Probable Cause Paperwork

Your Affiant is a law enforcement officer with the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office currently assigned to the South Metro Drug Task Force (SMDTF), and the following information was obtained by me personally and from the official records of the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office

On 10/4/11, I was assigned South Metro Drug Task Force case # 11-322, which has a corresponding Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office case number's (City of Centennial reports (CT11-33924) and (CT11-33930)).

Your Affiant was assigned the above reports for potential follow up and upon reviewing the reports noted the following:

- Arapahoe County Sheriff's Deputies responded to a call of an unwanted male party at which is located in the City of Centennial, County of Arapahoe, and State of Colorado.
- The subsequent investigation identified that male to be Patrick J. Sullivan Jr. (former Arapahoe County Sheriff).
- During the subsequent investigation your Affiant confirmed the male to be Patrick J. Sullivan Jr. and personally knows him as your Affiant was employed by the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office during Sullivan's term.
- During the subsequent investigation your Affiant identified and began working with two known, reliable, documented South Metro Drug Task Force confidential informants that your Affiant will refer to as CI # 1039 and CI # 1040.

During the week of November 13th, 2011, your Affiant contacted CI # 1039 and CI # 1040 asked if either confidential informant could purchase any methamphetamine from Sullivan. CI # 1039 and CI # 1040 advised your Affiant that he/she could possibly purchase methamphetamine from Sullivan, but would definitely be able to obtain methamphetamine from Sullivan in exchange for sexual acts. CI # 1039 and CI # 1040 further advised your Affiant that he/she would not know when he/she could obtain the methamphetamine, but would have to wait for Sullivan to want to engage in sexual activity. Both confidential informants advised your Affiant that they had engaged in sexual activity with Sullivan in the past and Sullivan provided them methamphetamine during past encounters and or cash, as payment for the sexual acts.

Sgt. Jason Anderson, your Affiant, and CI's 1039 and CI # 1040 made multiple pre-text telephone calls and texts engaging Sullivan in conversations in regards to obtaining methamphetamine and attempting to set a meeting with CI # 1039 and CI # 1040.

Your Affiant verified the known telephone number for Sullivan and provided CI's 1039 and 1040 with photographs of Sullivan obtained from the department of motor vehicles. Both CI # 1039 and CI # 1040 identified Sullivan's DMV photo as the male they had had sexual encounters with and obtained methamphetamine from in the past.

Sullivan agreed to provide methamphetamine to CI # 1040 and agreed to meet CI # 1040 at a residence at which is located in the City of Aurora, County of Arapahoe, and State of Colorado.

Sgt. Jason Anderson, your Affiant, and multiple agents from the South Metro Drug Task Force conducted an operation at the Aurora, County of Arapahoe, and State of Colorado.

The residence was outfitted with audio and video equipment and Sullivan was observed arriving at the residence. Sullivan was observed physically handing what appeared to be methamphetamine to CI # 1040 in the bedroom of the residence and was subsequently taken into custody without incident.

Agents from the South Metro Drug Task Force recovered the suspected methamphetamine from the bed that Sullivan was observed passing to CI # 1040 during the transaction.

In addition to the bag recovered from the bed, a second bag of suspected methamphetamine was recovered from Sullivan's person during a search incident to a lawful arrest.

Agent Jacob Gerson subsequently completed a NIK reagent field test on both of the suspected methamphetamine baggies and received a presumptive positive for the presence of methamphetamine on both. Agent Gerson obtained a combined net weight of .7 grams for the methamphetamine.

Sullivan was subsequently transported to the Patrick J. Sullivan Jr. detention facility and booked in on distribution of a schedule II controlled substance. Sullivan's bond was set at \$250,000.00
