AFFIDAVIT AND APPLICATION FOR ARREST WARRANT

While driving, the suspect asked the victim questions about her job, where she lived, and about being married. Victim had her purse and briefcase in the front seat. Her purse contained her Colorado Driver's License, envelopes containing money, an unknown brand taser, pepper spray, and her cellular phone with telephone # that has service through T-Mobile. The briefcase contained her passport, two copies of her marriage license, and personal items. The suspect grabbed her purse and briefcase and put them next to him in the back seat. The suspect demanded the victim's wedding ring on her left hand and another ring that was on her right hand. He also demanded her cell phone but told him that it was in her purse. There was also a global positioning system on her middle console that the suspect took and placed by him as well.

After driving a short amount of time the suspect told victim to drive into an alley. drove into an alley as directed by the suspect. The suspect told her to stop and get out. was told to open the trunk of her car and get inside it. began to cry and shake in fear for her life and again the suspect demanded that she get into the trunk. got in the trunk of the Saturn and the suspect closed the trunk lid. Victim could hear the suspect enter the driver's side of the car and get in and start the car. The suspect asked if she could hear him and she said yes. As he drove away, the victim could tell he turned a couple of corners. Victim was able to find the interior trunk release latch and used it to open the trunk. She held the lid closed until the vehicle slowed down and she jumped from the trunk, landing on her stomach causing pain and bruising to her legs, arms, and chest. She got up and ran for help to the 7-Eleven store while the suspect continued to drive away.

03/14/11 At approximately 0330 hours, your affiant received a phone call from Robbery Sergeant Edward Leger (90061) and he related that the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department and the Colorado State Patrol responded to a one car accident involving the victim's vehicle on Highway 285 at mile marker 240. Your affiant contacted Colorado State Trooper Jason Sparks and he stated that while investigating the accident it was found that the driver had fled the victim's vehicle. The Officers observed a red Toyota Highlander driving slowly by the accident scene and observed a white male driver and a black male passenger who matched the description of the suspect who took the victim's vehicle.

Officers followed the Toyota Highlander and initiated a high risk felony stop on the vehicle on Highway C470 between the Morrison Road exit and the Alameda Parkway Exit. The driver and passenger were removed and placed into custody. There were no other persons in the vehicle. Officers received consent to search the vehicle from the owner and driver, (10-30-51) who is a white male. Upon search of the vehicle, officers located a silver Smith and Wesson semi-automatic 9mm handgun just under the rear portion of the driver's seat. Owner stated that he does not own any handguns and did not have any handguns in the vehicle.

The passenger was identified as William Lornes (05-06-86) and he is a black male.
