AFFIDAVIT IN SUPPORT OF A WARRANTLESS ARREST

Your affiant is of lawful age and a sworn peace officer of the Jefferson County Sheriff's Office, Golden, Colorado, in the County of Jefferson.

Your affiant states that the following facts are true and based upon his/her personal knowledge, as a result of his/her conversations with the person(s) named herein and reviewing their written or oral statements. On March 9, 2015, at about 7:10 pm, your affiant arrested Steven Mark Weigum, whose date of birth is April 16, 1959, for the crime(s) of Aggravated Incest and Sexual Assault on a Child by one in a Position of Trust, which occurred at [REDACTED] Circle, in the County of Jefferson, State of Colorado. The facts which developed the probable cause of this arrest are as follows:

On March 9, 2015, at about 2:20 pm, Deputy Victor Aversa was dispatched to the South Precinct (11139 Bradford Road), reference a domestic violence call. At about 2:28 pm, Deputy Aversa arrived and met with [REDACTED] and her mother, [REDACTED] DOB/ 09-02-65.

[REDACTED] told Deputy Aversa that between 2004 and 2010, [REDACTED] and [REDACTED], Steven Mark Weigum, DOB/ 04-16-59, [REDACTED] told Deputy Aversa that during that time [REDACTED] had been "touching me while I was sleeping." [REDACTED] described the touching as under her clothes, on her breasts and vaginal areas. [REDACTED] did not believe any penetration occurred and that Steven only used his hands. [REDACTED] stated that if she moved around, Steven would "hide [REDACTED] or [REDACTED] then return." [REDACTED] felt ashamed of what occurred and did not want to get [REDACTED] in trouble, but [REDACTED] believed the truth needed to be told. [REDACTED] told her mother about Steven's actions on March 8, 2015.

In 2010, [REDACTED] and Steven [REDACTED] told Deputy Aversa Steven has not touched her since [REDACTED] but has been "creeping around." [REDACTED] described creeping around as finding Steven looking into the bathroom while [REDACTED] was in the shower. Steven has sent [REDACTED] inappropriate text messages making statements about how beautiful [REDACTED] is and wishing [REDACTED] was Steven's girlfriend.

[REDACTED] confronted Steven the night of March 8, 2015, and [REDACTED] told Steven to leave the house. Steven was very apologetic and appeared to be filled with guilt and remorse. Steven sent [REDACTED] multiple text messages stating he planned to kill himself with medication or retire from the Jefferson County School District and move away. Steven mentioned that [REDACTED] should cash in his life insurance, sell his vehicles and discussed how much money was in their bank accounts.

On March 8, 2015 at about 11:00 am, Steven sent the following text to [REDACTED] "You were the love of my life and [REDACTED] is such an amazing person. How could I have done this. I'm so sorry."

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As Deputy Aversa spoke with [redacted] and [redacted] Steven sent [redacted] more text messages. The text messages were of an apologetic nature mixed with statements of suicide and admission: - at approximately 2:54pm, "What I did with [redacted] was creepy. I can't justify it. But there wasn't sex. Doesn't matter. I'm a horrible human being. I deserve to die."

[redacted] and [redacted] came to the JCSO headquarters and spoke to your affiant. [redacted] described in detail how Steven would enter her room while her mother was working late in the evening. [redacted] told your affiant how Steven would put his hands inside of her pajamas to touch her breasts and vagina. According to [redacted] the touching action took place on a frequent basis, weekly or more. The touching stopped at around late fourth grade or early fifth grade. Sometime during the fourth grade, Steven started to look into the bathroom every time [redacted] took a shower. Looking in on [redacted] in the bathroom continued until [redacted] was eighteen years of age [redacted] with a friend.

[redacted] phone was downloaded at the Sheriff's Office and there were many text messages admitting that what he did to [redacted] was wrong. Steven made several comments about ending his life.

[redacted] participated in a pretext phone call with Steven. During the call Steven stated that any touch that might have occurred was incidental. Steven claimed all he tried to do was remove [redacted] clothing so he could look at [redacted] Steven made numerous comments about killing himself to [redacted] during the call.

Your affiant and Investigator Matt Clark drove to the area of C470 and West Ken Caryl Avenue to check hotel parking lots. While at the Holiday Inn Express, northeast corner of C470 & West Ken Caryl Avenue, dispatch received a call from [redacted] [redacted] observed Steven's truck in the parking lot of the Hampden Inn & Suites at 7611 Shaffer Parkway in Littleton, CO. Investigator Clark and your affiant went to the Hampden Inn & Suites and found Steven in room 209. Steven had taken an unspecified number of pills. There were empty prescription bottles that had contained Trazadone and Hydralcodone at one point in time. There was also a small, semi automatic pistol on the desk in the room.

Steven was transported by medical personnel to the Littleton Adventist Hospital.

Based upon the foregoing facts, your affiant submits that there is probable cause to believe that criminal offenses have been committed in violation of Colorado law. Your affiant further submits that there is probable cause to charge **Steven Mark Weigum, DOB/ 04-16-59**, with the commission of these offenses.
