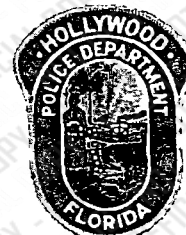

On October 17th, 2021 **Jason Banegas, W/M 11/09/2002** did knowingly, willfully and violently fight and resist Police Officer YC who at the time was engaged in the lawful execution of a legal duty through physical force. COUNT II

RESISTING OFFICER WITH VIOLENCE

On October 17th, 2021, Jason Banegas, W/M 11/09/2002 did willfully and violently resist **MRB**, a law enforcement officer dressed in a fully marked uniform, engaging in the lawful execution of a legal duty by doing violence causing injuries to **MRB** to include scratches and abrasions contrary to *F.S. 843.01*

COUNT III

ARMED BURGLARY

On October 17th, 2021, Jason Banegas, W/M 11/09/2002, did unlawfully enter the dwelling to wit: a covered carport, armed with a handgun with the intent to deprive **RN** of her red bike contrary to *F.S. 810.02*

COUNT IV

GRAND THEFT FIREARM

On October 17th, 2021, Jason Banegas, W/M 11/09/2002, was in possession of a stolen Glock 43x, 9mm semi-automatic handgun, stolen out of Miami Dade County, on September 14th, 2021 under Case number PD210915292199-N temporarily depriving **JV** of his firearm, contrary to *F.S. 812.04 (2)(c)(5)*.

COUNT V

CARRYING CONCEALED FIREARM

On October 17th, 2021, Jason Banegas, W/M 11/09/2002, did have a firearm concealed in his right front pants pocket as victim **YC** approached contrary to *F.S. 790.01 (2)*.

The undersigned Affiant, Detective Ryan Rillo of the Hollywood Police Department County of Broward, State of Florida, hereby submits this affidavit and application for arrest to the Honorable Ernest A. Kollra Jr. Judge of the Circuit Court of the Seventeenth Judicial Circuit in and for Broward County, State of Florida.

This affidavit and application is hereby electronically submitted bearing your Affiant's signature supported by oath or affirmation in compliance with F.S. 901.02(3), in which the Affiant deposes and says that on or about the 17th day of October A.D. 2021, in the County and State aforesaid, one **Jason Banegas W/M 11/09/2002** did then and there:

COUNT I

FELONY MURDER

On October 17th, 2021 Jason Banegas, W/M 11/09/2002 did knowingly, willfully and violently fight and resist Police Officer YC who at the time was engaged in the lawful execution of a legal duty through physical force. GROUND FOR ISSUANCE

The following grounds constitute this Affiant's reason for his belief that the laws of the State of Florida were violated as stated above and the facts establishing the grounds for this affidavit and the probable cause for believing that such facts exist are as follows:

AFFIANT QUALIFICATIONS

Your Affiant is Detective Ryan Rillo, Badge 2535, of the Hollywood Police Department and has been a Police Officer for over 28 years. Your Affiant has been assigned as a Patrol Officer and

Field Training Officer. Your Affiant has been a Detective for 16 years with the last 8 years assigned to the Homicide Unit. During my tenure in homicide, your Affiant has been trained in death investigations which include homicides; police involved shootings, suicides, accidental and unattended deaths.

PROBABLE CAUSE

On October 17, 2021, at approximately 2227 hours, Hollywood Police Officers were dispatched to a suspicious person call involving a white male riding a bicycle going house to house trying vehicle door handles in the area of 4040 North 44 Avenue. Officer Defreeze met with the reportee, and viewed video surveillance of the suspect wearing a blue hoodie, white t-shirt with a design on the front, and dark pants, riding a red bicycle with a front basket trying to open car doors. This information was issued as a BOLO to responding units at 2242 hours.

At 2252 hours, Victim Officer YC operating a marked patrol vehicle and wearing an issued police uniform with insignias made contact with a male matching the suspect description in the 4100 block of North Hills Drive. Dispatch records revealed Victim Officer YC was in a physical struggle with the suspect and was unable to provide his exact location. At 2254 hours, Officer MRB arrived on scene. He stated to Detective Toler and me when he arrived, he observed Victim YC and the suspect, later identified as Jason Banegas, on the ground in the grass swale. The suspect was holding a pistol, and the victim was attempting to wrestle the pistol away from him. Officer MRB kicked the suspect, knocking the pistol out of his hand. Officer MRB and the suspect began to physically fight, with the suspect violently resisting the Officer MRB's attempts to place him into custody. The suspect was eventually handcuffed by Officer MRB, who received abrasions and scratches during the violent encounter. After he handcuffed the suspect, he noticed Victim YC was shot in the face and was unresponsive. Officer MRB began to perform CPR on Victim YC. Other Officers arrived at the scene and transported Victim YC to Memorial Regional Hospital while performing CPR in the police vehicle. Victim YC was later pronounced deceased at Memorial Regional Hospital at 0111 hours. Memorial Staff advised Detective Keough that the victim had a gunshot wound on the left side of his head between his ear and jaw. The suspect was transported to the Hollywood Police Department.

