT ACHIEVEMENT.

AND LOOK AT THE SIZE DIFFERENCE BETWEEN THE MAGELLAN AND THE SHIPS THAT COULD NAVIGATE OUR PORT BEFORE THE DEEP DREDGE.

THAT'S INCREDIBLE.

ON THE CRUISE SIDE, PORT-MIAMI CONTINUES TO HOLD ITS DOMINANT POSITION AS THE "CRUISE CAPITAL OF THE WORLD."

IN 2019, PORT-MIAMI HIT AN ALL-TIME RECORD OF MORE THAN 6.8 MILLION PASSENGERS. THIS WAS A 22 PERCENT INCREASE OVER THE YEAR BEFORE.

LET'S NOW TAKE A CLOSER LOOK AT WHAT'S AHEAD FOR PORT MIAMI IN THIS SHORT VIDEO...

**WASN'T THAT IMPRESSIVE?** 

WE HAVE A FANTASTIC FUTURE AHEAD OF US!

THE PORT'S EXPANSION WILL GENERATE AN INCREASED ECONOMIC IMPACT TO SOUTH FLORIDA OF ABOUT \$7.8 BILLION, SUPPORTING AN ADDITIONAL 27,500 JOBS ANNUALLY.

MEANWHILE NEW SHOT-SPOTTER TECHNOLOGY HAS REDUCED CRIME AND IMPROVED PUBLIC SAFETY.
MOVING FORWARD, WE ARE EXPANDING THIS PROGRAM, ALONG WITH OUR LICENSE PLATE READERS.

BOTH SYSTEMS TRANSMIT LIFE-SAVING INFORMATION TO OUR REAL-TIME CRIME CENTER.

AT FIRE RESCUE, THE COUNTY HIRED 130 NEW FIREFIGHTERS IN 2019, AND FOUR NEW UNITS WERE ADDED, AS WELL AS A NEW STATION THAT OPENED IN PALMETTO BAY.

AND OUR CORRECTIONS AND REHABILITATION DEPARTMENT IS ALSO IN FULL AUTOMATION-MODE. STARTING THIS YEAR, WE WILL HAVE VIDEO VISITATION AS AN OPTION FOR PEOPLE AWAITING TRIAL OR SERVING SHORT SENTENCES.

THANKS TO DIRECTOR MORRIS COPELAND AND HIS TEAM AT THE JUVENILE SERVICES DEPARTMENT, WE ALSO CONTINUE TO REDUCE YOUTH VIOLENCE WITH A NUMBER OF OUTSTANDING PROGRAMS AND PARTNERS IN OUR COMMUNITY.

ONE OF OUR MOST CREATIVE HIGH-TECH SOLUTIONS IS THE "VELOCIA" MOBILITY APP WE LAUNCHED LAST MONTH. IT OFFERS REWARDS FOR SMART TRANSIT DECISIONS THAT HELP PEOPLE BREAK THE HABIT OF TRAVELING ALONE IN THEIR CARS.

VELOCIA WAS THE WINNING IDEA OF OUR COUNTY'S "FASTRACK" COMPETITION.

WE ALSO LAUNCHED "CONTACTLESS OPEN PAYMENT" FOR OUR TRANSIT SYSTEM BACK IN AUGUST. NOW, YOU CAN QUICKLY ENTER THE FAREGATE ON METRORAIL AND METROBUSES WITH A SIMPLE TAP OF YOUR CREDIT CARD OR DIGITAL WALLET.

IN ADDITION, OUR CARPOOLING PARTNERSHIP WITH WAZE HAS HELPED REDUCE GRIDLOCK.
WE ARE ALSO WORKING HARD TO IMPROVE MIAMI-DADE'S ROADWAYS AND TRANSIT OPTIONS.

OUR COUNTY'S "STRATEGIC MIAMI AREA RAPID TRANSIT" PLAN IS ADVANCING SIX CORRIDORS OF THE PEOPLE'S TRANSPORTATION PLAN. IN 2019, WE ACHIEVED MANY KEY MILESTONES FOR THE SMART PLAN.

IN OCTOBER, COUNTY COMMISSIONERS APPROVED \$76 MILLION FOR CONSTRUCTION OF A RAIL STATION AND PARK-AND-RIDE LOT ON THE NORTHEAST CORRIDOR IN A PUBLIC-PRIVATE PARTNERSHIP WITH VIRGIN TRAINS U.S.A.

THIS WILL LINK COMMUTERS TRAVELING BETWEEN
AVENTURA AND DOWNTOWN MIAMI. VIRGIN TRAINS IS ALSO
ADDING A STOP AT PORT-MIAMI.

AND PLANS ARE ALSO UNDERWAY FOR A TRI-RAIL STATION IN MIDTOWN.

