04/13/11 At approximately 1500 hours, victim (08-: 89) contacted the Denver Police Department to report being kidnapped at gun point in her 2004 maroon Saturn Ion with Colorado : from 3000 E. 1st Avenue Denver, Colorado occurring between 1430 hours and 1500 hours.

Denver Police Officer William Seiwald (05055) responded to the victim's location of $E.8^{th}$ Avenue Denver, Colorado at the 7-Eleven Store where she called 911. On arrival Officer Seiwald received general information as to the robbery and aired the description of the victim's vehicle and the suspect description. Officer Seiwald transported victim topolice to police headquarters and she was brought up to the third floor video interview room.

Detective Todd Cole (97012) with the Denver Police Robbery Unit conducted a video interview with victim.

Lat approximately 1600 hours on 04-13-11 in reference to Denver Police

Department report number #2011-162557. Victim

gave the following synopsized statement;

stated that she works at the Cherry Creek Mall

which is located at

3000 E. Ist Avenue Denver, Colorado.

Saturn Ion Sedan on the fifth level of the parking garage before beginning work. A Black male suspect approached her driver's side door and asked a question. The Black male was described as possibly being in his late 20's, 6'00" tall, thin build, with bald or shaven head, mustache, light blue diamond stud on the right side of his nose, black lettering tattoos on the right side of his eye, possible tattoos on his neck, and was wearing dark clothing.

opened the car door to hear him and the suspect asked for a cigarette and then asked to use her phone.

The suspect looked around and pulled out a silver handgun from his waist area and stated, "You are going to drive me. Unlock your doors." The suspect entered the back seat of the car behind and told her that she was going to leave the parking garage. The suspect directed her out of the mall parking garage and made victim. drive in the directions that he relayed to her.

AFFIDAVIT AND APPLICATION FOR ARREST WARRANT

03/14/11 At approximately 0330 hours, your affiant received a phone call from Robbery Sergeant Edward Leger (90061) and he related that the Jefferson County Sheriff's Department and the Colorado State Patrol responded to a one car accident involving the victim's vehicle on Highway 285 at mile marker 240. Your affiant contacted Colorado State Trooper Jason Sparks and he stated that while investigating the accident it was found that the driver had fled the victim's vehicle. The Officers observed a red Toyota Highlander driving slowly by the accident scene and observed a white male driver and a black male passenger who matched the description of the suspect who took the victim's vehicle.

Officers followed the Toyota Highlander and initiated a high risk felony stop on the vehicle on Highway C470 between the Morrison Road exit and the Alameda Parkway Exit. The driver and passenger were removed and placed into custody. There were no other persons in the vehicle. Officers received consent to search the vehicle from the owner and driver, to t(10-30-51) who is a white male. Upon search of the vehicle, officers located a silver Smith and Wesson semi-automatic 9mm handgun just under the rear portion of the driver's seat, Owner the stated that he does not own any handguns and did not have any handguns in the vehicle.

The passenger was identified as William Lornes (05-06-86) and he is a black male.