The scene encompassed the 4100 block of North Hills Drive just west of the roundabout. There was a red bicycle with a white basket in the middle of the street. Close by, in the north grass swale were two sneakers and a large blood scene from where Victim YC was found on the ground. A navy blue zip-up jacket was found on the swale west of the blood scene.

A Glock pistol with a black frame and satin/nickel slide bearing serial number BLCU6550 was discovered east of the blood scene. The pistol was reported stolen during a vehicle burglary to the Miami Dade Police Department on September 14, 2021 under case number

PD210915292199-N. The pistol was identified as a Glock 43x, 9mm, semiautomatic pistol. The victim was identified as JV.

Detective Patriarca told me he was approached by a male identified as [REDACTED] at the Emerald Hills Country Club. Witness [REDACTED] told him his vehicle broke down, and while he was awaiting a tow truck, he heard two gunshots. He advised, prior to the shooting, he was with the suspect, who he identified as his girlfriend's brother.

Witness [REDACTED] was transported by patrol to the Hollywood Police Department. Post Miranda warnings, he provided a digitally recorded video statement to Detective Toler and me outlined below.

The suspect, he identified as Jason, and the witness were driving home in the witness' Jeep when it broke down. The suspect was wearing a blue zippered jacket, white shirt, blue jeans, and white sneakers. The suspect's description and physical characteristics were the same provided by Officer Defreeze when he met with the reportee from the suspicious person call. He pulled the Jeep up to the front entrance to the Emerald Hills Country Club and called a tow company. The suspect left the witness for approximately 30 minutes and returned on a red bicycle with a light-colored basket affixed to the front. The suspect left the witness again on the bicycle and returned a short time later with AirPods, AirPods Pros, an iPhone, an iPod, and cash. He wrapped the items in a white-colored shirt with a unique design on the front and placed the items on a bench in front of the country club. Later, the items were recovered from the bench at the county club. Shortly after the suspect left again, Witness [REDACTED] heard two quick gunshots. When he made contact with Detective Patriarca, he observed the red bicycle lying on the roadway. He positively identified the bicycle as the one the suspect returned with when he left on foot the first time.

Detective Toler and I made contact with Suspect Jason Banegas (w/m, DOB; 11/09/02) in Interview Room One. The interview was video and audio taped. The suspect was provided the exact same written Miranda warning form to follow along as I read him his rights. He agreed to provide a statement. The suspect stated the following:

He was the passenger in Witness [REDACTED]'s vehicle when it broke down, and they parked the vehicle at the country club. He stated he left the witness and walked around when he saw a red bicycle in a carport that was occupied by a vehicle. He walked into the carport and removed the bicycle. He rode the bicycle back to the country club and met with the witness. He left again and stated he had tried to open unlocked doors of approximately eight vehicles. Out of the eight, he stated he found approximately three vehicles unlocked. He entered the vehicles and removed property herein. He was unable to provide details of the vehicles he burglarized. Banegas stated he returned to the country club and wrapped the stolen items in his white shirt, and left them on the bench in front of the club. He rode the bicycle out into the roadway (4100 North Hills Drive) when he was stopped by an officer. He advised as he began to peddle the bike, the Officer grabbed him. He stated he was being disrespected by the Officer and panicked because he was carrying a concealed firearm and did not want to go back to jail as he was just released 30 days ago.

The two began to violently struggle with each other. The suspect stated he resisted the Officer's attempts to place him on the ground by pushing him. He said the Officer gave him commands to stop resisting, and he did not comply. The two continued to physically struggle while still standing for a short time. The suspect said once they were in the grass, the Officer hit him, and he fell to the ground, and the Officer got on top of him. The suspect noticed vehicle headlights and believed another Police Officer was arriving. The suspect stated he reached into his front right pocket and removed a semiautomatic pistol with a black frame and white slide. He said the Officer never knew he had the gun in his possession and in his hand. The suspect said his intention was to kill himself, but the Officer kept moving around during the struggle. When he thought the Officer was clear of the muzzle, he pulled the trigger. He maintained he was unaware the Officer was shot. The suspect stated he had the gun in his possession for the last twenty-four hours.