FOR COMMUTERS IN THE SOUTH CORRIDOR, WE ARE MOVING QUICKLY ON A BUS RAPID TRANSIT SYSTEM WITH ICONIC STATIONS THAT WILL GET PASSENGERS TO THEIR DESTINATION AS FAST AS IF THEY WERE RIDING METRORAIL.

WE WILL BE ABLE TO COMPLETE THIS PROJECT IN THE SUMMER OF 2022.

UNDER CURRENT REGULATIONS, THIS WILL BE FINISHED YEARS SOONER THAN WE COULD HAVE COMPLETED A RAIL SYSTEM, FOR ABOUT A BILLION DOLLARS LESS.

THE GOOD NEWS IS THE TRUMP ADMINISTRATION HAS PUBLISHED PROPOSED RULES TO EXPEDITE ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEWS ON PROJECTS.

I WANT TO THANK PRESIDENT TRUMP FOR HIS LEADERSHIP TO BRING COMMON-SENSE REFORMS TO CUT RED TAPE WITHOUT HURTING OUR ENVIRONMENT.

FOR THE NORTH CORRIDOR, WE ARE WORKING WITH THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION TO DESIGN AND BUILD MUCH-NEEDED AND LONG-PROMISED PUBLIC TRANSIT IN COMMISSIONER BARBARA JORDAN'S DISTRICT.

PLANS FOR THE BEACH CORRIDOR WILL CONNECT MIAMI BEACH TO DOWNTOWN MIAMI AND EVENTUALLY TO THE DESIGN DISTRICT AND MIDTOWN.
AND THE R-F-P FOR THE FIRST LEG OF THAT PROJECT IS NOW UNDERWAY.

ON THE EAST-WEST CORRIDOR ALONG STATE ROAD 836, AN EXPRESS BUS ROUTE ON THE DOLPHIN EXPRESSWAY WILL BE IN OPERATION THIS SPRING.

MEANWHILE, THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORKS IS NOW ANALYZING THREE RAPID TRANSIT ALTERNATIVES.

WE ARE ALSO UPDATING OUR BUS FLEET, BRINGING HUNDREDS OF C-N-G AND ELECTRIC BUSES THAT WILL DRAMATICALLY REDUCE OUR COUNTY'S CARBON FOOTPRINT. AND WE WILL COMPLETE OUR RAIL MODERNIZATION PLAN WITH ALL NEW TRAIN CARS BY THIS SPRING.

THERE ARE NO QUICK FIXES, BUT WE ARE MOVING STEADILY FORWARD WITH THE HELP OF TECHNOLOGY.

WE CONTINUE TO UPGRADE LIGHTS AT 3,000 INTERSECTIONS USING ADAPTIVE TRAFFIC SIGNAL TECHNOLOGY. THIS ALLOWS FOR CONTINUOUS ADJUSTMENTS OF SIGNAL TIMING TO MEET TRAFFIC DEMANDS AND CHANGING ROAD CONDITIONS.

WE ARE ALREADY SEEING IMPROVEMENTS IN DRIVE TIMES DURING RUSH HOUR ON U.S.-1 AND OTHER ROADS.

WE ARE ALSO WORKING WITH DEVELOPERS TO BUILD HOUSING AT STRATEGIC LOCATIONS THAT MINIMIZE THE TIME PEOPLE SPEND COMMUTING.

NEW "TRANSIT-ORIENTED DEVELOPMENTS" INCLUDE THE "LINK AT DOUGLAS" AND "MOTION AT DADELAND." BOTH OF THESE DEVELOPMENTS ARE NEXT TO METRORAIL STATIONS IN COMMISSIONER XAVIER SUAREZ'S DISTRICT.

EVEN AS WE COME UP WITH CREATIVE WAYS TO GET MORE PEOPLE OUT OF THEIR CARS INTO TRANSIT AND RIDE-SHARE OPTIONS, WE KNOW THAT MOST PEOPLE STILL HAVE TO COUNT ON THEIR CARS TO GET AROUND.

THAT'S WHY I WILL KEEP FIGHTING FOR THE RESIDENTS OF WEST KENDALL AND SOUTH DADE WHO ARE DESPERATE FOR RELIEF FROM TRAFFIC CONGESTION THAT IS DESTROYING THEIR QUALITY OF LIFE.

THERE'S BEEN A LOT OF MISINFORMATION ABOUT THE KENDALL PARKWAY PROJECT, INCLUDING ACCUSATIONS THAT IT WILL HURT THE EVERGLADES.

