I write to you today at the request of the family of Sang-Hyuk Kim. Sang-Hyuk Kim was a constituent of mine. Sang-Hyuk Kim was apparently murdered on 27 November, 2016. To date it is my understanding that this murder remains under investigation with no indictment of a perpetrator pending.


Sang-Hyuk Kim's family has requested my assistance because, it feels quite strongly that the Denver Police Department has essentially ignored it and, more pertinently, that the Denver Police is not vigorously investigating and seeking to resolve this case.

I have attached to this letter a chronology provided to me by the family of Sang-Hyuk Kim which provides the basis for the family's concern.

I do understand that as this is an ongoing criminal investigation that there are limitations on what information and updates upon this effort you can provide to the family, but the difficulty this family appears to have experienced having any communication with the investigators seems to go beyond the limits necessary to protect the investigation. The family of Sang-Hyuk Kim is, as you certainly understand, devastated by this tragedy. Enhanced communication from Denver Police Department, the investigators and the identification, indictment, and successful prosecution of his murderer would go a long way toward aiding the family through its grief.

I therefore request, that you look into this matter to see if there is a way either your office or the Denver Police can proactively reach out to the family with the objective of aiding it in obtaining the information regarding and a resolution to this case. The family asks for this as it seeks closure.
