[Ofc. A Silberman], a Police officer with the AURORA POLICE DEPT. states that there exists probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named suspect for the charges stated above. The Officer further states that the facts below are based on personal knowledge and/or interviews with witness(s) and fellow peace officers and/or review of official law enforcement reports.

1. The crime(s) alleged occurred on [02/18/2013], at {1490 S Bahama St },

City of Aurora, County of [Arapahoe], State of Colorado.

2. The suspect was arrested at [4:13] [X]am []pm on the

[19] day of [February/2013]
Month/Year

3. The facts in support of the probable cause for the warrantless arrest of the above named suspect are as follows:

{On 2-18-13 at approximately 10:31 PM Ofc. VanDyk and I (Ofc. Silberman/308209) were dispatched on a fire assist call at 1490 S Bahama St. The call notes stated that a fire had started in the basement and there were fireworks, guns and ammo inside along with three people. Also the father and son were attempting to put the fire out. This address is located within the city of Aurora, Arapahoe County, State of Colorado.

Upon our arrival other officers were on scene with the fire department. The firemen were actively putting the fire out as clouds of dark smoke were coming out of the garage and front door area of the residence.

When it appeared that the fire was put out more fire department personnel arrived on scene and went inside the residence. I was then informed by a fireman that explosive materials were discovered inside along with large

amounts of firearms, ammo and fireworks. This information was confirmed with other firemen who were on scene. I then did a walkthrough of the upstairs of the residence and observed large amounts of firearms (long guns and handguns) along with ammo lying on the floor by the kitchen table. I also observed potassium nitrate on the kitchen table as well. A box of fireworks along with loose fireworks were also brought outside and placed on the driveway by the firemen.

Approximately 20 minutes later the owner of the residence, Michael Glover (DOB/081557) was mirandized by the Arson Investigators on scene. At that time he made a statement that he has (2) pipe bombs inside a shed in the back yard and gave them consent to search. Sgt Stowell was kept up to date with all this information and came out to the scene and started Arapahoe County Bomb Squad.

I Mirandized Mr. Grover a second time from my APD issued Miranda card and he declined to speak to me further about this incident. This occurred and approximately 1:43 AM. Due to the public safety concern of the explosive devices and the neighborhood, I did ask him questions. Mr. Glover was asked if there were more explosive devices inside the shed or the residence. He stated that there were not. I then asked if there were blasting caps inside the shed with the bombs and he stated no. He said there were only some propane type tanks and some gasoline. At this time Mr. Grover was detained pending our current investigation.

The Arapahoe Bomb Squad arrived on scene and spoke to Mr. Grover about the devices. It was explained to him that these questions were asked out of safety for the public and the officers so they would not be accidentally detonated. Mr. Grover told them that the pipe bombs were filled with black powder and had electrical caps as the fuse. He said that one end was welded on and the other was held on by some sort of adhesive. The devices were not powered by any battery/electrical source so they were safe at this time. He said that he just built them recently and was going to detonate them this upcoming weekend.

Bomb Tech Anselmi then went and looked at the devices in the shed. He then told Sgt Stowell that these devices were consistent with being pipe bombs.

Due to the evidence discovered by the Arson investigators, the statements made by Mr. Glover and the observations made by the Arapahoe Bomb squad, it is believed by this officer that probable cause exists to charge Mr. Glover with possession of explosive devices (sec # 18-12-109(2)).

At approximately 4:13 AM he was placed in to custody and transported to the Aurora City Jail. He was then processed and turned over in to their custody.

Mr. Grover was positively identified through PIMS, NCIC/CCIC and via his DMV photo.