HERE, I TAKE MY INSPIRATION FROM ONE OF MY FAVORITE PRESIDENTS, TEDDY ROOSEVELT, WHO SAID – QUOTE – "THE NATION BEHAVES WELL IF IT TREATS THE NATURAL RESOURCES AS ASSETS, WHICH IT MUST TURN OVER TO THE NEXT GENERATION INCREASED AND NOT IMPAIRED IN VALUE. CONSERVATION MEANS DEVELOPMENT AS MUCH AS IT DOES PROTECTION."

THANK YOU, PRESIDENT ROOSEVELT, FOR THOSE WISE WORDS THAT HAVE STOOD THE TEST OF TIME.

WE WILL CONTINUE TO PUSH FOR THE KENDALL PARKWAY BECAUSE IT WILL DRAMATICALLY IMPROVE THE QUALITY OF LIFE FOR THE RESIDENTS OF WEST DADE.

ALL OF OUR ECONOMIC SUCCESS HAS ALSO CREATED CHALLENGES THAT WE ARE TURNING INTO NEW OPPORTUNITIES. AFFORDABLE HOUSING TOPS THAT LIST.

WE ARE EXPANDING ALL OPTIONS IN THE AREAS OF AFFORDABLE AND PUBLIC HOUSING, IN ADDITION TO THE FEDERAL SECTION 8 HOUSING PROGRAM.

WE ALSO HAVE MADE DRAMATIC PROGRESS FOR RESIDENTS OF ALL AGES.

WE CELEBRATED ONE OF MY PROUDEST ACHIEVEMENTS BACK IN JULY, WHEN WE HELD THE GRAND RE-OPENING OF PHASE ONE AT LIBERTY SQUARE.

MOST IMPRESSIVE OF ALL, NOT A SINGLE PUBLIC-HOUSING RESIDENT HAS BEEN DISPLACED. AS PROMISED, EVERYONE HAD A NEARBY PLACE TO LIVE DURING THE CONSTRUCTION UNTIL THEIR NEW UNITS WERE READY.

MY THANKS TO CHAIRWOMAN AUDREY EDMONSON FOR WORKING WITH ME TO IRON OUT THE ISSUES DURING THE DEVELOPMENT OF THIS PROJECT.

MIAMI-DADE'S HOMELESS TRUST ALSO HAS MADE HUGE STRIDES FORWARD TO PROVIDE SHELTER FOR THOSE MOST IN NEED. SINCE 1994, THE NUMBER OF HOMELESS RESIDENTS IN OUR COUNTY HAS DROPPED FROM MORE THAN 8,000 TO 1,100 PEOPLE TODAY.

THIS IS A NATIONWIDE CHALLENGE TO END HOMELESSNESS FOR L-G-B-T-Q YOUTH, ALONG WITH YOUNG PEOPLE OF COLOR.

FOR THOSE RESIDENTS IN OUR COUNTY WHO ARE HOMEOWNERS, LIFE HAS ALSO IMPROVED DRAMATICALLY IN THE PAST EIGHT YEARS.

IN 2012, SHORTLY AFTER I TOOK OFFICE, WE CREATED THE DEPARTMENT OF REGULATORY AND ECONOMIC RESOURCES TO CONSOLIDATE THE COUNTY'S FRAGMENTED PERMITTING PROCESS.

R-E-R HAS MADE DOZENS OF CODE CHANGES AND STREAMLINED PERMITTING, SAVING BUSINESSES AND HOMEOWNERS BOTH TIME AND MONEY.

THANKS TO W-A-S-D'S WISE PLANNING, MIAMI-DADE IS ONE OF ONLY FIVE GLOBAL COMMUNITIES TO PILOT A "CITY WATER RESILIENCE APPROACH" THAT WILL EVALUATE THE STRENGTHS AND WEAKNESSES OF OUR WATER SYSTEM.

WE ALSO CONTINUE TO STUDY THE WATER QUALITY OF OUR BEAUTIFUL BISCAYNE BAY.

2016. OUR COUNTY IS THE ONLY COMMUNITY IN THE WORLD TO HAVE CONQUERED THIS DEVASTATING VIRUS.

EVERYTHING THAT WE DO IN COUNTY GOVERNMENT IS FOCUSED ON MAKING MIAMI-DADE A BETTER PLACE FOR ALL RESIDENTS BY PUTTING PEOPLE FIRST.

WITH THAT GOAL IN MIND, THE COUNTY'S COMMUNITY ACTION AND HUMAN SERVICES DEPARTMENT HAS MADE GREAT STRIDES TO HELP OUR MOST VULNERABLE RESIDENTS.

SINCE 2011, MORE THAN 900 CHILDREN HAVE BEEN ADDED TO HEAD START PROGRAMS, WITH A NEW MODEL THAT PUTS NON-PROFITS IN CHARGE OF EDUCATION GOALS.

FOR EVERY \$1 OF LOCAL TAX MONEY SPENT, CAHSD HAS LEVERAGED MORE THAN \$3 FROM OUTSIDE FUNDERS. THIS HAS HELPED US BUILD CRITICAL SERVICES.