Detectives located the Victim of the armed burglary, identified as RC, at her residence located at [REDACTED]. She stated to detectives no one was authorized on her property or to take her bicycle, and she wished to prosecute. The Detectives advised the carport is enclosed on two sides and covered by the roof of the residence. The bicycle was parked in front of the Victim's parked car.

Detectives located two witnesses who observed the suspect riding the bicycle in front of the Victim's residence. The witnesses provided the detectives with sworn statements. A show-up was conducted with the witnesses at the Hollywood Police Department, where they both positively identified Suspect Banegas.

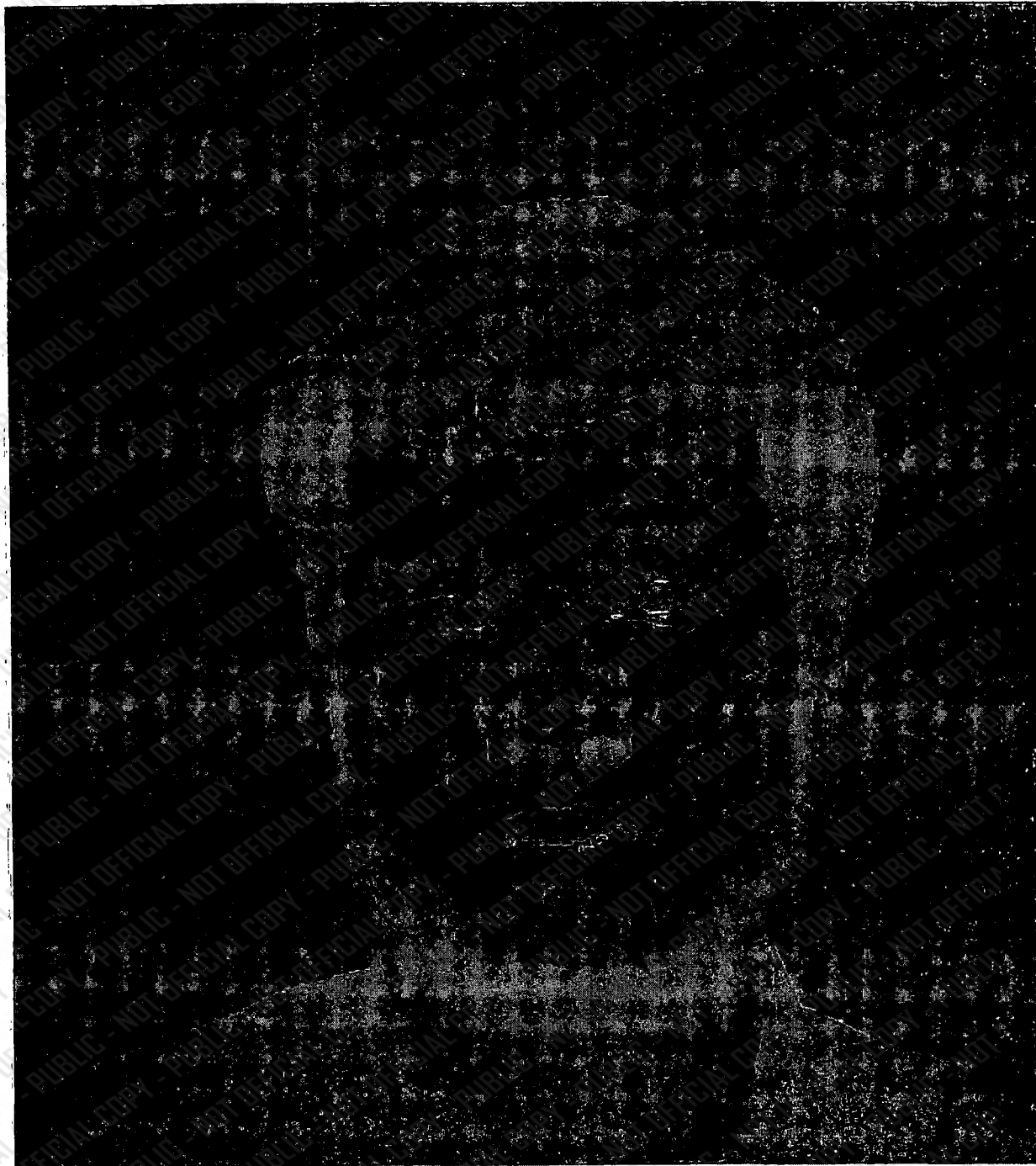
