ORDER GRANTING <u>EMERGENCY</u> MOTION FOR TEMPORARY RESTRAINING ORDER AND TELEPHONE HEARING

This Court, having reviewed the **Emergency** Complaint for Injunctive Relief, Including Temporary Restraining Order and Motion for Telephonic Hearing, and the separate **Emergency** Motion for Temporary Restraining Order and Telephonic Hearing, and finding good cause, enters the following ORDERS:

- 1. Plaintiff's request for a temporary restraining order is GRANTED. Defendant Bandimere Auto-Performance Center, Inc. d/b/a Bandimere Speedway Inc. is hereby enjoined and restrained from violating Colorado's Public Health Orders, including EO D 2020-123 and CDPHE PHO 20-28, by:
  - (1) hosting any gatherings at its outdoor venue in excess of 175 people per designated activity;
  - (2) hosting any event that violates any of PHO 20-28's social distancing

- requirements, including its requirement for 6 feet of space between individuals from different households and its requirements for event venues to manage traffic flow; and
- (3) hosting any event that serves food in violation of the restaurant requirements in PHO 20-28.
- 2. Bandimere Speedway Inc. is ORDERED to immediately comply with EO D 2020-123 and PHO 20-28, including
  - (1) its prohibition of gatherings at its outdoor venue in excess of 175 people per designated activity;
  - (2) its social distancing requirements, including its requirement for 6 feet of space between individuals from different households and its requirements for event venues to manage traffic flow; and
  - (3) its restaurant requirements in PHO 20-28.
- 3. Plaintiff's request for telephonic hearings is GRANTED.