THROUGH A \$10 MILLION GRANT, MORE THAN 500 FAMILIES HAVE BEEN ADDED TO THE EARLY HEAD START PROGRAM.

THIS FUNDING CREATED MORE THAN 160 NEW JOBS IN 2019. IT ALSO INTRODUCED THE MONTESSORI METHOD INTO NEIGHBORHOODS THAT NORMALLY WOULD NOT HAVE ACCESS TO THIS HIGHLY SUCCESSFUL TEACHING MODEL.

CAHSD ALSO HAS HELPED FEED OUR COUNTY'S MOST VULNERABLE RESIDENTS: OUR CHILDREN AND OUR SENIORS.

MORE THAN 1.2 MILLION MEALS HAVE BEEN SERVED TO ADULTS, AND MORE THAN 10,000 CHILDREN HAVE RECEIVED TWO MEALS DAILY.

THIS PAST SUMMER, WE OFFERED MEALS TO KIDS AT 180 SITES. THAT'S AN INCREASE OF 35 PERCENT OVER LAST YEAR.

THAT'S A HUGE IMPROVEMENT OVER 2011, WHEN ONLY ABOUT 10,000 ANIMALS WERE SPAYED AND NEUTERED IN THE COUNTY.

TODAY, MIAMI-DADE'S SOCIAL MEDIA PAGES REACH MORE THAN 44 MILLION USERS EACH YEAR.

THANKS TO SENIOR ADVISOR MYRIAM MARQUEZ AND THE COMMUNICATIONS DEPARTMENT FOR CONTINUING TO FIND WAYS THAT MAKE GOVERNMENT SERVICES MORE ACCESSIBLE TO OUR RESIDENTS.

WHILE THE LIBRARY SYSTEM HELPS OUR RESIDENTS
DEVELOP THEIR MINDS, OUR DEPARTMENT OF PARKS,
RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES HELPS KEEP US PHYSICALLY
FIT AS WE ENJOY THE GREAT OUTDOORS.

ONE OF THE BIGGEST CHALLENGES OUR PARK SYSTEM FACED IN 2019 WAS THE SPREAD OF SEAWEED ALONG OUR SHORELINE.

WE BLADED AND REMOVED MORE THAN 27,000 CUBIC YARDS OF SEAWEED TO KEEP OUR BEACHES PRISTINE FOR OUR 2.8 MILLION RESIDENTS AND THE 23 MILLION TOURISTS WHO VISIT EACH YEAR AND WHO CONTRIBUTE MORE THAN \$18 BILLION TO OUR LOCAL ECONOMY.

I WANT TO THANK COMMISSIONER EILEEN HIGGINS FOR HER LEADERSHIP ON THAT PROJECT.

AND THE FATHER GERARD JEAN-JUST COMMUNITY CENTER, WHICH IS A BEAUTIFUL \$11 MILLION FACILITY.

IN 2019, PARKS ENTERED A NEW ERA OF INCLUSION FOR ALL CHILDREN WITH THE "SUPER-HERO GARDEN AUTISM PLAYGROUND" AT TAMIAMI PARK.

IT'S A FIRST-OF-ITS-KIND OUTDOOR PARK FOR YOUTH AT ALL RANGES OF THE AUTISM SPECTRUM. AND WE PLAN FOR MORE PLAYGROUNDS LIKE THIS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTY.

ENGAGEMENT IN HEALTHY RECREATION HAS INCREASED IN RECENT YEARS, THANKS TO THE MAYOR'S YOUTH SPORTS CHAMPIONSHIP SERIES.

MEANWHILE, THE FIT-2-LEAD YOUTH DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM HAS LED TO A 31 PERCENT REDUCTION IN JUVENILE ARRESTS IN ZIP CODES WHERE IT IS OFFERED.

THIS SUCCESS RESULTED IN FIT-2-LEAD RECEIVING A \$1.8 MILLION GRANT FROM THE CHILDREN'S TRUST.

WE CONTINUE TO EXPAND OUTDOOR OPPORTUNITIES FOR ALL RESIDENTS IN THE MOST CREATIVE WAYS.

THE FIRST HALF MILE OF THE UNDERLINE WILL OPEN THIS YEAR. THIS LINEAR RECREATION SPACE WILL EVENTUALLY SPAN 10 MILES, UNDER THE METRORAIL LINE.

WE ARE ALSO GOING TO HELP DEVELOP THE SIX-MILE LUDLAM TRAIL ALONG THE ABANDONED TRAIN TRACKS IN WEST MIAMI-DADE.

THIS HAS BEEN A TOP PROJECT FOR VICE CHAIRWOMAN REBECA SOSA.
