ARMED AND DANGEROUS

On June 17, 2014 at about 2:10 p.m. the Wells Fargo Bank at 6000 West 44th Avenue in Wheat Ridge was robbed by two masked and armed suspects. The suspects terrorized employees and customers, removing a large sum of money from the vault before fleeing in the pictured stolen car.

The suspects were described as:

#1 – A Hispanic or white male, 18 to 30 years old, 5'3" to 5'6", medium build;

#2 – A Hispanic or white male, 18 to 30 years old, 5'7" to 5'9", medium build.

The getaway car was abandoned and set on fire in a wooded area near the 2600 block of West 60th Avenue in Adams County shortly after the robbery.
